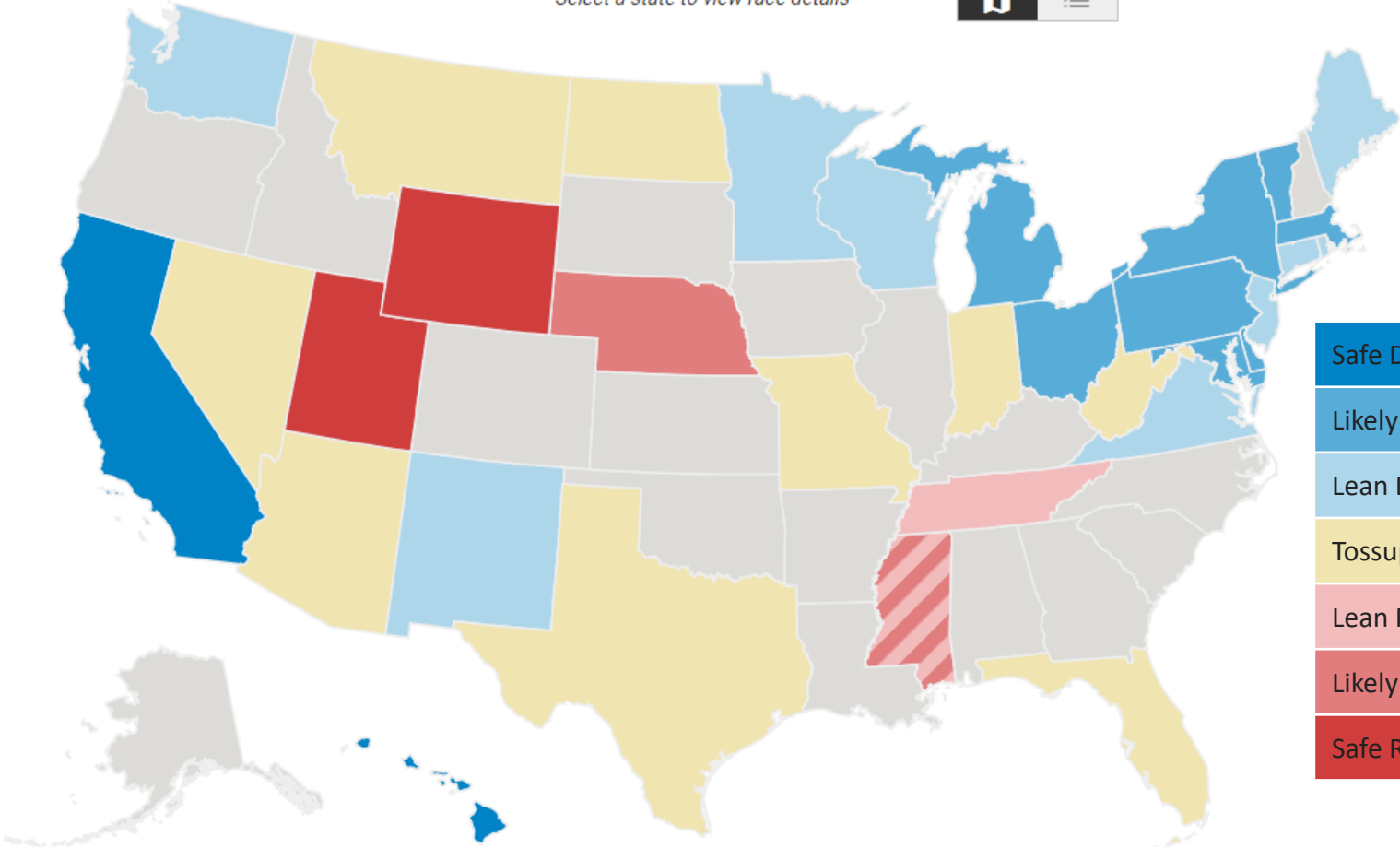

