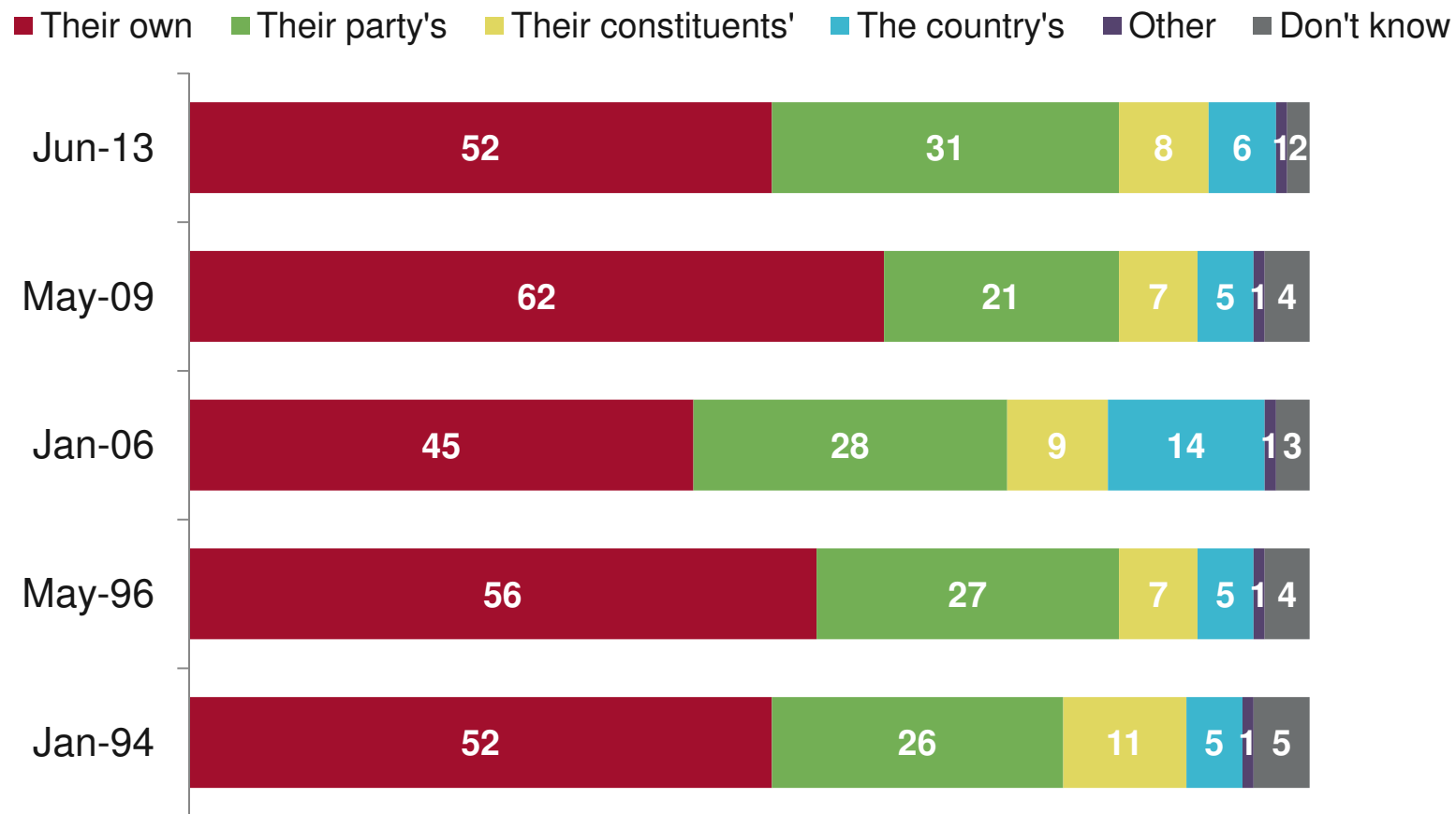

In general whose interests do you think MPs put first?

