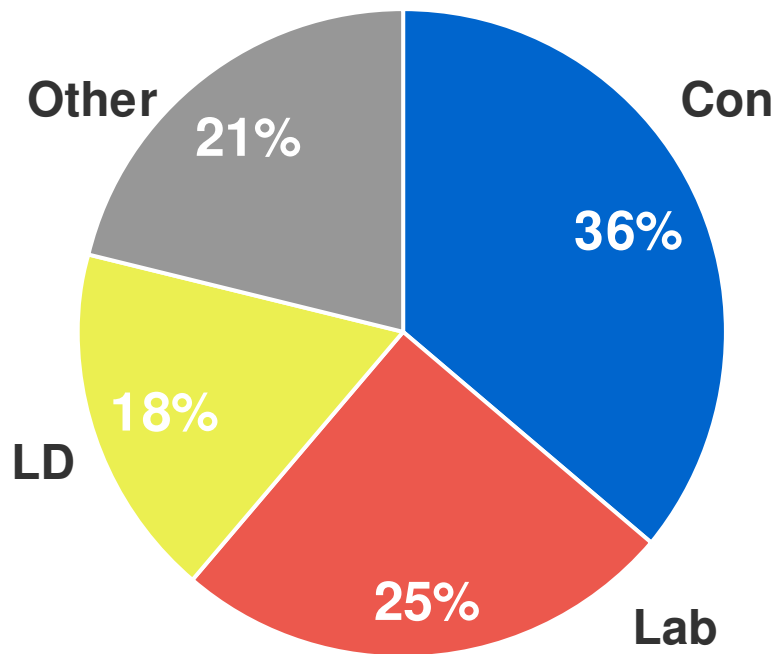

# Voting Intention: all giving an opinion vs. those “certain to vote”

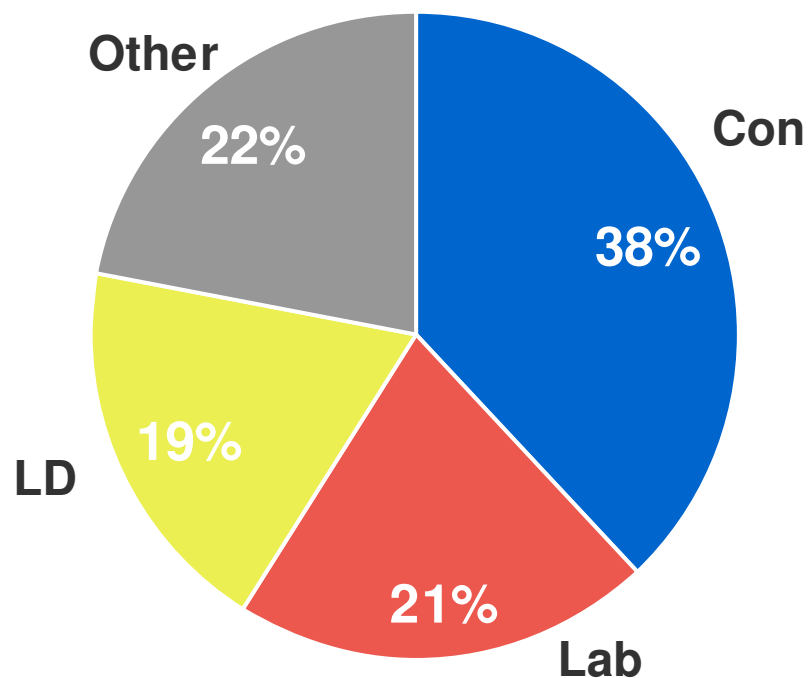
*How would you vote if there were a General Election tomorrow?*

