

If a Labour/Conservative government is elected after the next General Election do you think it will or will not. . .?


And do you think that the next government, regardless of which party it is, should or should not..?

Positive characteristics


In choosing between Gordon Brown, David Cameron or Nick Clegg, which leader do you think ...?


Negative characteristics

In choosing between Gordon Brown, David Cameron or Nick Clegg, which leader do you think ...?




Trustworthy?

Government's record on the economy


Since it was elected in May 1997, do you think the government has done a good job or a bad job at managing the economy?

Government's record on handling taxation and public expenditure


Since it was elected in May 1997, do you think the government has done a good job or a bad job at handling taxation and public expenditure?


Conservatives ready to govern?

To what extent do you agree or disagree that the Conservatives are ready to form the next Government?




Cameron's Conservatives are seen as less ready than Blair's Labour in 1997

Do you agree or disagree with the following statements? David Cameron is ready to be Prime Minister