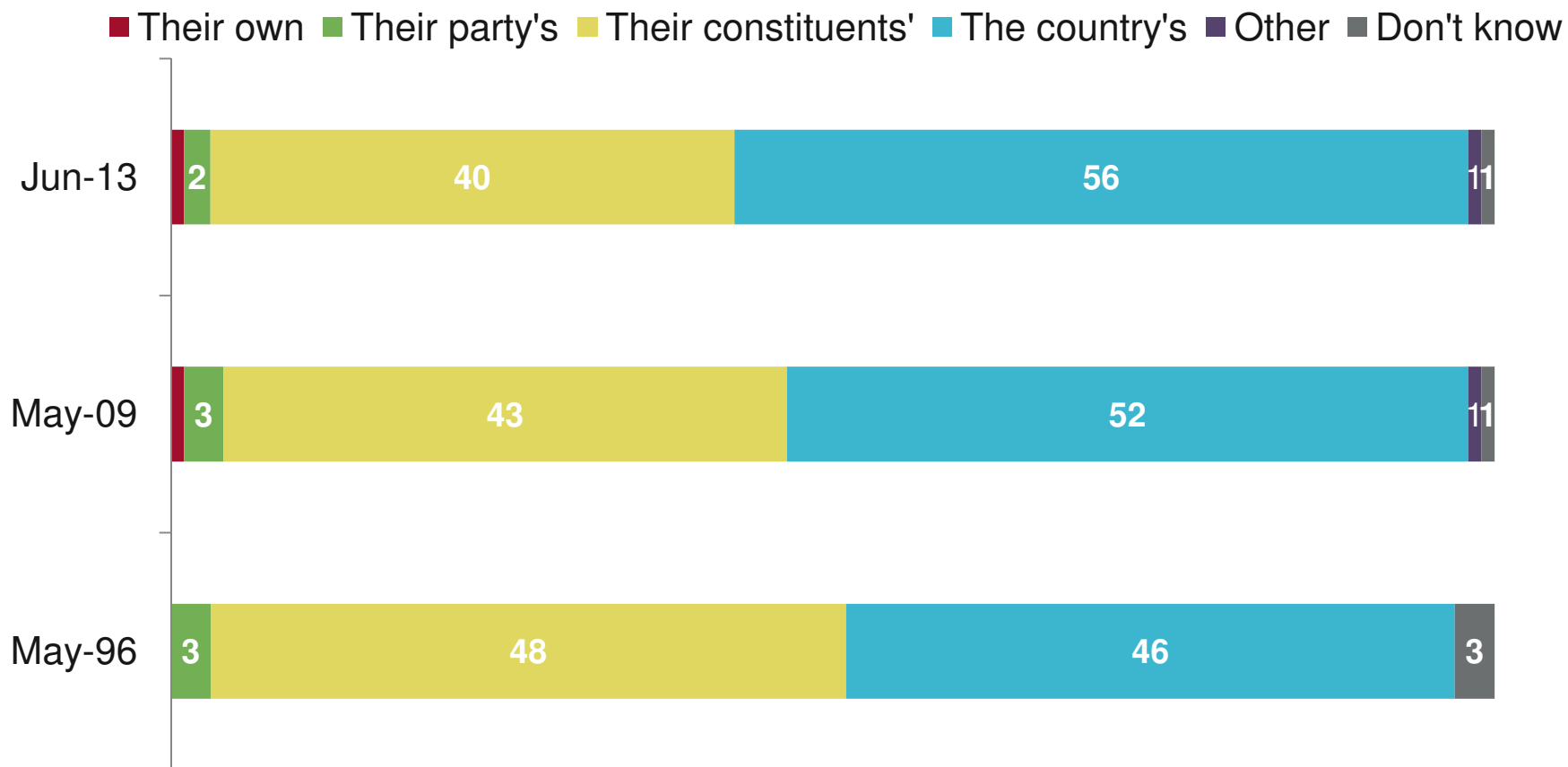

In general whose interests do you think MPs should put first?