**All giving a voting intention (75%)**



**Conservative lead = +11**

**All certain to vote (51%)**



**Conservative lead = +17**

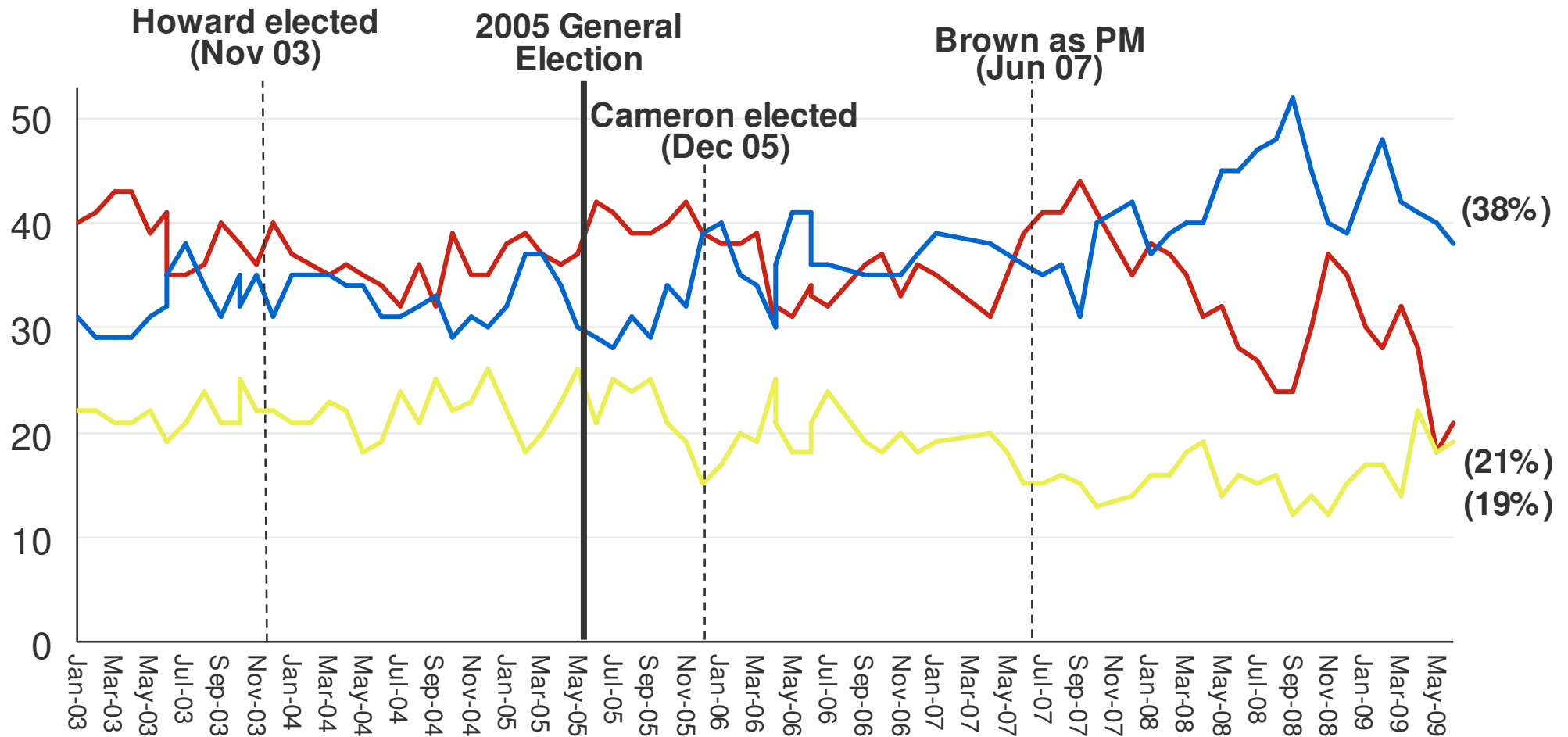

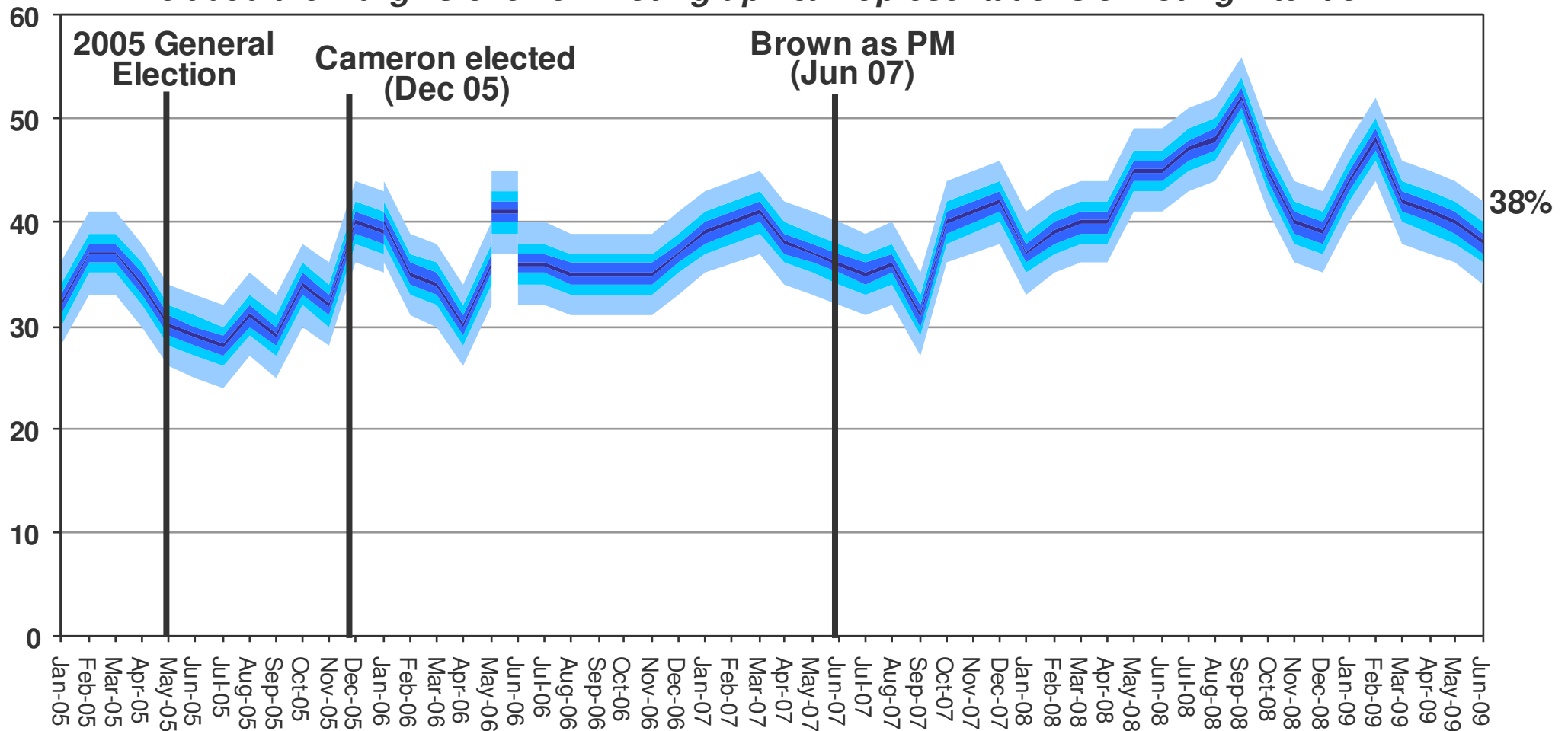

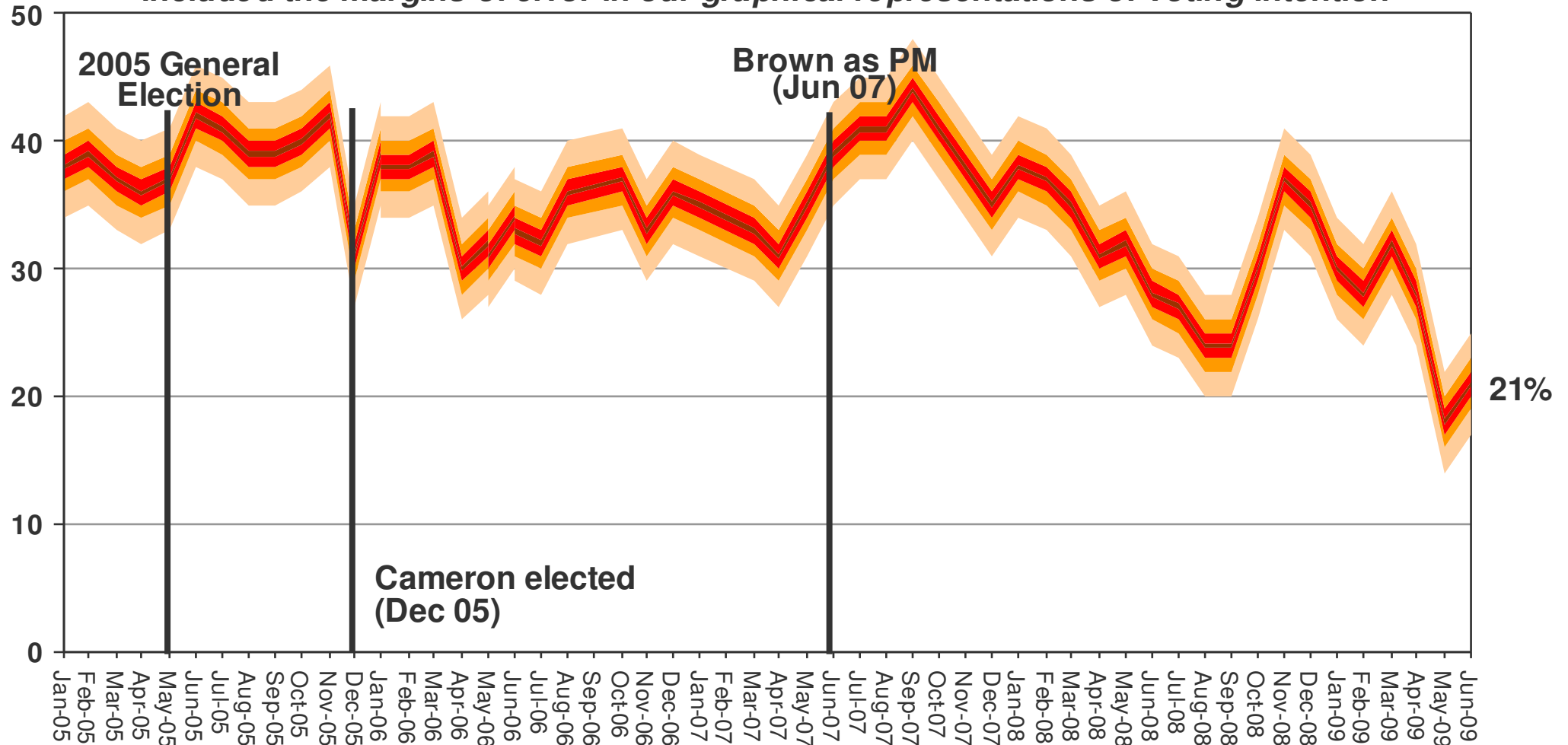

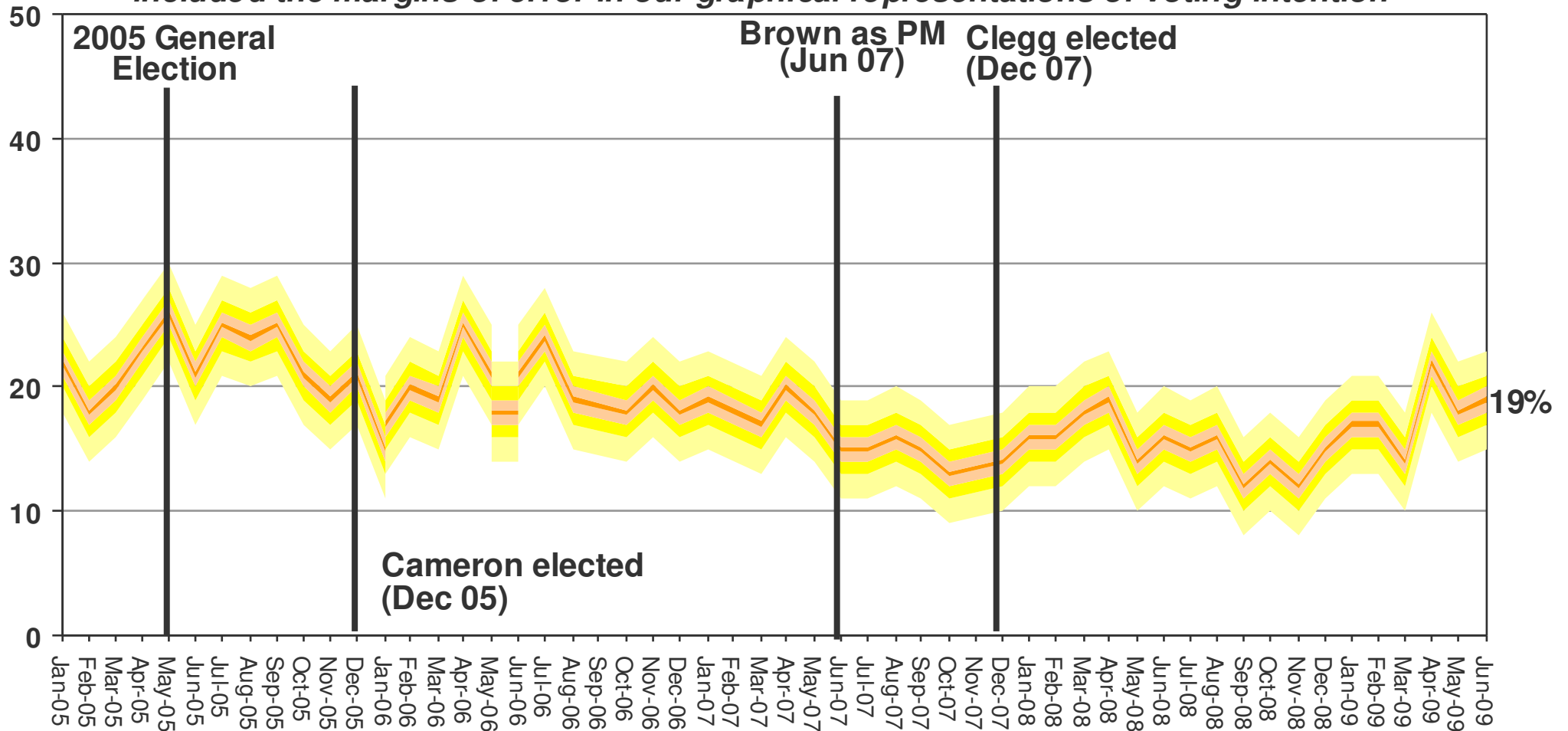

