



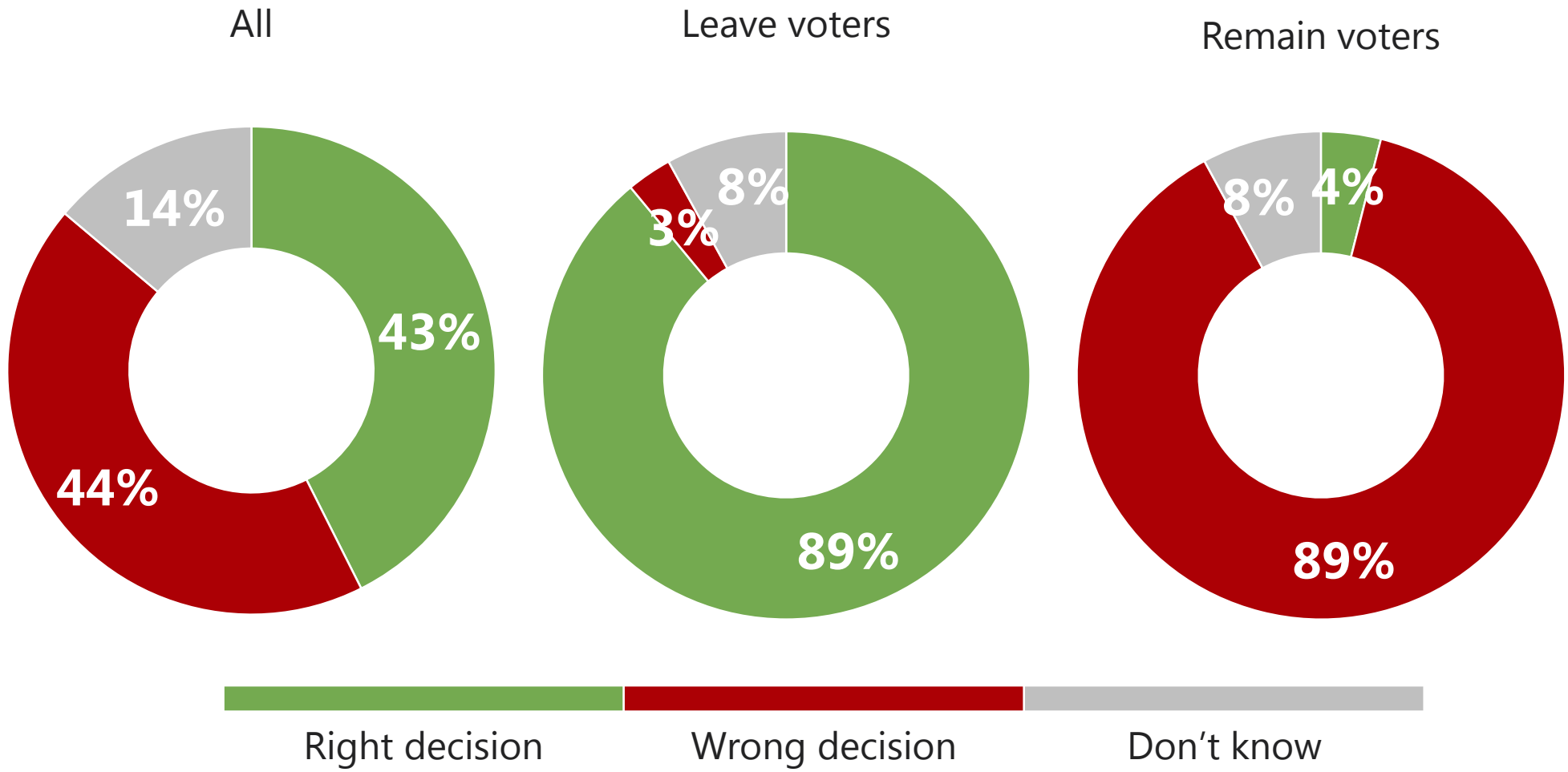

Do you think that was the right decision or the wrong decision for the United Kingdom?

