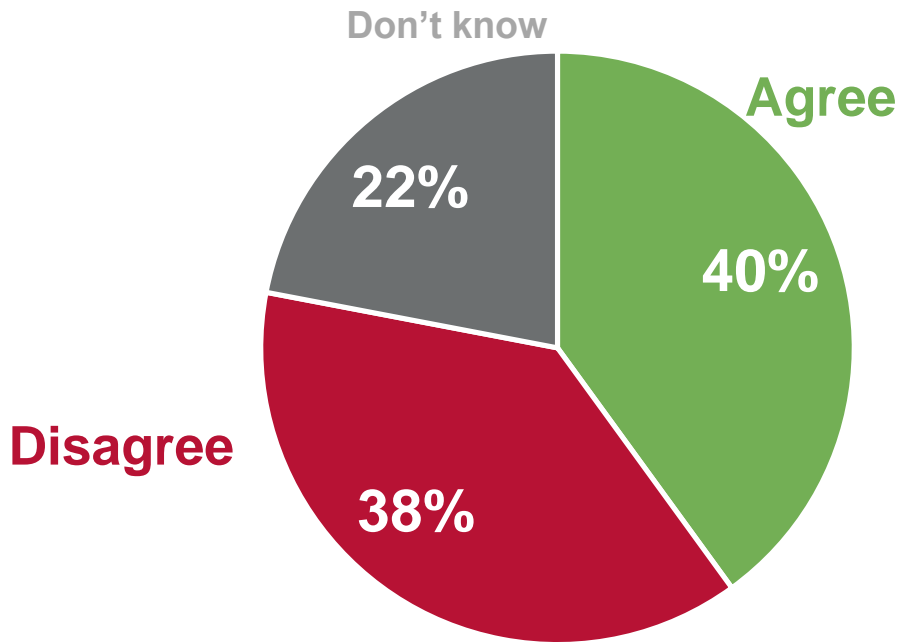

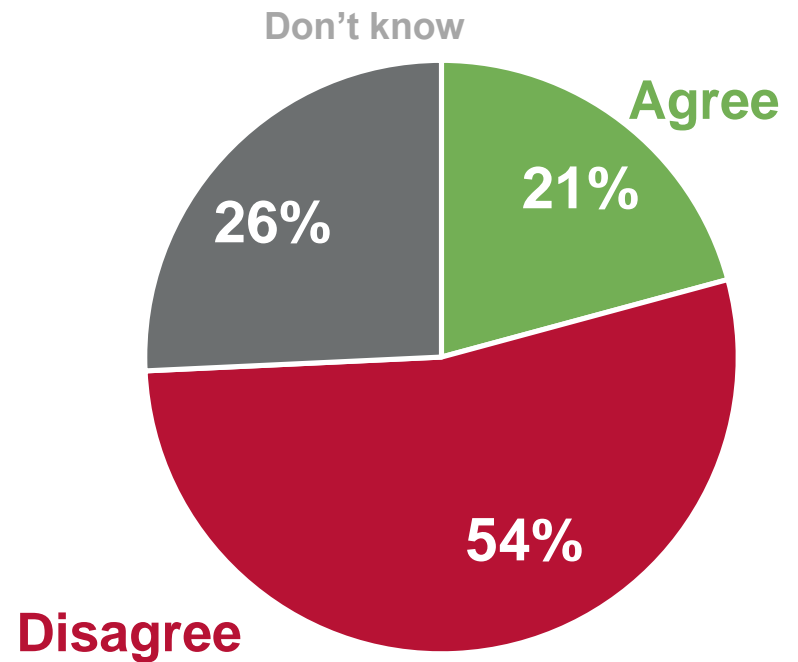

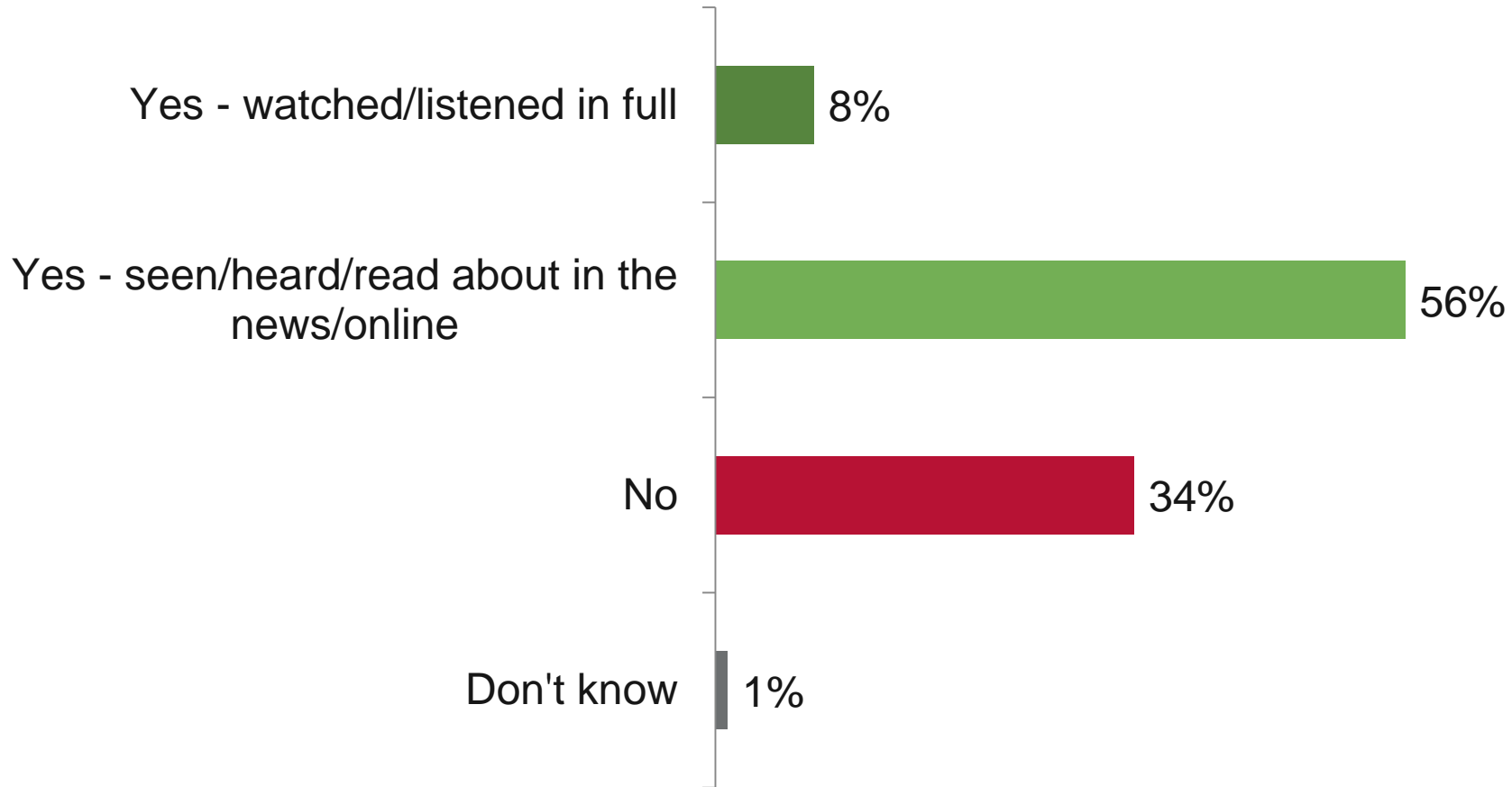

Have you seen, heard or read anything about today's Autumn Statement where Chancellor George Osborne announced a number of policies on spending and taxes?