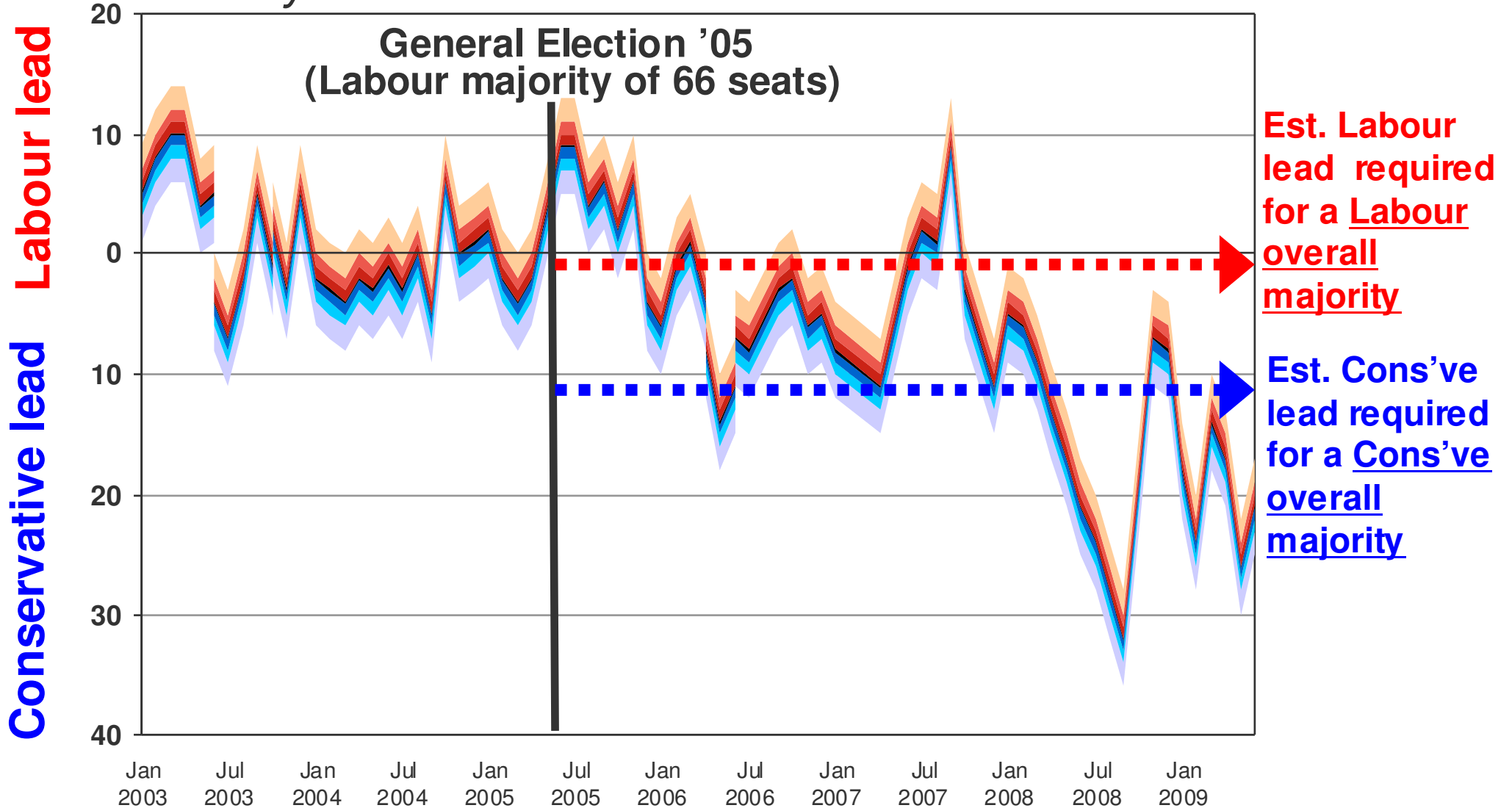

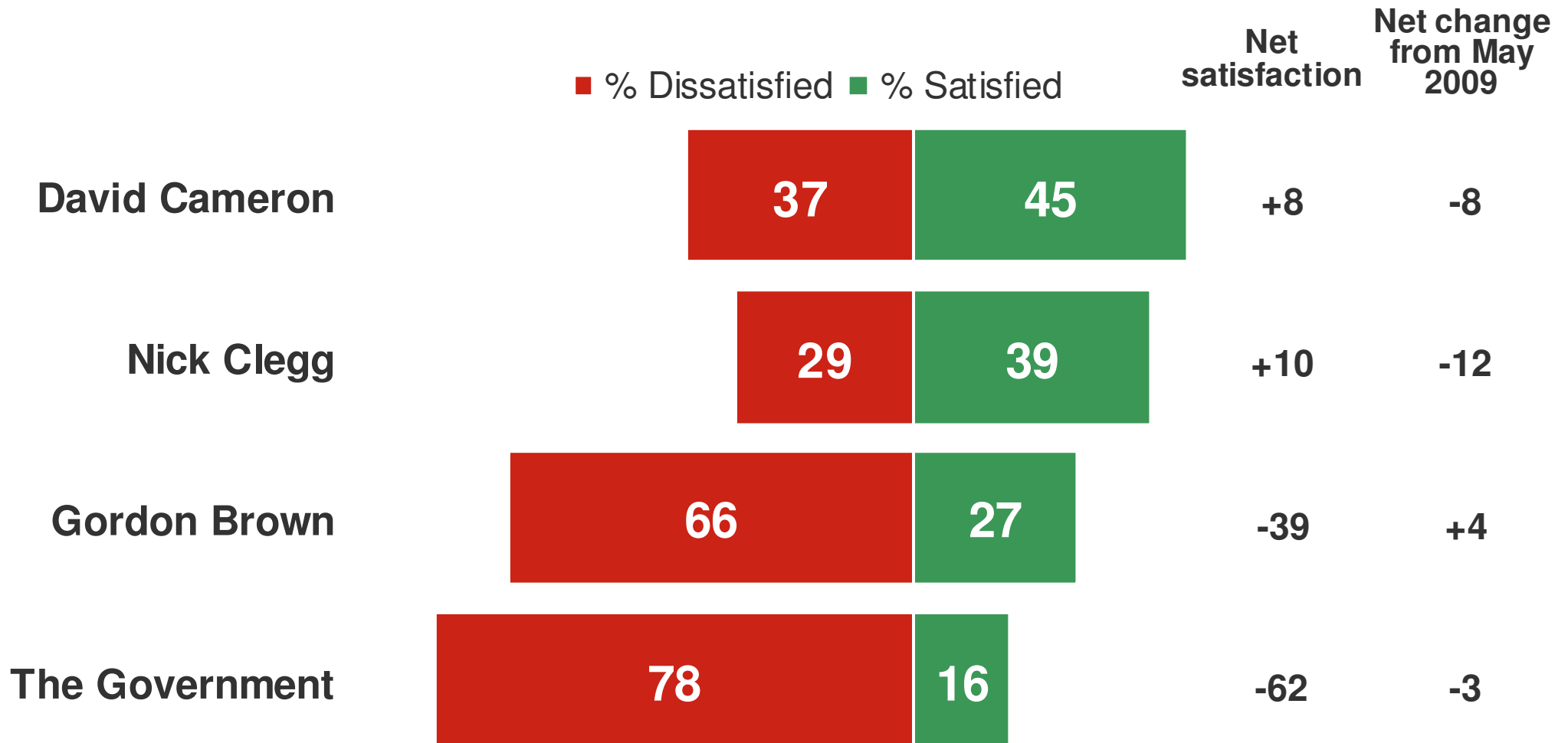

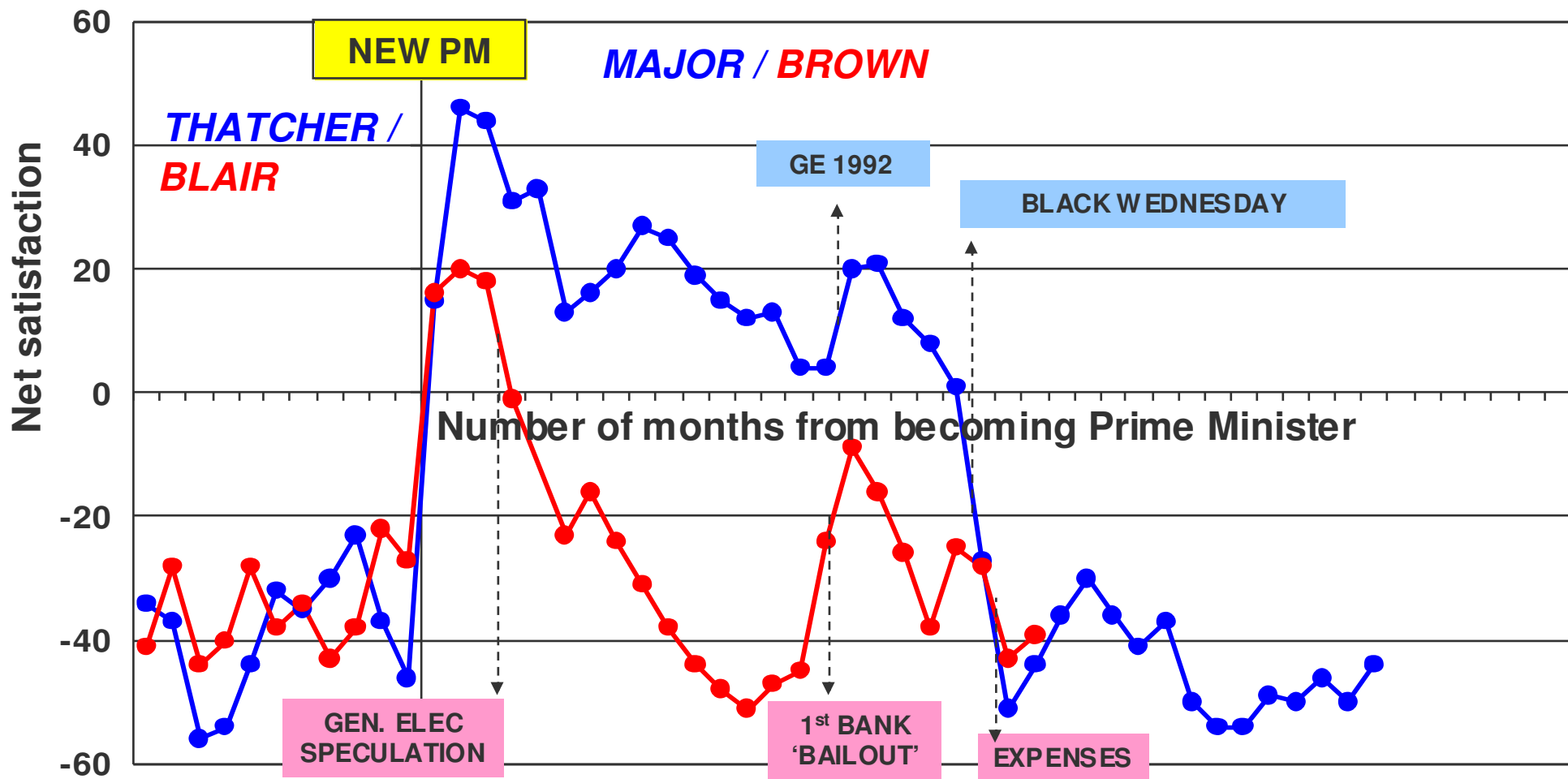