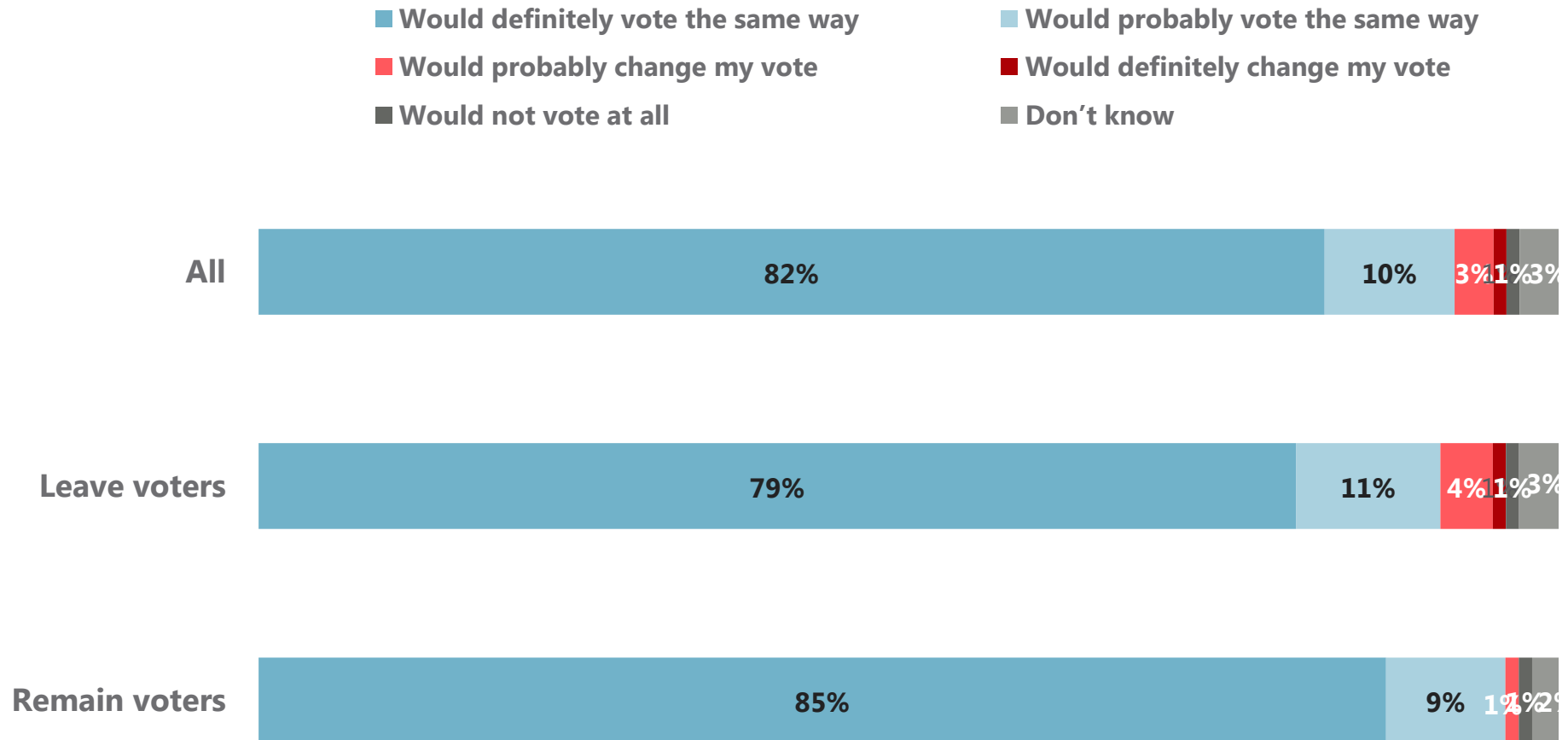

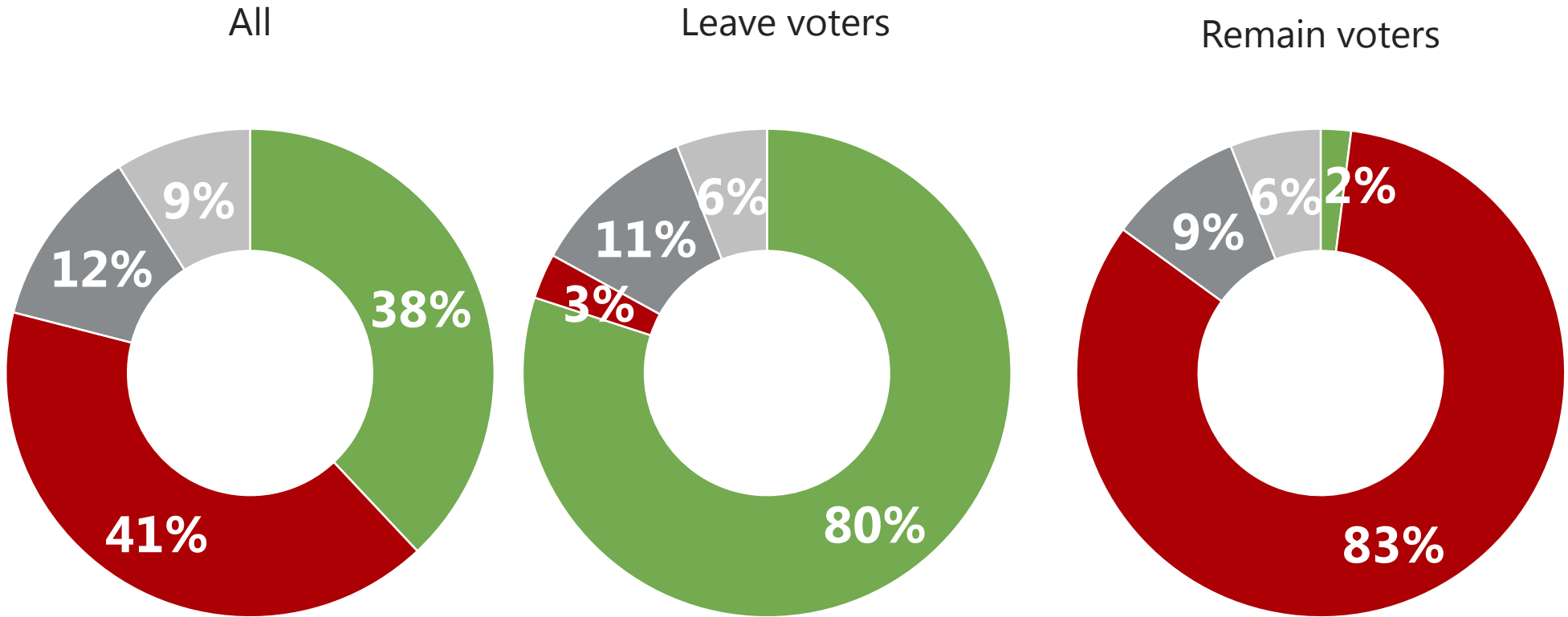
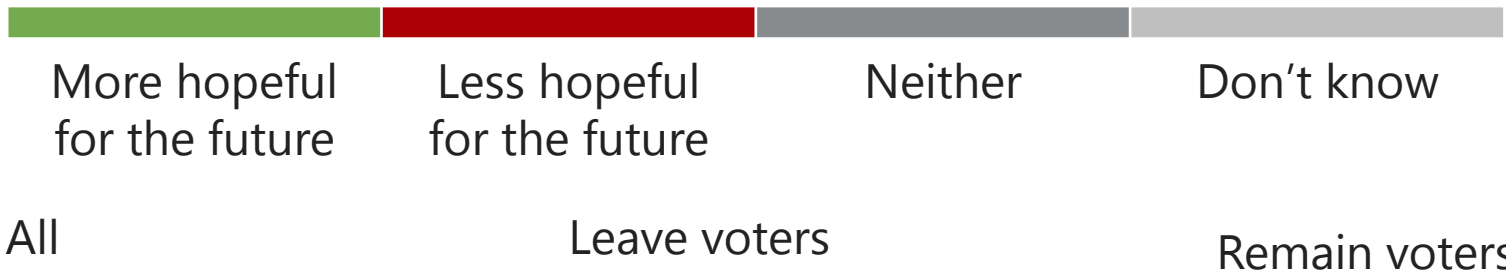
If a second referendum was to be held on the United Kingdom's membership of the European Union, would you vote the same way or would you change your vote?