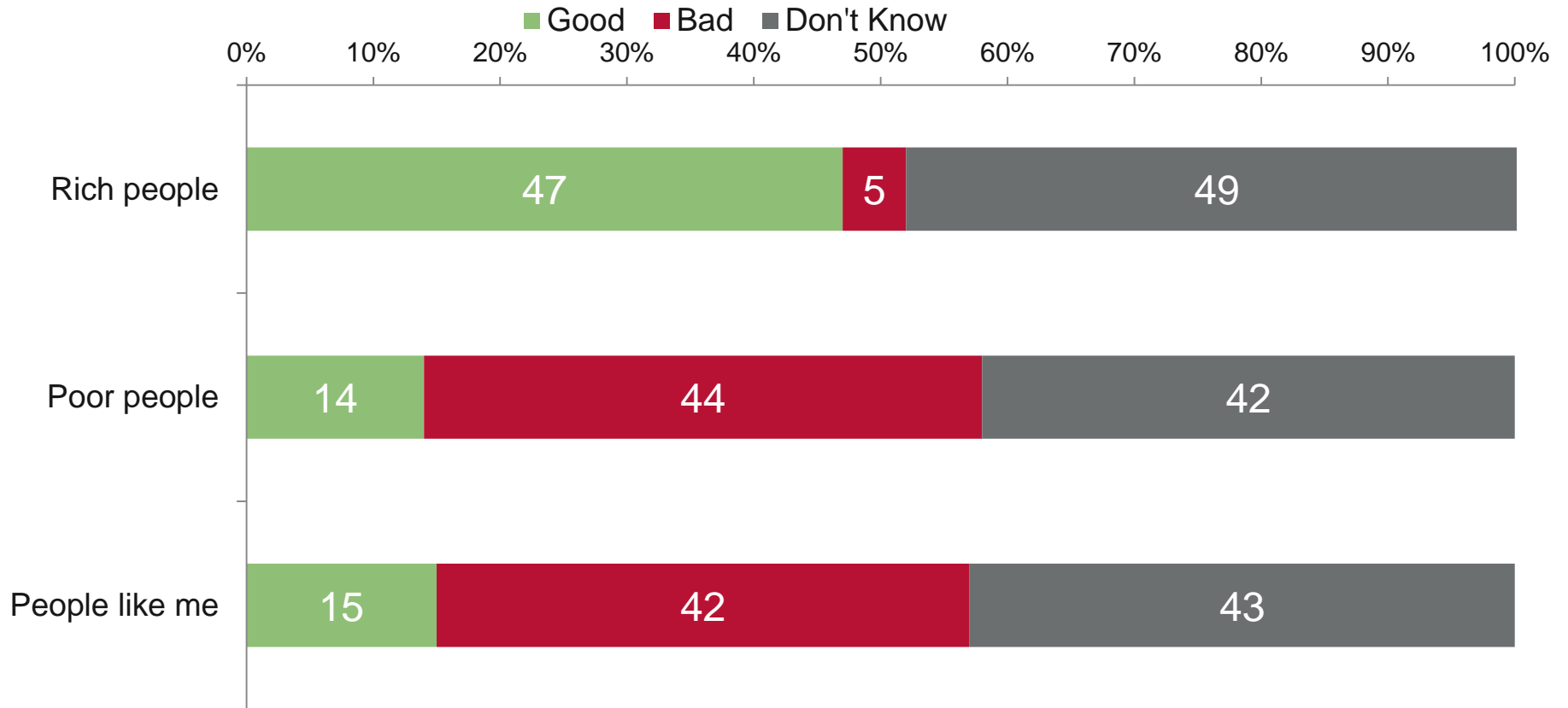

Overall, do you think today's Autumn Statement was good or bad for.....