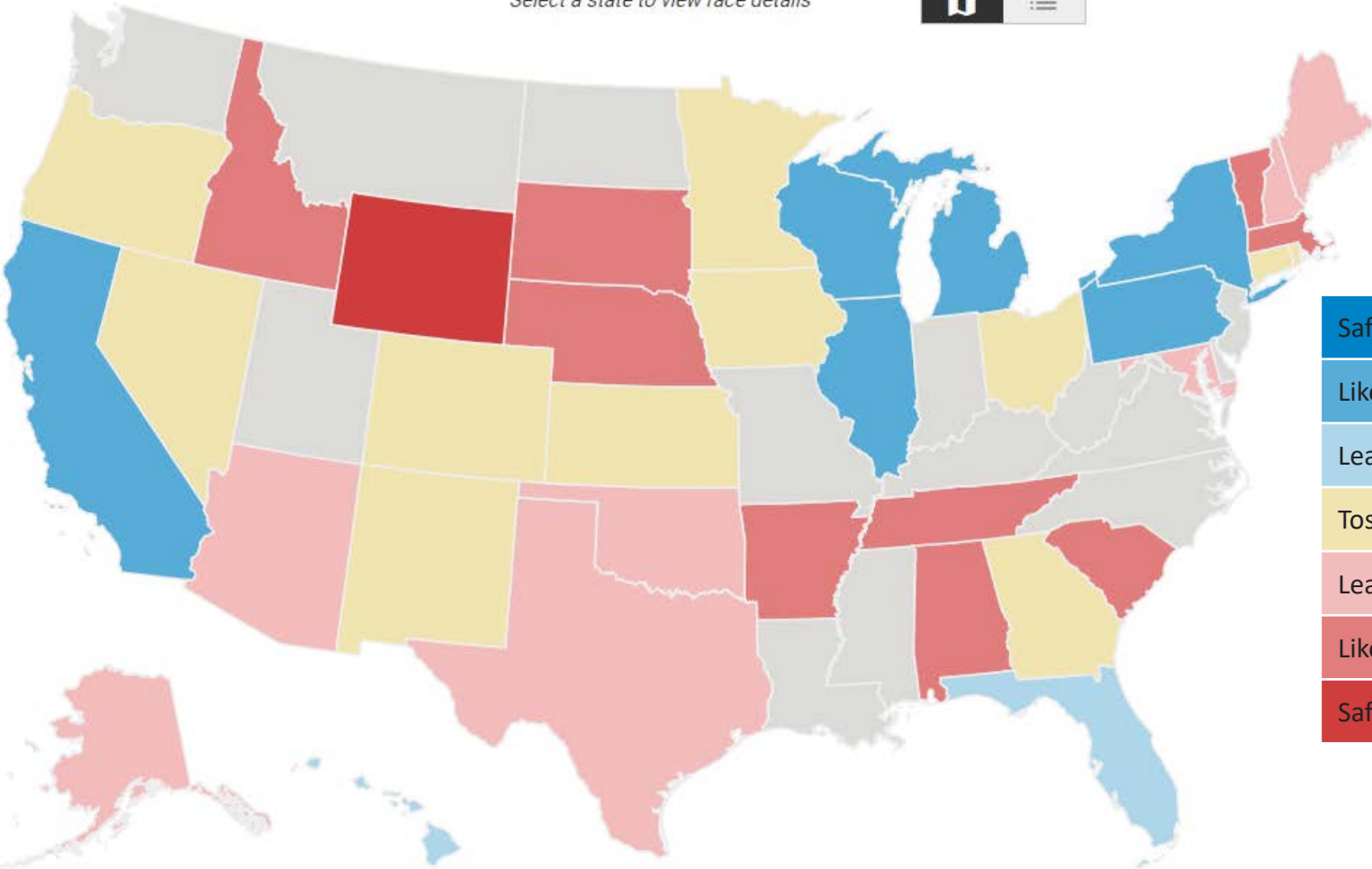

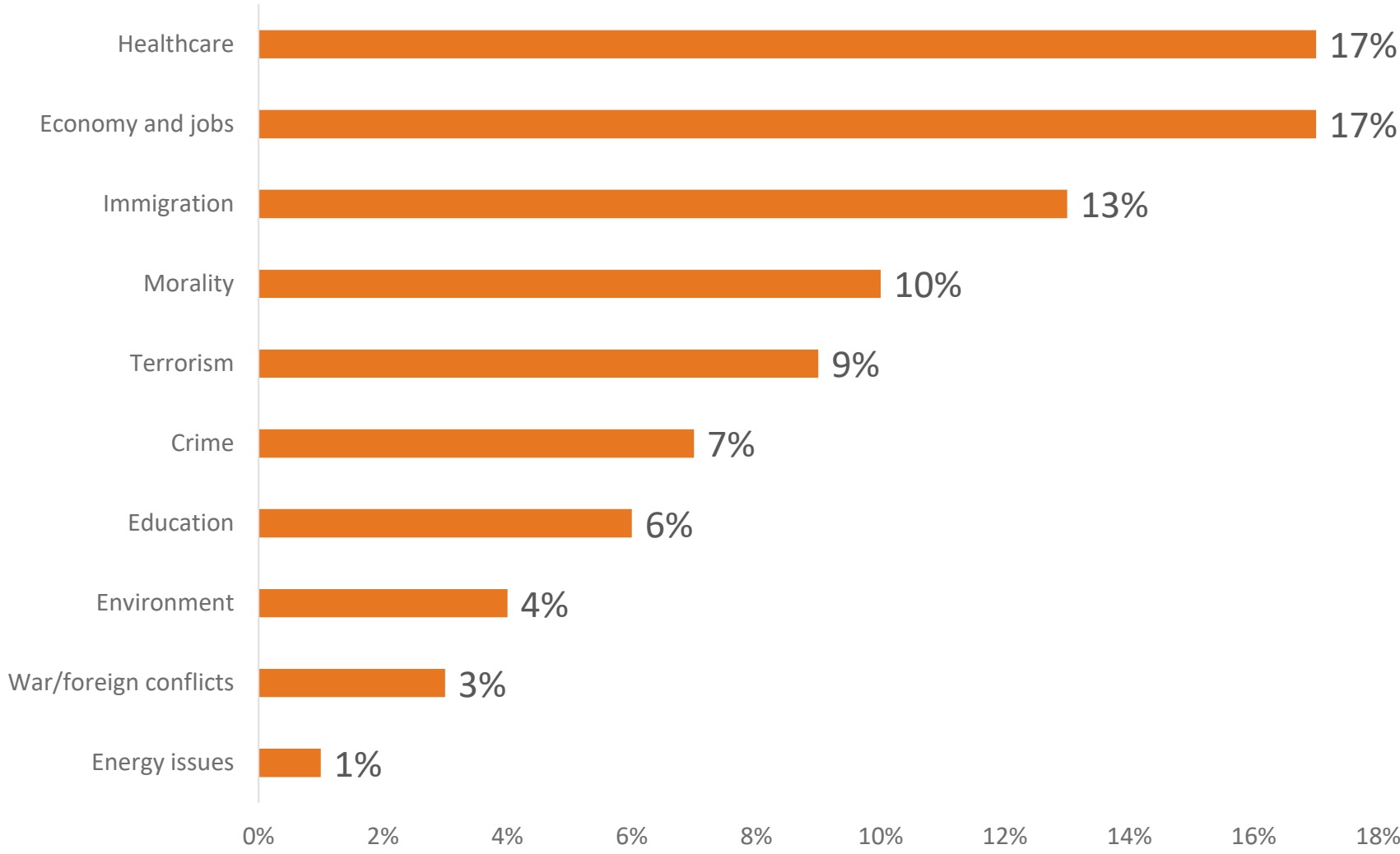