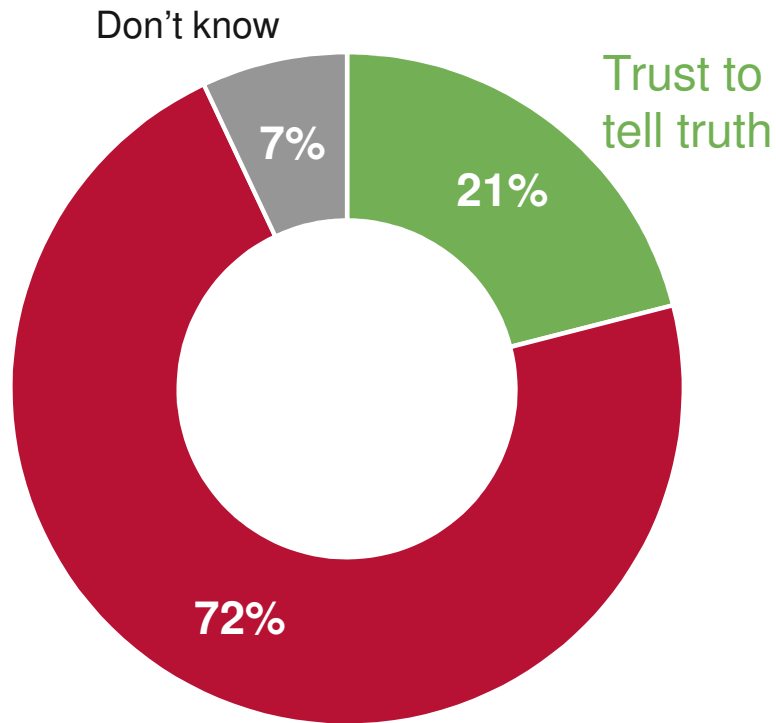

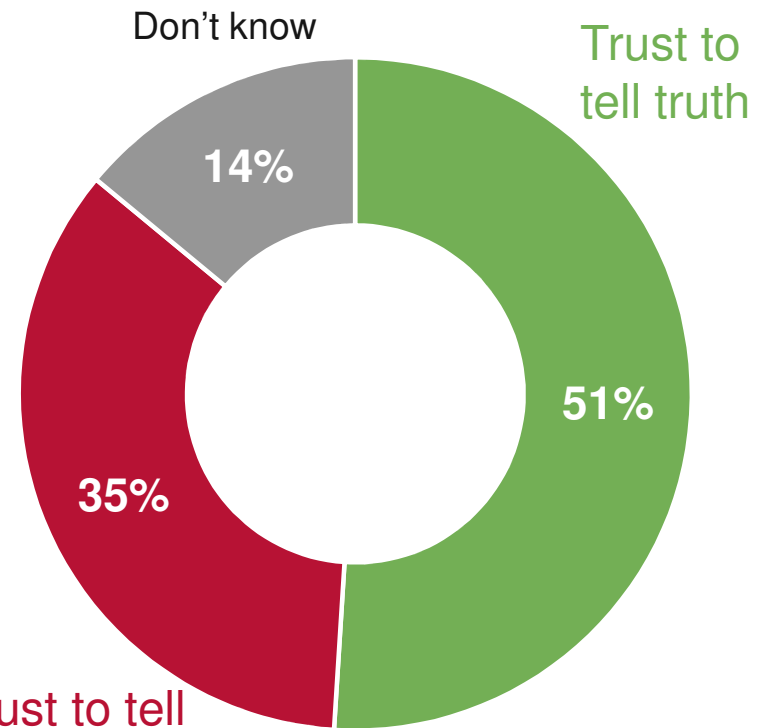