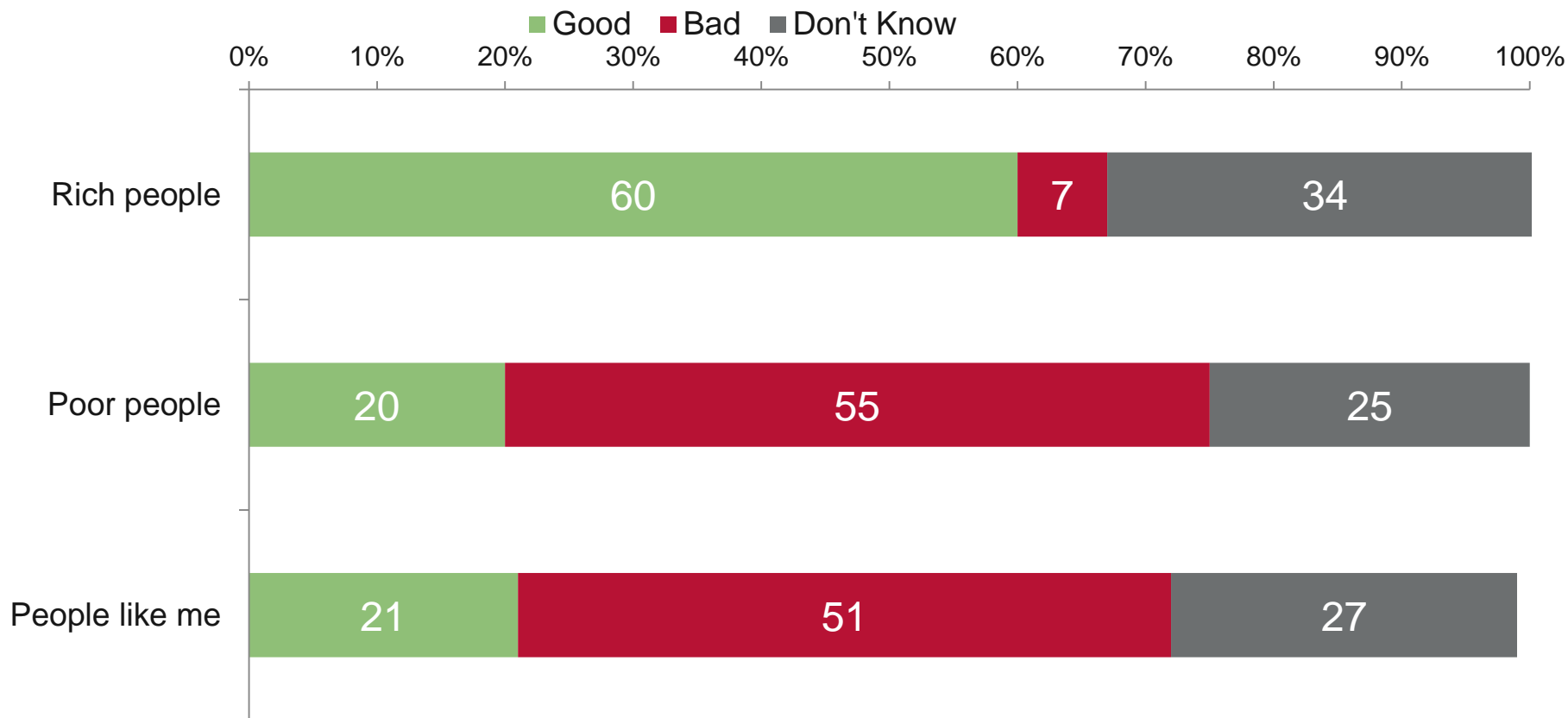

Overall, do you think today's Autumn Statement was good or bad for.....