How does the United Kingdom's decision to leave the European Union make you feel, if at all?



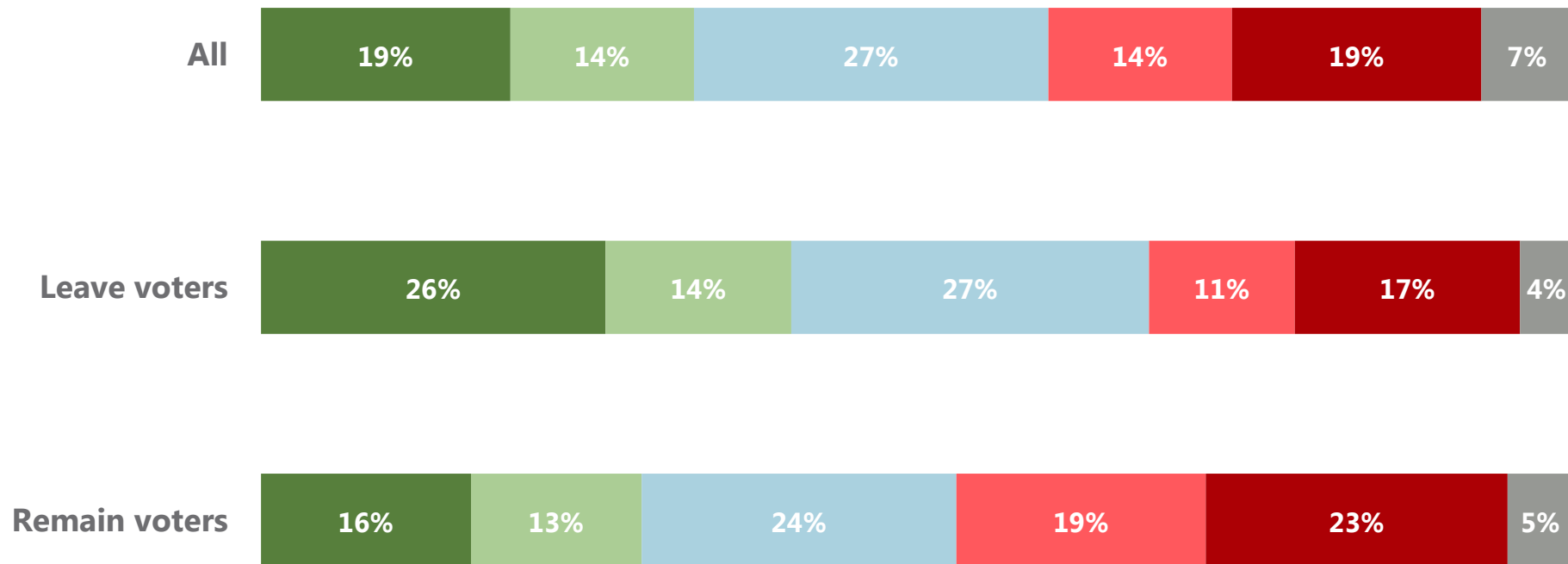

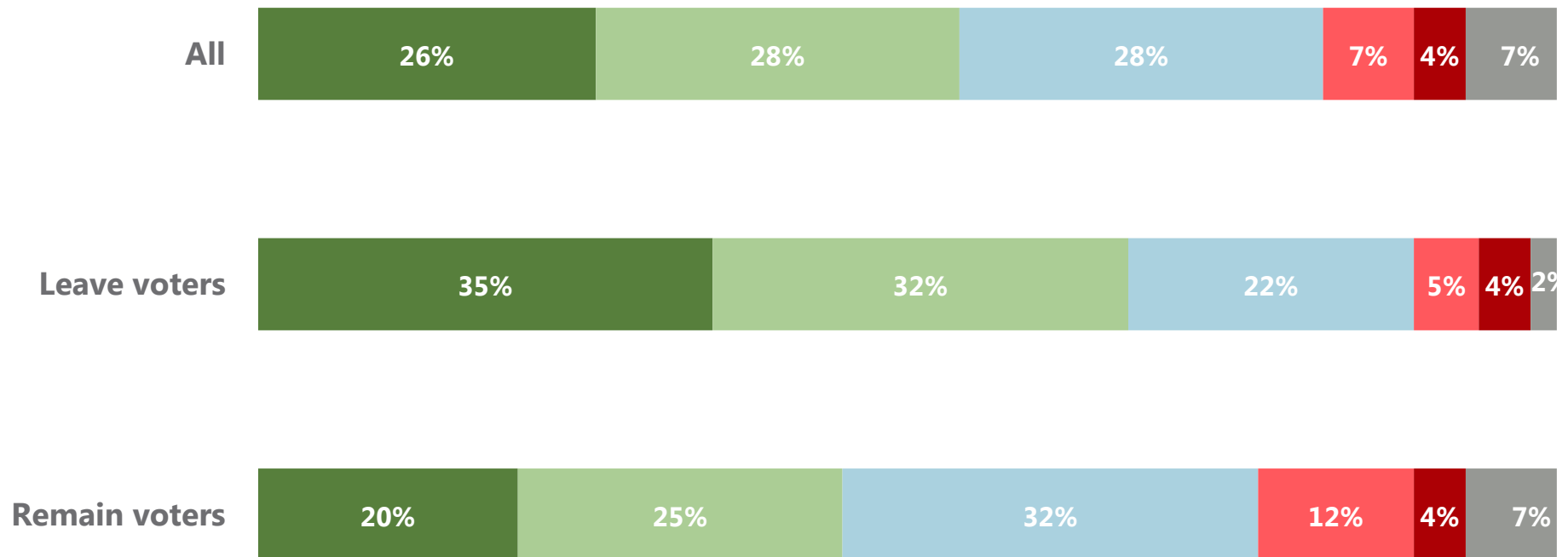

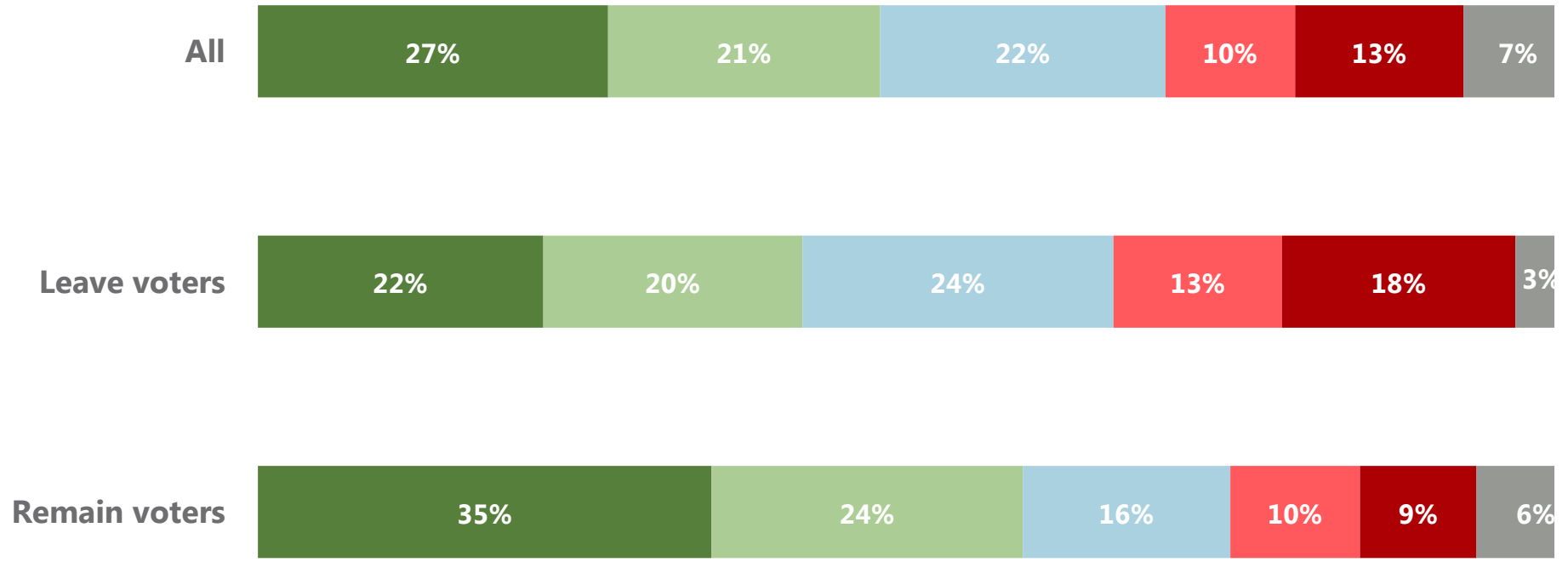

