



Survey of Residents' Views of Patterns of Local Government 2003/4: Additional Research

Topline for: The Nantwich Area, Crewe & Nantwich Borough Council Area, Cheshire

Technical Note

- Results are based on interviews with 330 residents aged 18+ in the Nantwich area of the Crewe
 Nantwich Borough Council area.
- Interviews were conducted face-to-face, in home between 1 December 2003 and 23 February 2004.
- A representative quota sample was interviewed in randomly selected Enumeration Districts (EDs) within the area, with quotas set by age, gender and work status using 2001 Census data.
- Data are weighted by age, gender and work status to the known profile of the area.
- Where results do not sum to 100% this may be due to multiple responses or computer rounding.
- An asterisk (*) indicates a value of less than 0.5%, but not zero.
- Results are based on all respondents unless stated otherwise.
- All the figures in this topline are given as percentages, even when the base is low. Where the base is under 50, considerable caution should be applied when making inferences.
- For some questions, comparative data is provided from findings across the Cheshire area, where 1,850 interviews were carried out. County data is additionally weighted by population size of each district.