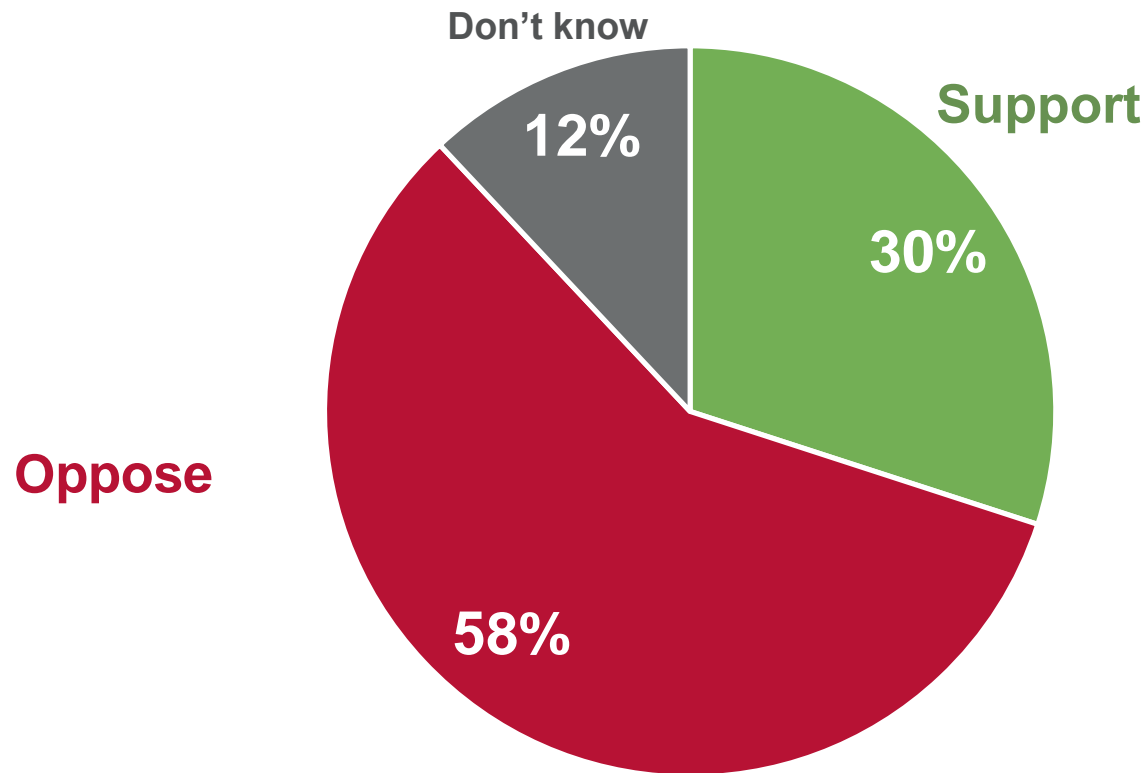

Do you support or oppose linking retirement age to life expectancy so that retirement age will rise to 68 in the 2030s and 69 in the 2040s?



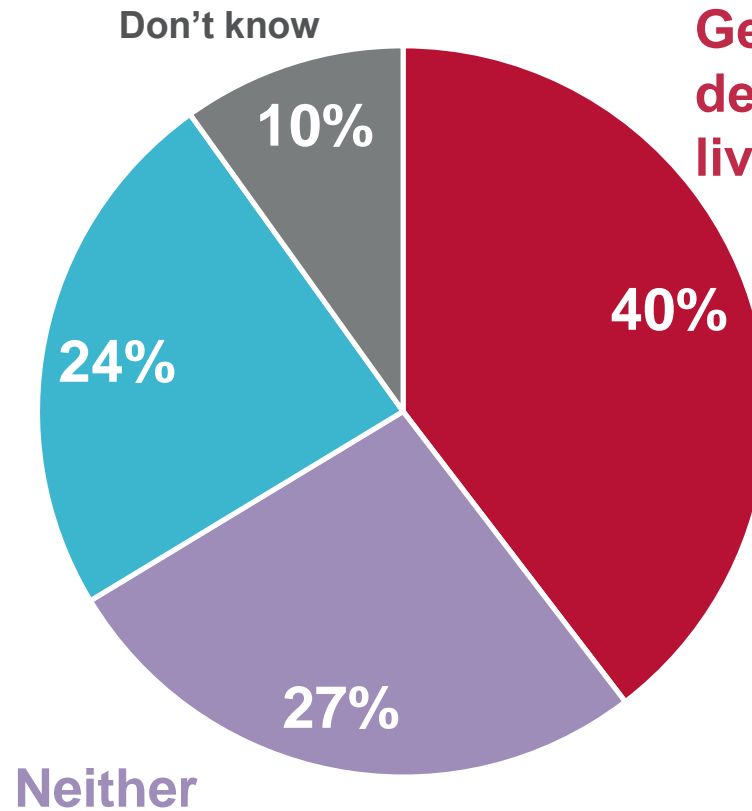
