

Political Poll for the News of the World Topline Findings 18.04.09

- Ipsos MORI interviewed a representative sample of 1,021 adults in Great Britain aged 18+
- Interviews were conducted by telephone on 17 April 2009
- Data are weighted to match the profile of the population
- Where percentages do not sum to 100, this may be due to computer rounding, the exclusion of "don't know" categories, or multiple answers.
- Throughout the volume, an asterisk (*) denotes any value of less than half of one per cent