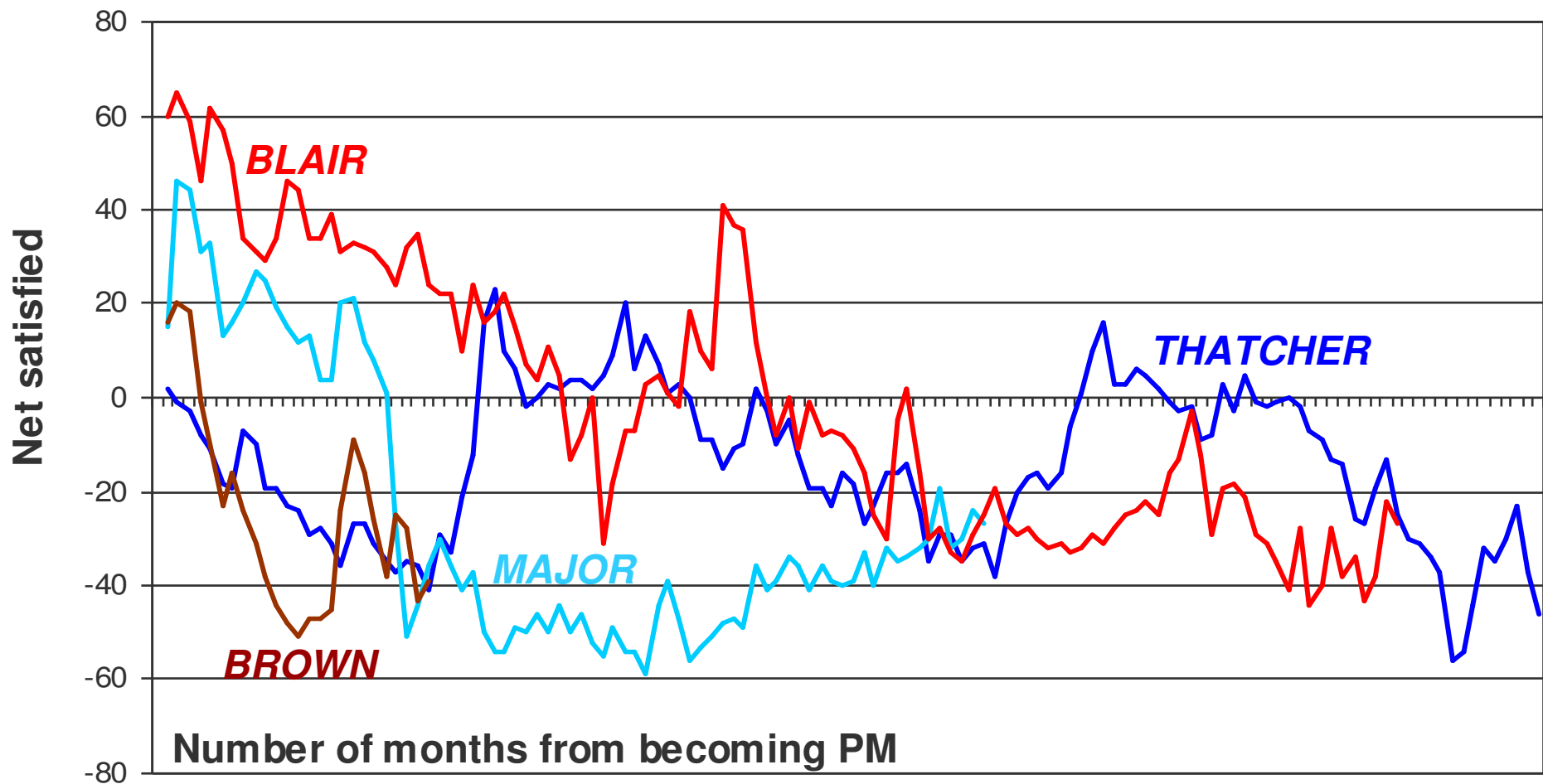

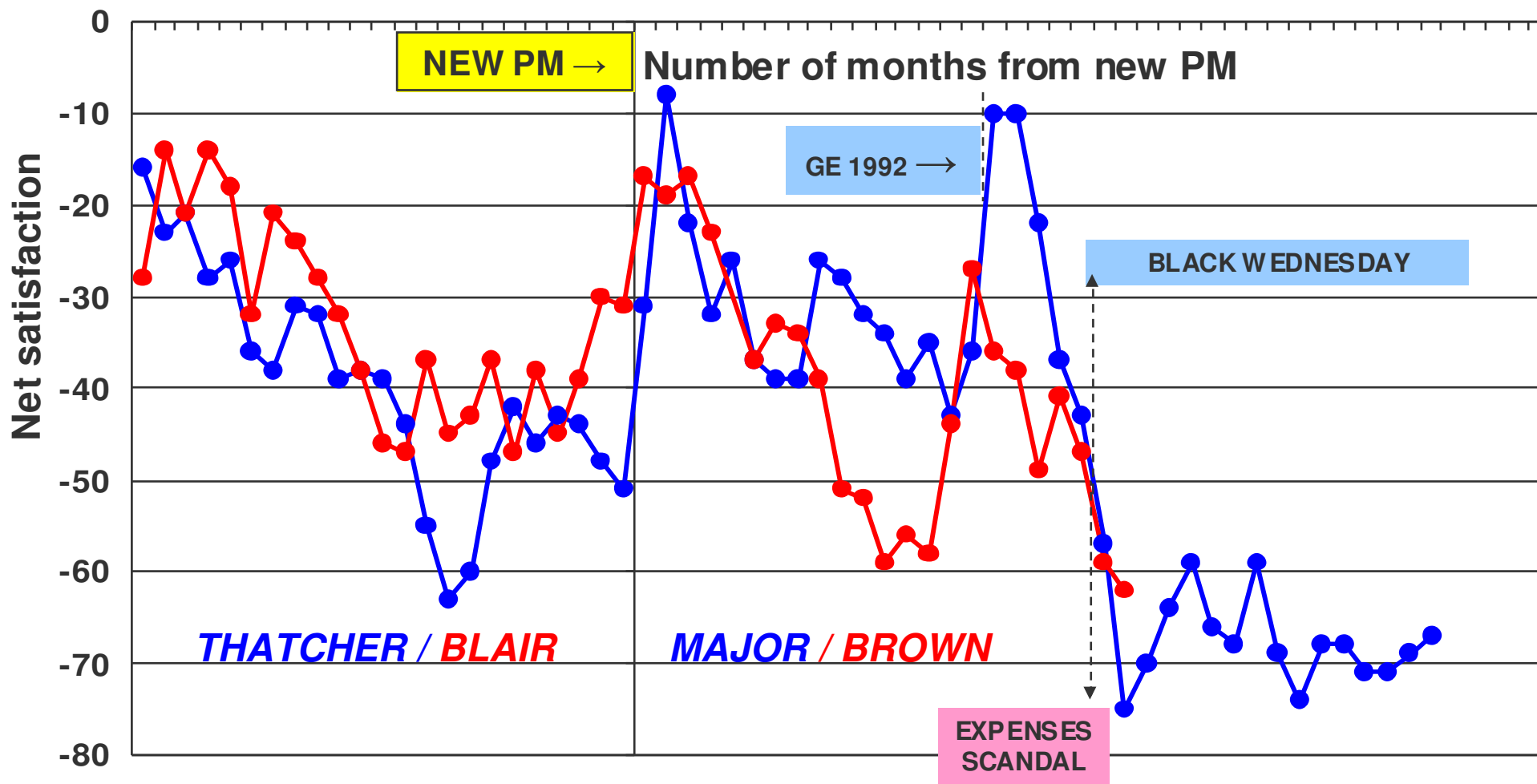

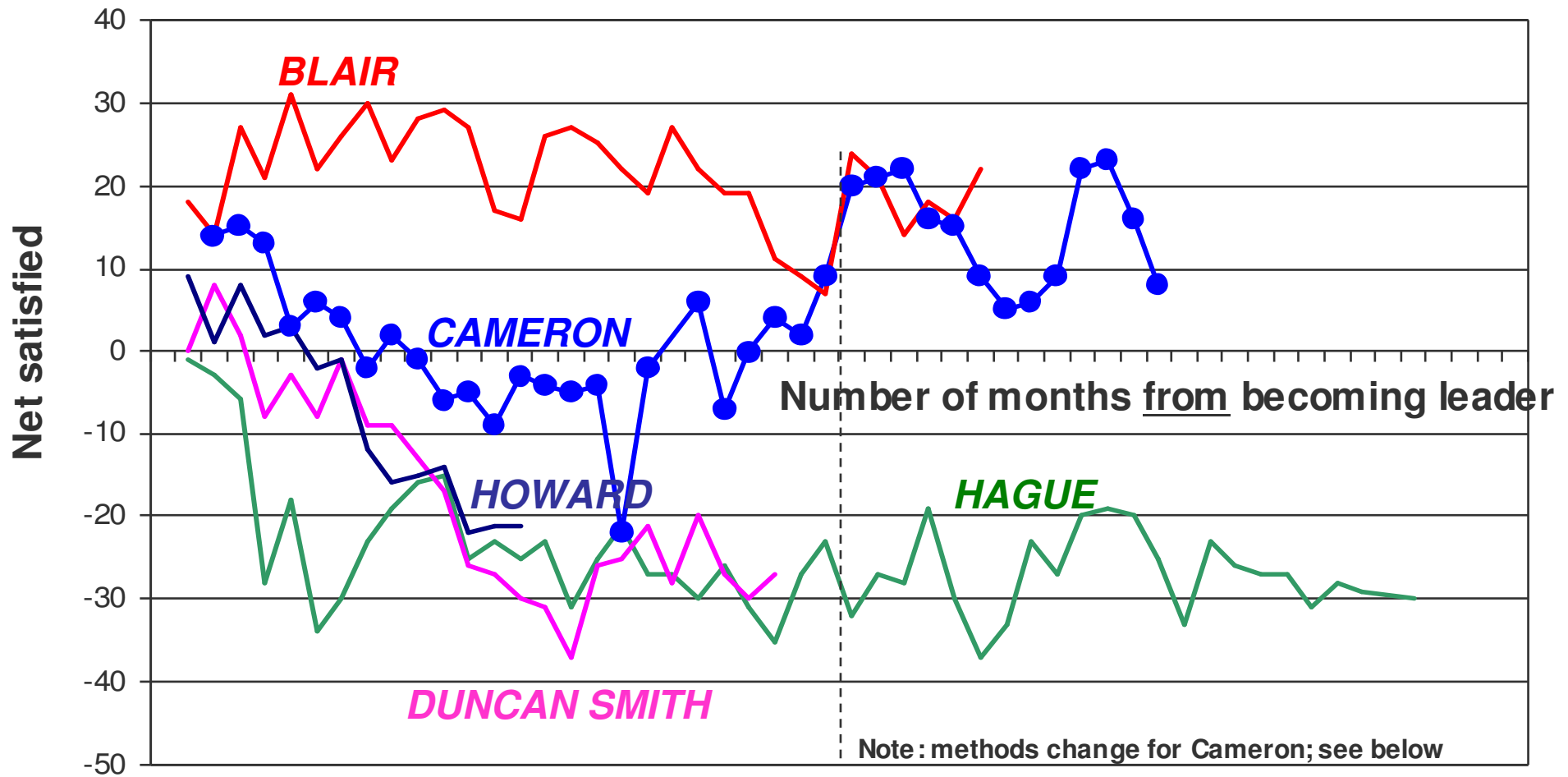

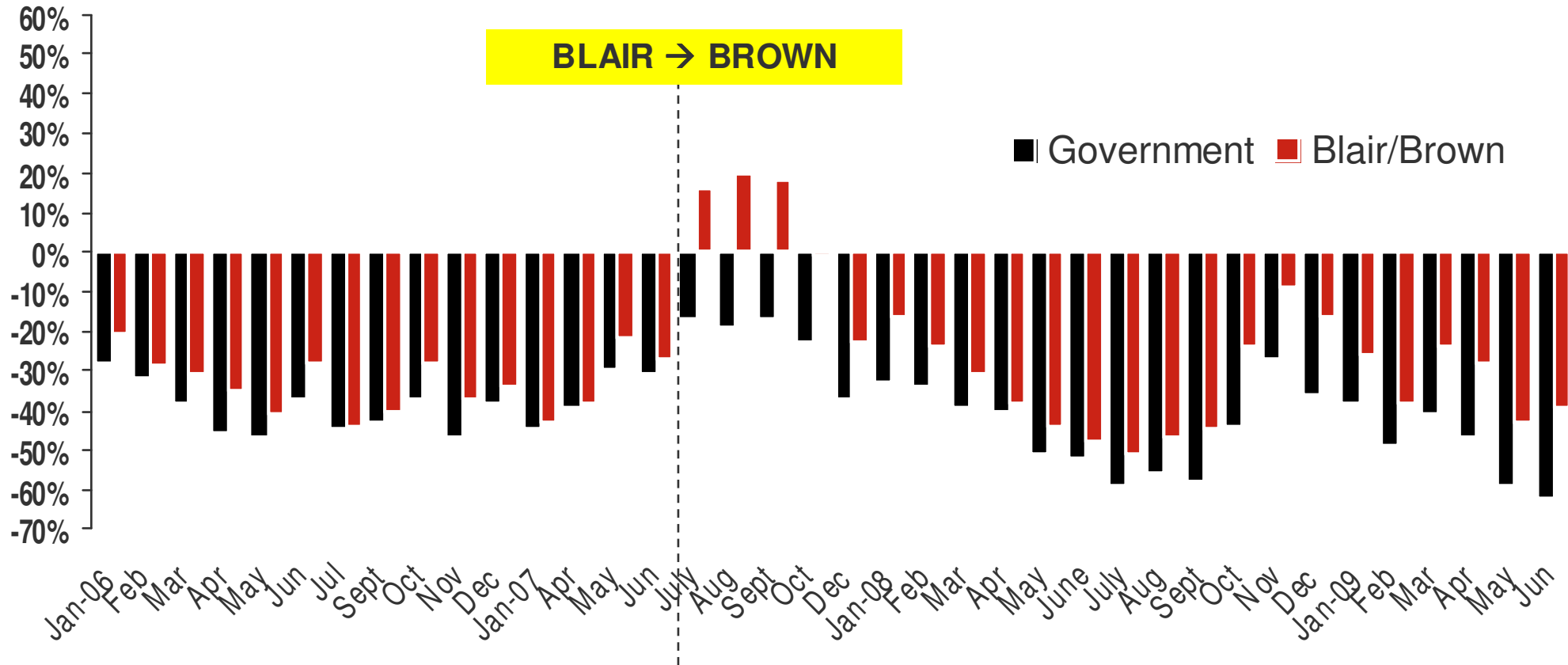