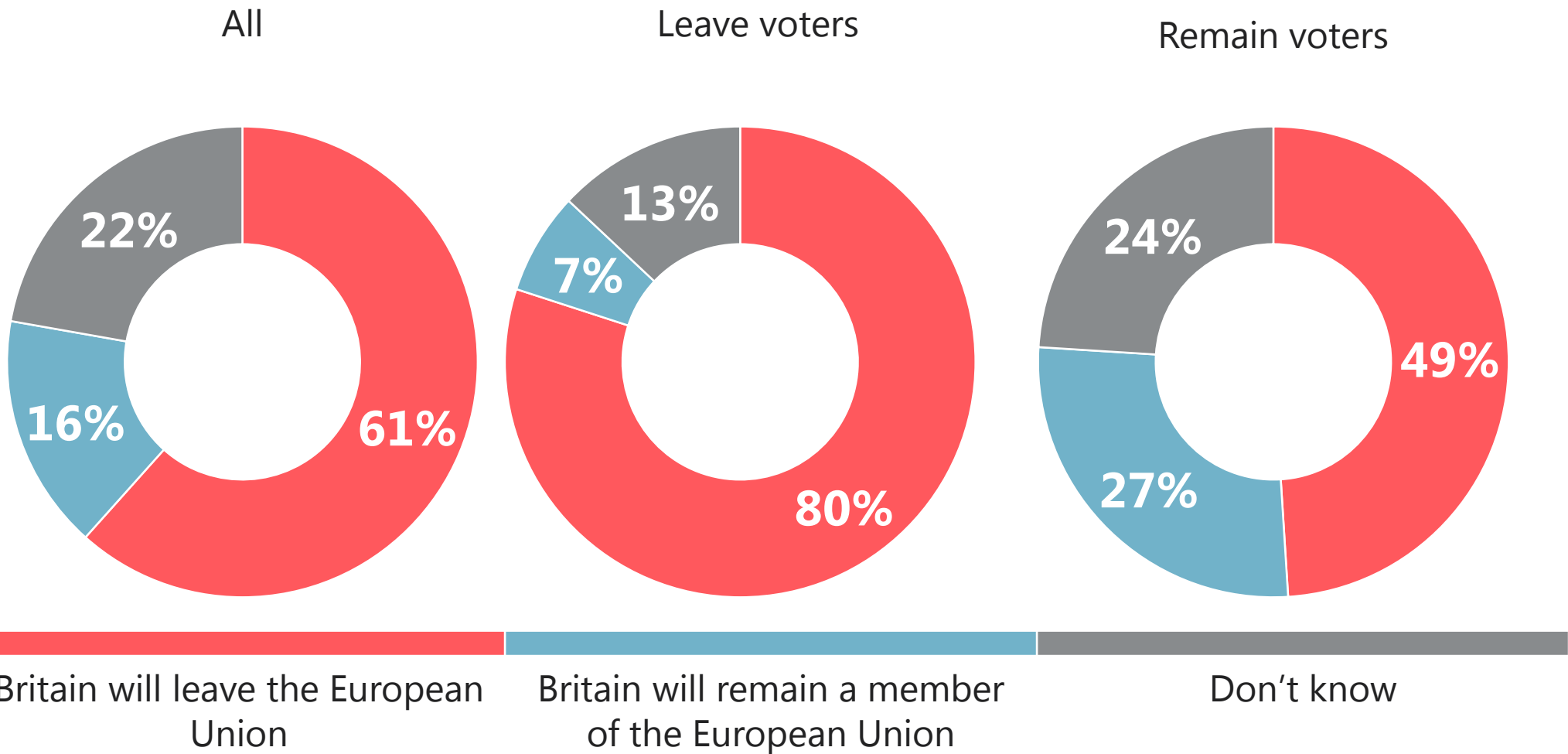

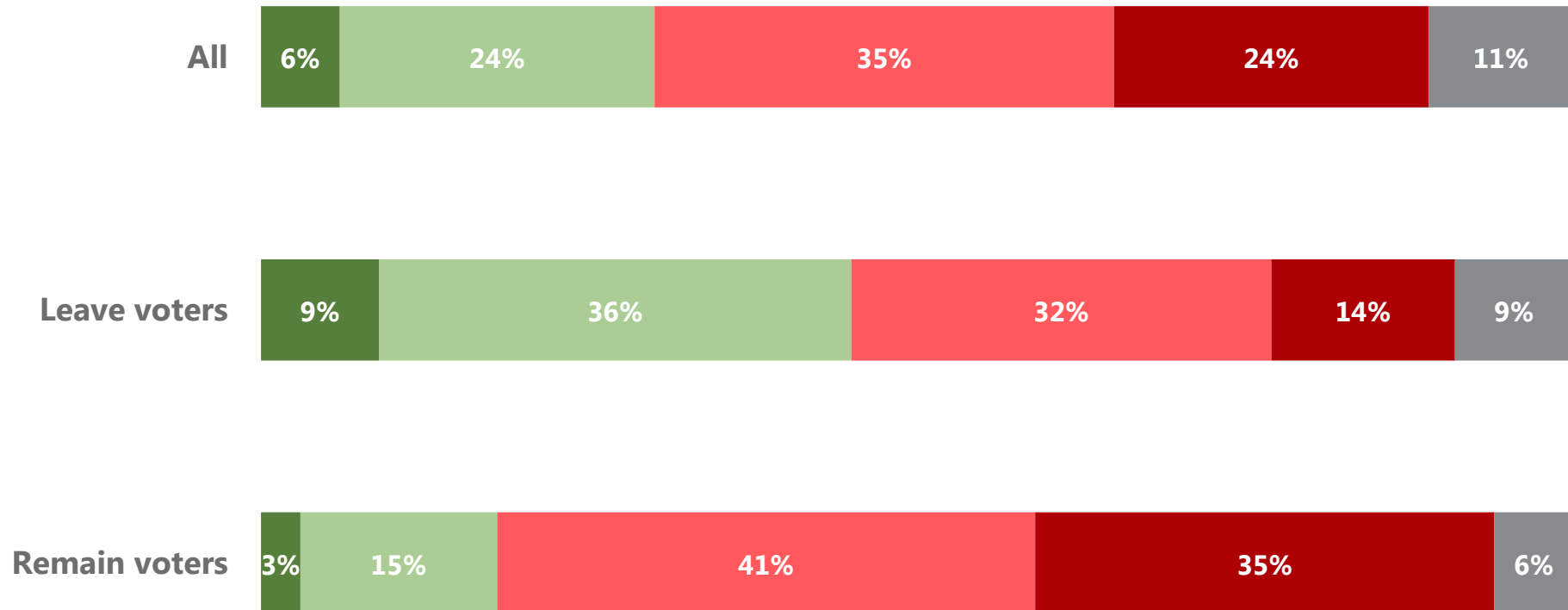

How confident, if at all, are you in Britain's political leaders to get the best possible terms of exit for Britain from the European Union?

