

### The Global Vulnerability Index

Global Citizens Feel More Vulnerable Than They Did One Year Ago

Sense of Vulnerability Fueled by Two of Eight Threats in 2014: Armed Conflict and Major Health Epidemic











#### Methodology...

These are findings of the research conducted by global research company Ipsos for the Halifax International Security Forum.

Conducted between October 5<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014.

Sample of 17,581 respondents in 23 countries were interviewed: Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Brazil, Canada, France, Germany, Great Britain, Hungary, India, Italy, Japan, Mexico, Poland, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, Turkey and the United States.

Interviews were conducted among adults aged 18-64 in the US and Canada and aged 16-64 in all other countries. Approximately 1000+ individuals participated on a country by country basis via the Ipsos Online Panel with the exception of Argentina, Belgium, Hungary, India, Mexico, Poland, Romania, Russia, Saudi Arabia, South Africa, South Korea, Sweden and Turkey where each have a sample approximately 500+.

The precision of Ipsos online polls are calculated using a credibility interval. In this case, a poll of 1,000 is accurate to +/- 3.5 percentage points and one of 500 is accurate to +/- 5.0 percentage points in their respective general populations. There are 15 countries that have been weighted to represent their actual adult population: Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Canada, France, Germany, Hungary, Italy, Japan, Poland, South Korea, Spain, Sweden, United Kingdom and the United States. The remaining nine country results are representative of adult Primary Consumers who are internet enabled and have a higher income and education than the average country norm.





### Canada Threat Assessment: Potential for Happening in Next 12 Months...












#### Six in 10 (59% +13): A major health epidemic breaking out in your country...









# **Global Vulnerability Index**

Perceived Potential Threats vs Perceived Confidence of Governments/Agencies to Respond/Protect



#### The World Feels More Vulnerable than at this time Last Year:

Total Global Vulnerability Index Ranking (total threat minus total confident divided by eight categories = +/- "secure/vulnerable"):

Worse Overall: -9.875 (versus -9.250 in 2013 = -.625)

Better on Computer Hacking: Some person, organization or country hacking into either your public, private or personal information system for fraudulent or espionage purposes: -23.0 (versus -27.0 in 2013 = +4.0)

Better on a Major Attack: A nuclear, biological or chemical attack taking place somewhere in the world: -16.0 (versus -24.0 in 2013 = +8.0)

Methodology: 8 Perceived Threats vs Perceived Confidence of Governments/Agencies to protect them from threats.



#### The World Feels More Vulnerable than at this time Last Year:

Worse on a major health epidemic breaking out in your country: - 11.0 (versus -3.0 in 2013 = -8.0)

Worse on a terrorist attack taking place in your country: -9.0 (versus -7.0 in 2013 = -2.0)

Better on the personal safety and security for you or your family members being violated: -7.0 (versus -12.0 in 2013 = +5.0)

Better on a violent conflict breaking out between ethnic or minority groups in your country: -5.0 (versus -7.0 in 2013 = + 2.0)

Worse on your country being involved in an armed conflict with another nation: -5.0 (versus + 4.0 in 2013 = -9.0)

Worse on a major natural disaster occurring in your country: -3.0 (versus +2.0 in 2013 = -5.0)






#### Threat Index *Total* Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable








2014 Threat Index Some person, organization or country hacking into either your public, private or personal information system for fraudulent or espionage purposes Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable






### **2014** Threat Index A nuclear, biological or chemical attack taking place somewhere in the world Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable






### 2014 Threat Index A major health epidemic breaking out in your country Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable






### Threat Index A terrorist attack taking place in your country








# **2014** Threat Index *The personal safety and security for you and your family members being violated* Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable






# 2014 Threat Index A violent conflict breaking out between ethnic or minority groups in your country Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable






## 2014 Threat Index Your country being involved in an armed conflict with another nation Green = Secure Red = Vulnerable