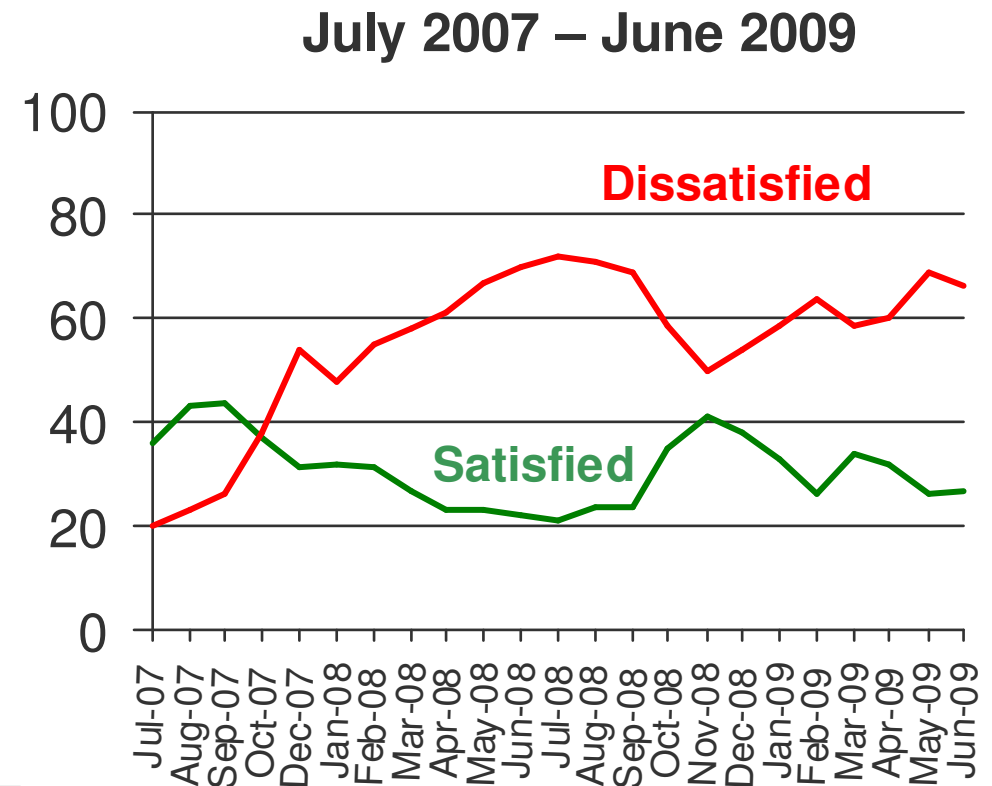

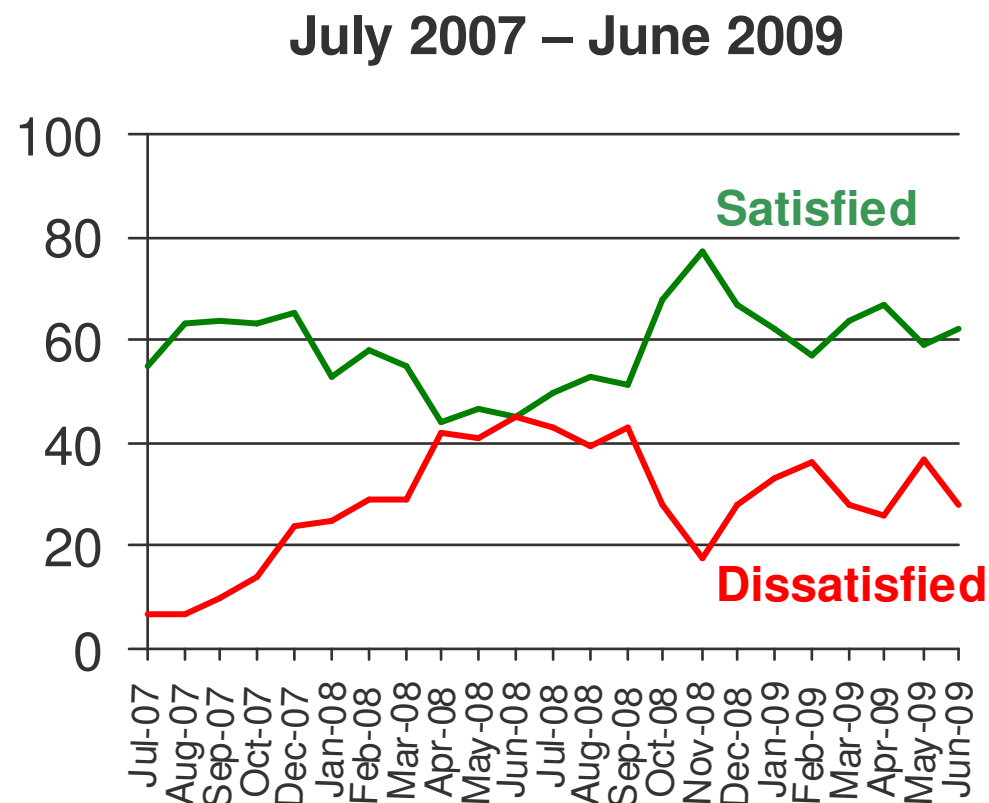
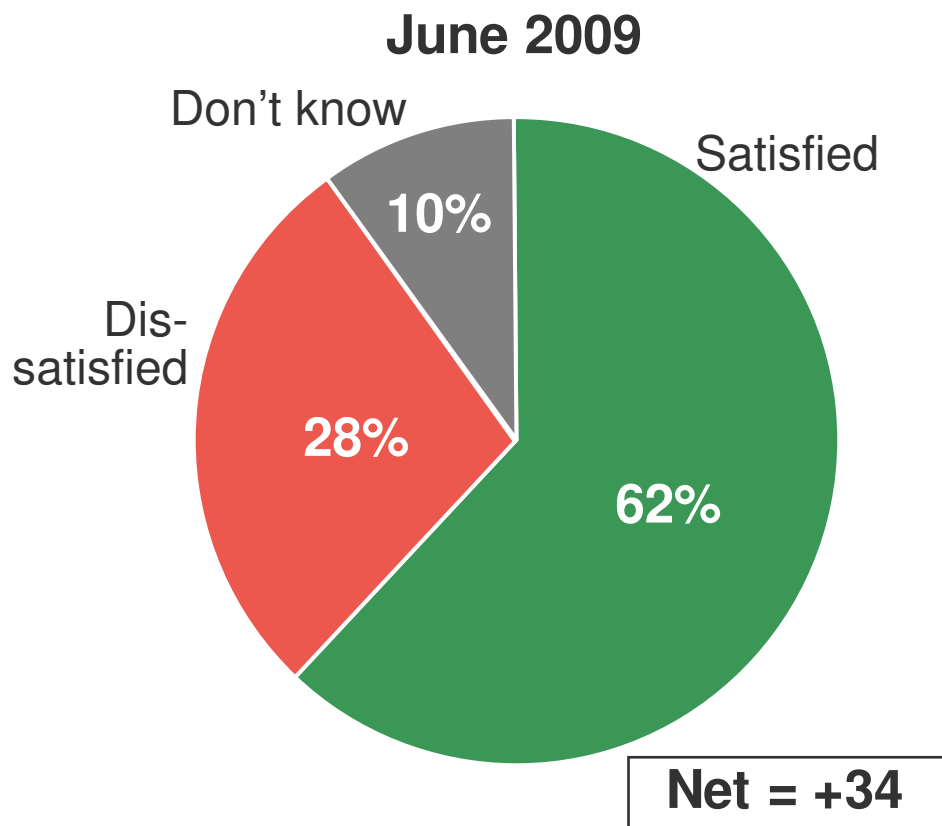