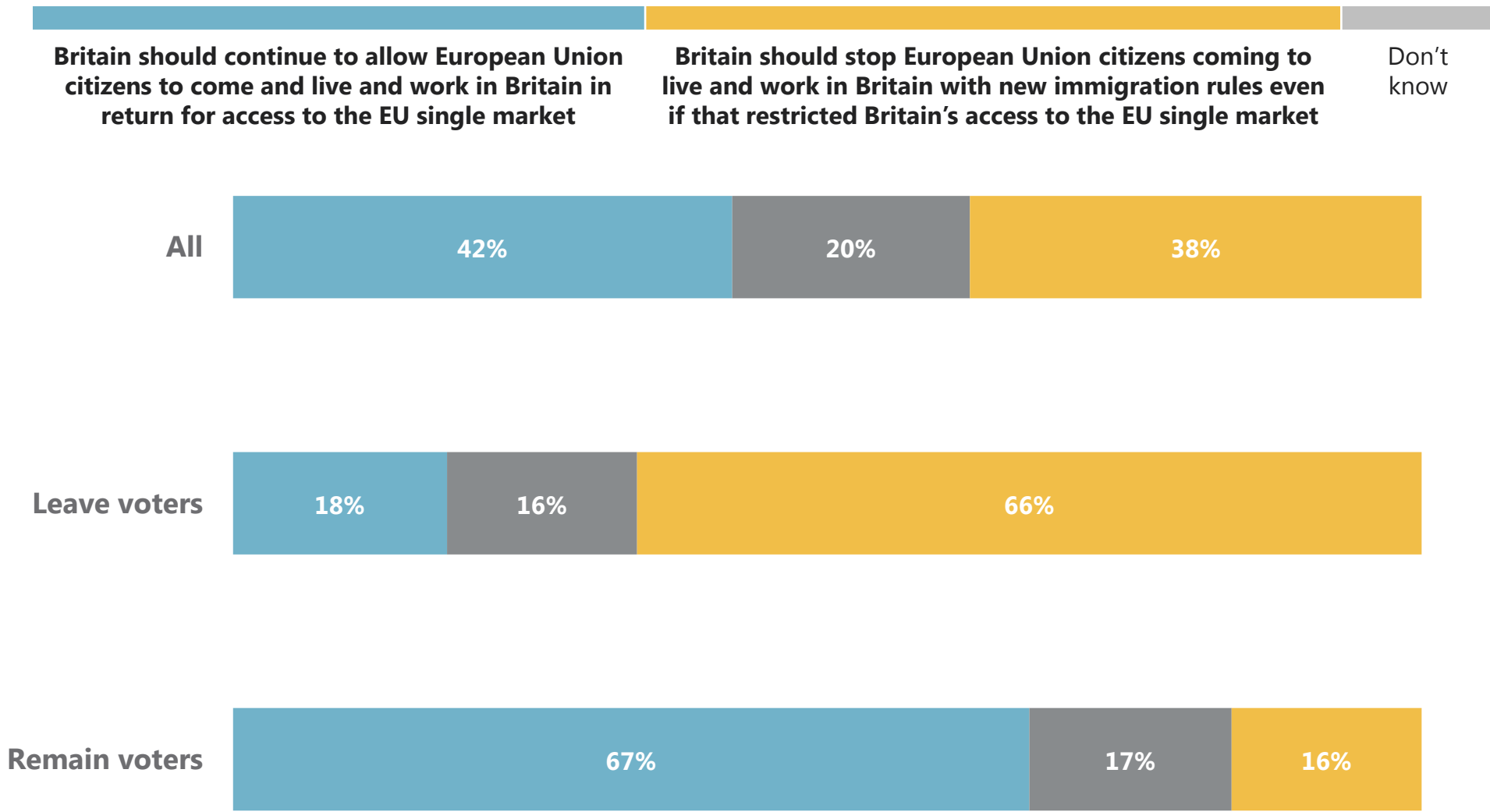