### Your local MP



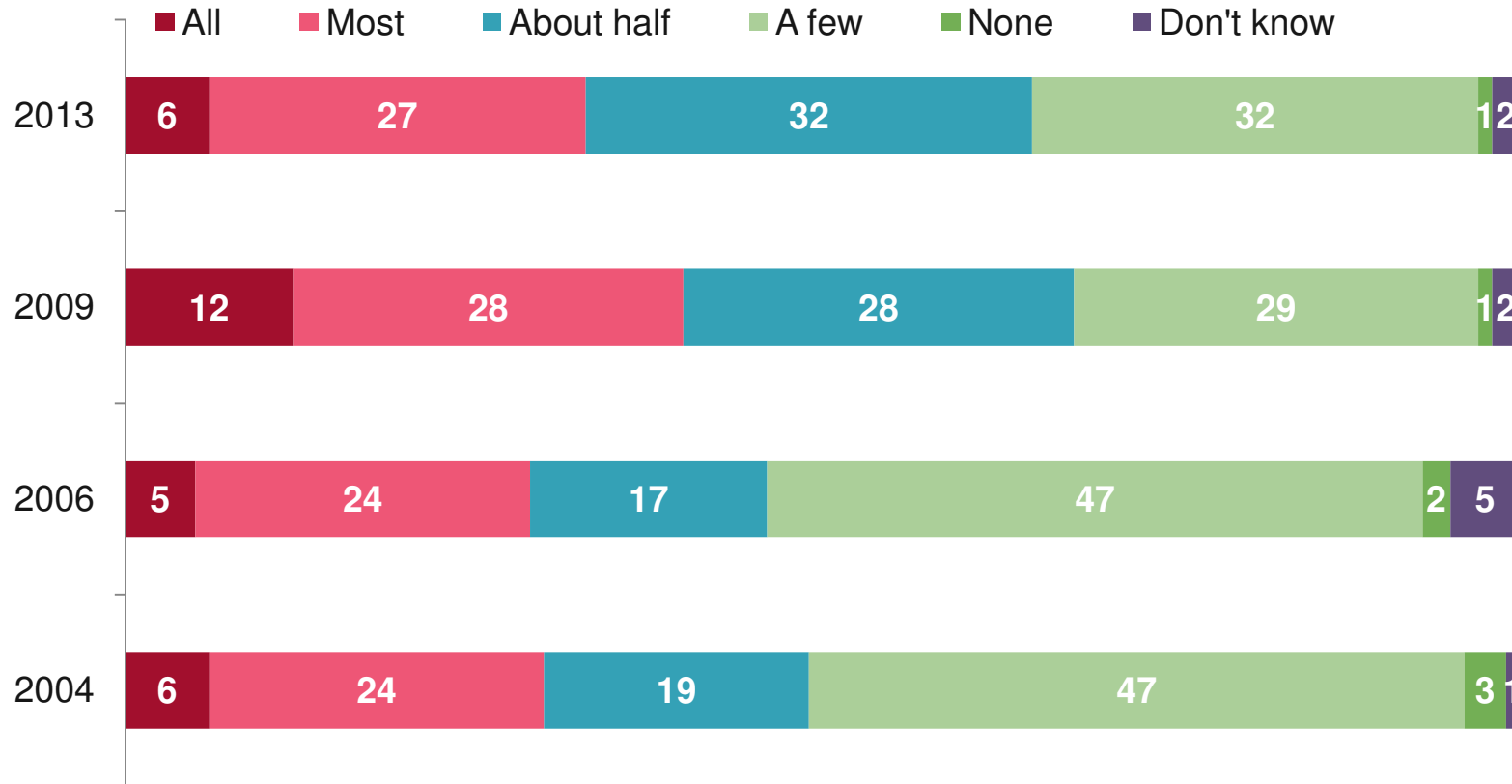
