











Who those respondents in the 22 countries surveyed who are AWARE of ALL THREE CANDIDATES would like MOST to see as the next President of the United States:


- 55% would like <u>MOST</u> to see Barack Obama as the next President of the United States...






Of those respondents in the 22 countries surveyed who are <u>AWARE of ALL THREE CANDIDATES</u>:

- 65% are following the 2008 Presidential election in the United States <u>Somewhat</u> Closely ...
- 20% are <u>NOT Following</u> the 2008 Presidential election in the United States <u>Closely At All</u> ...





METHODOLOGY:

These are the findings of an Ipsos poll conducted on behalf of the AI Jazeera English Network involving a sample of 22,605 respondents, with a minimum of 1,000 interviews per country, across the Ipsos global online panel access network. The field window was April 15 through May 22, 2008. The margin of error per country is +/-3.1, 19 times out of 20.