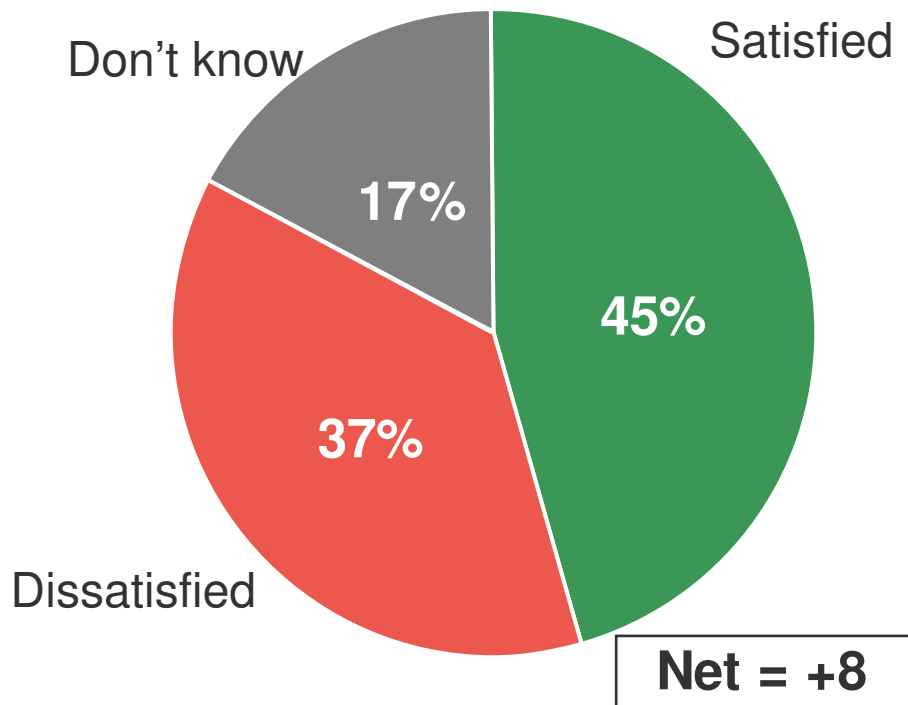

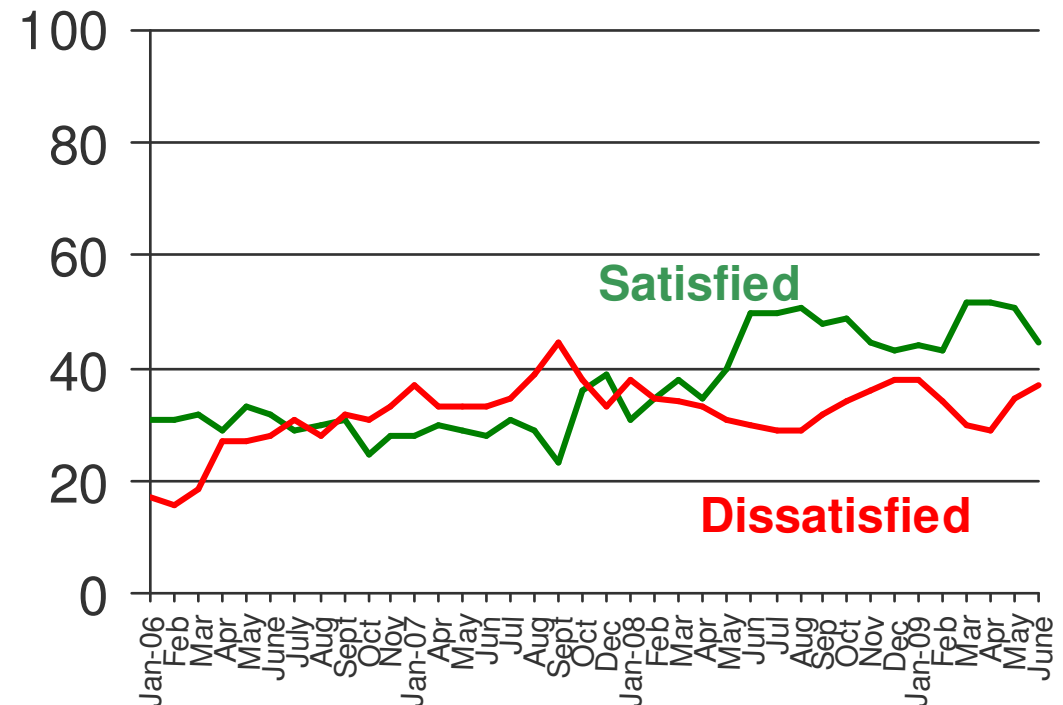

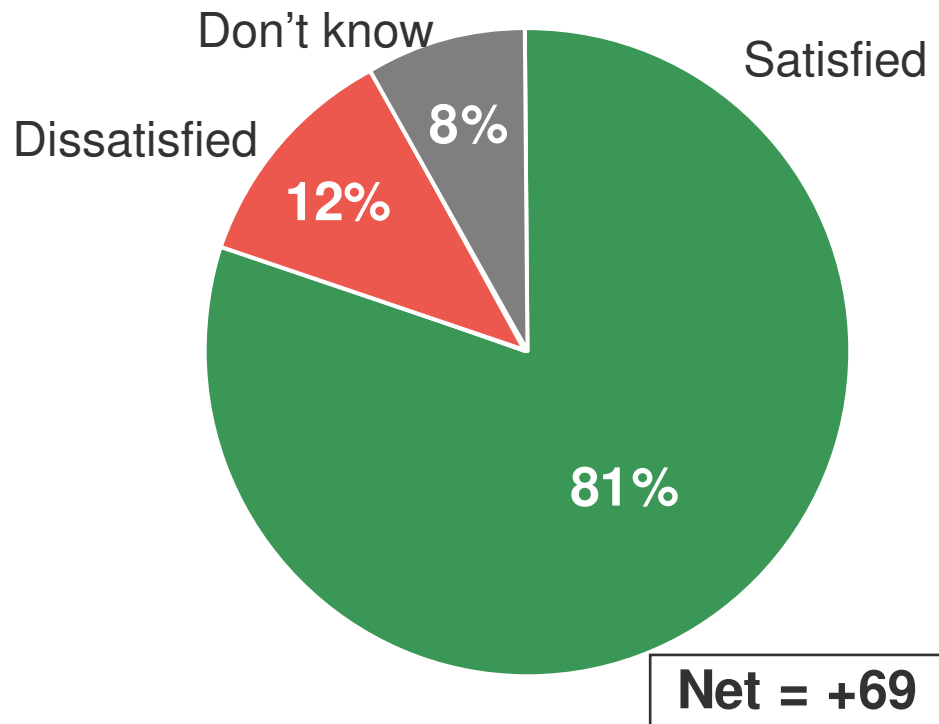

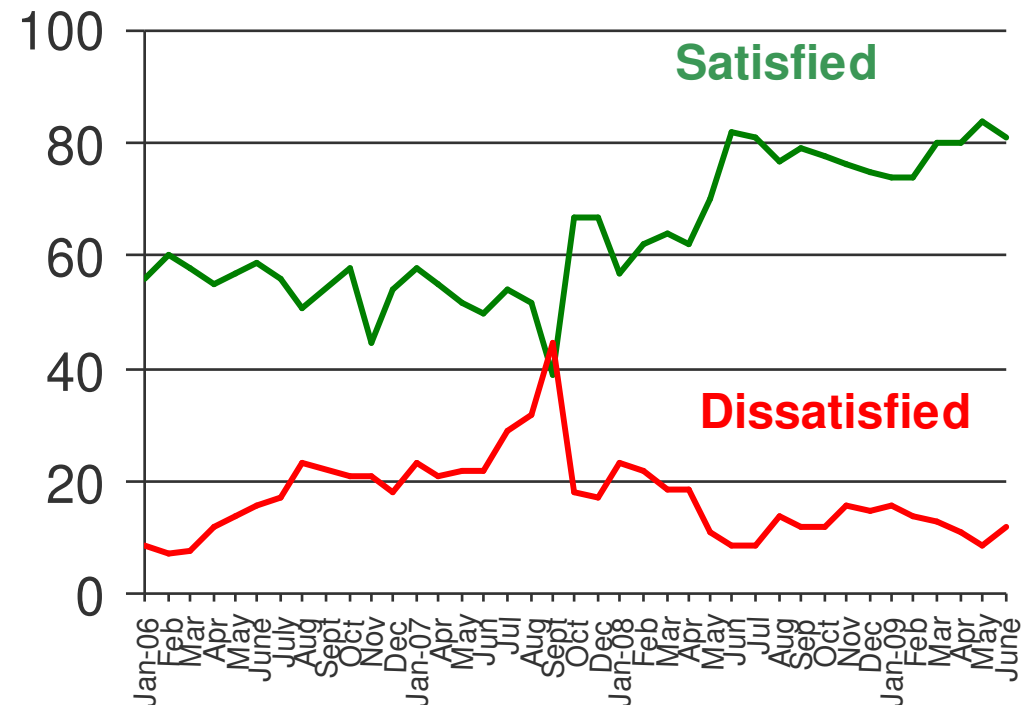
# David Cameron (satisfaction among Tory supporters)

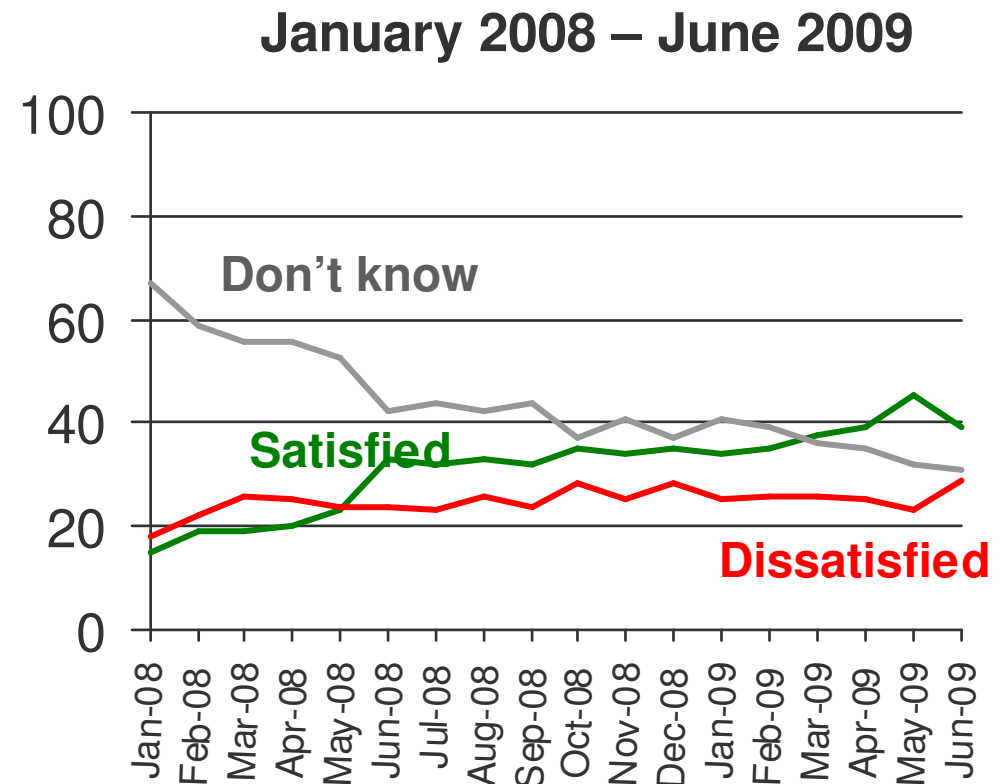
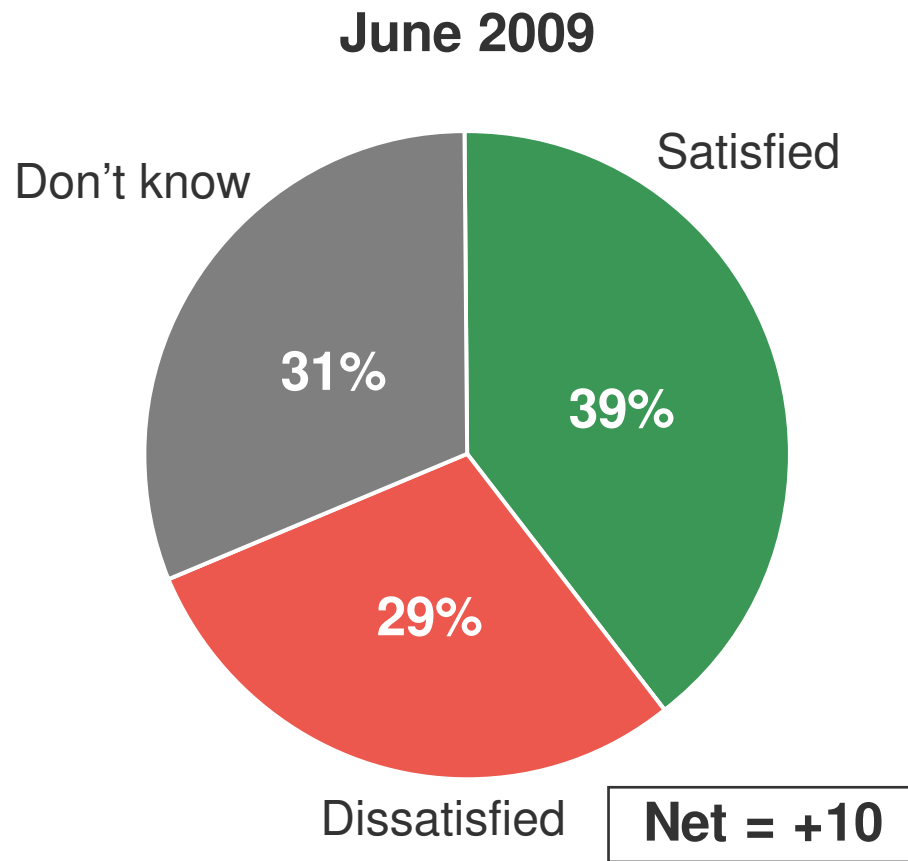

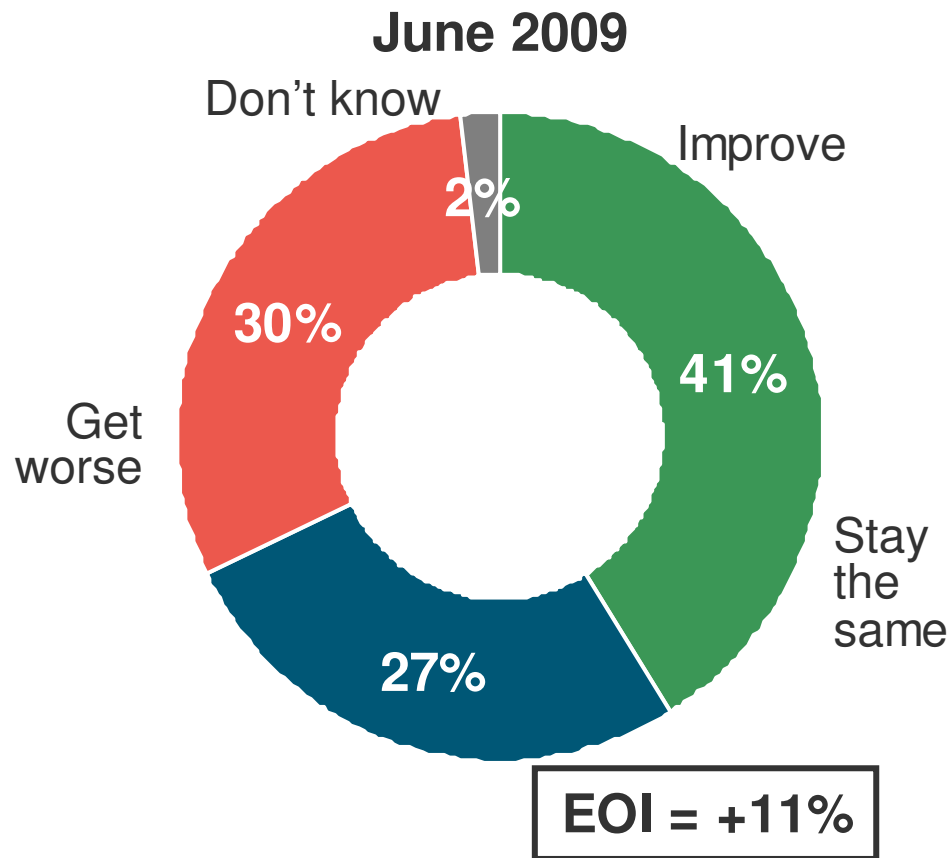

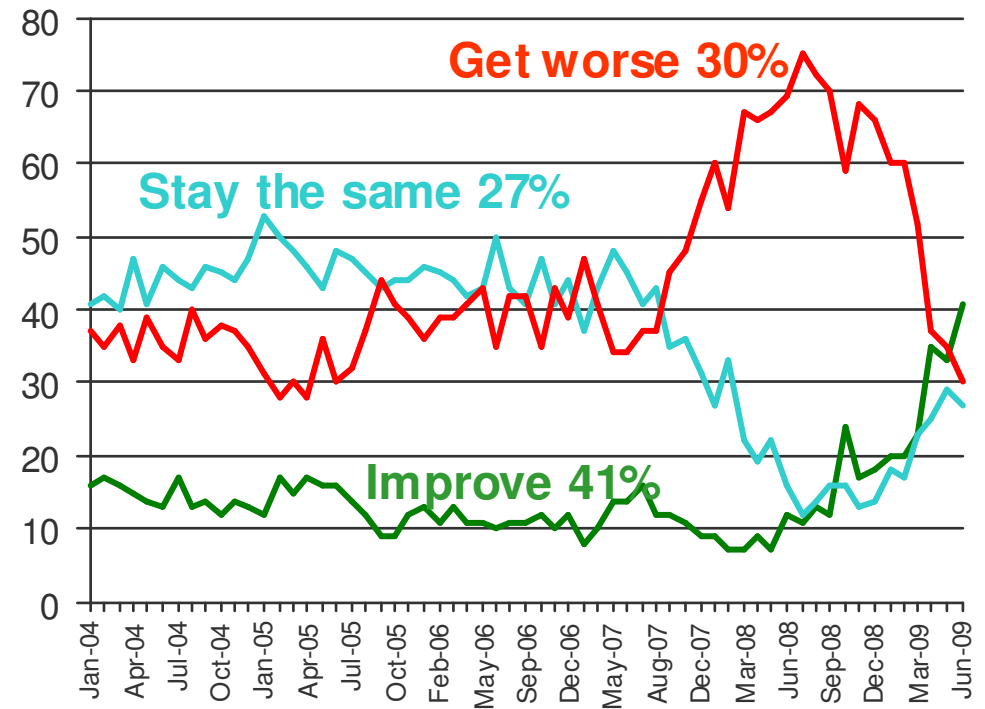

**January 2004 – June 2009**



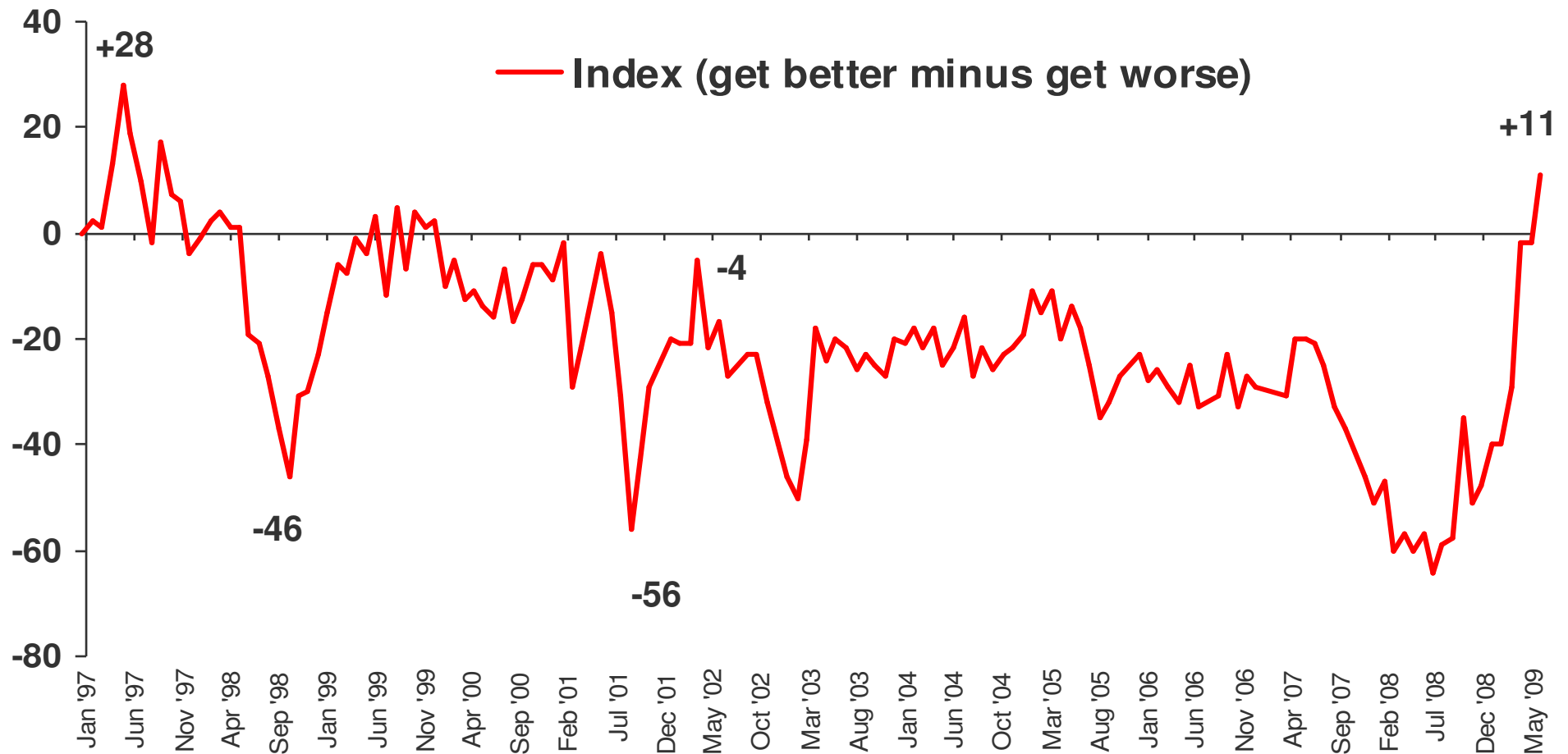

*Do you think that the general economic condition of the country will improve, stay the same or get worse over the next 12 months?*



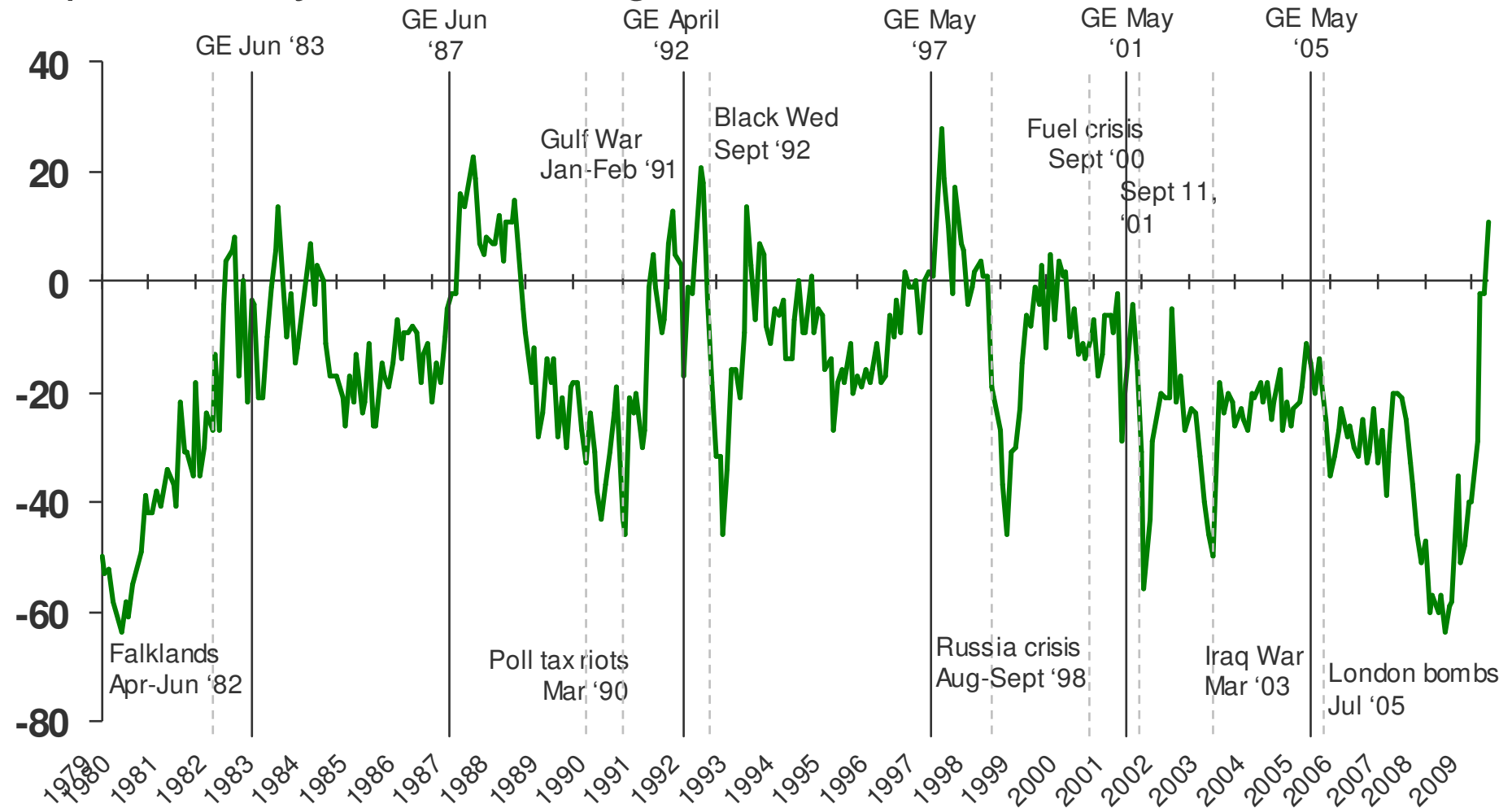