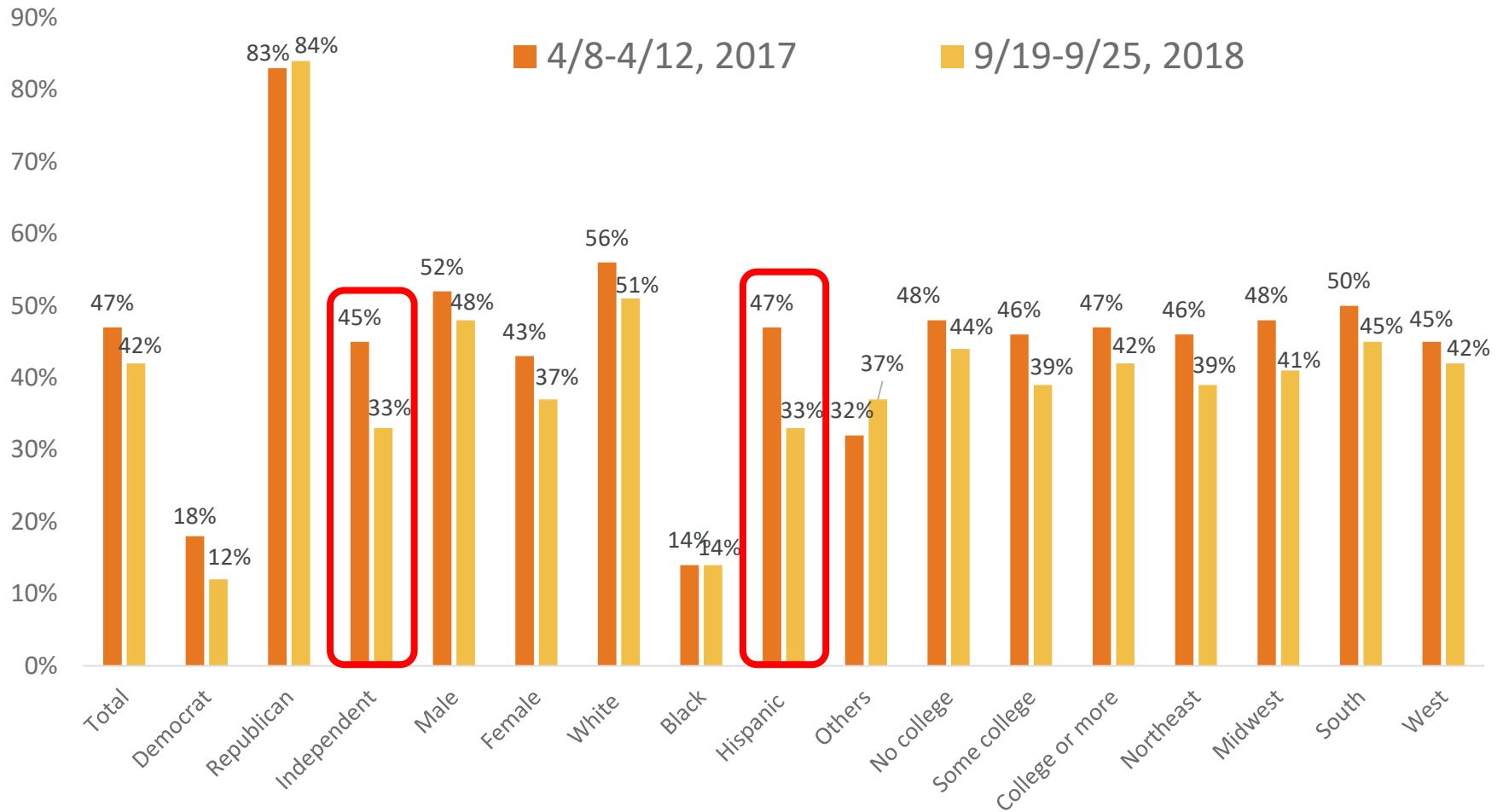
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?





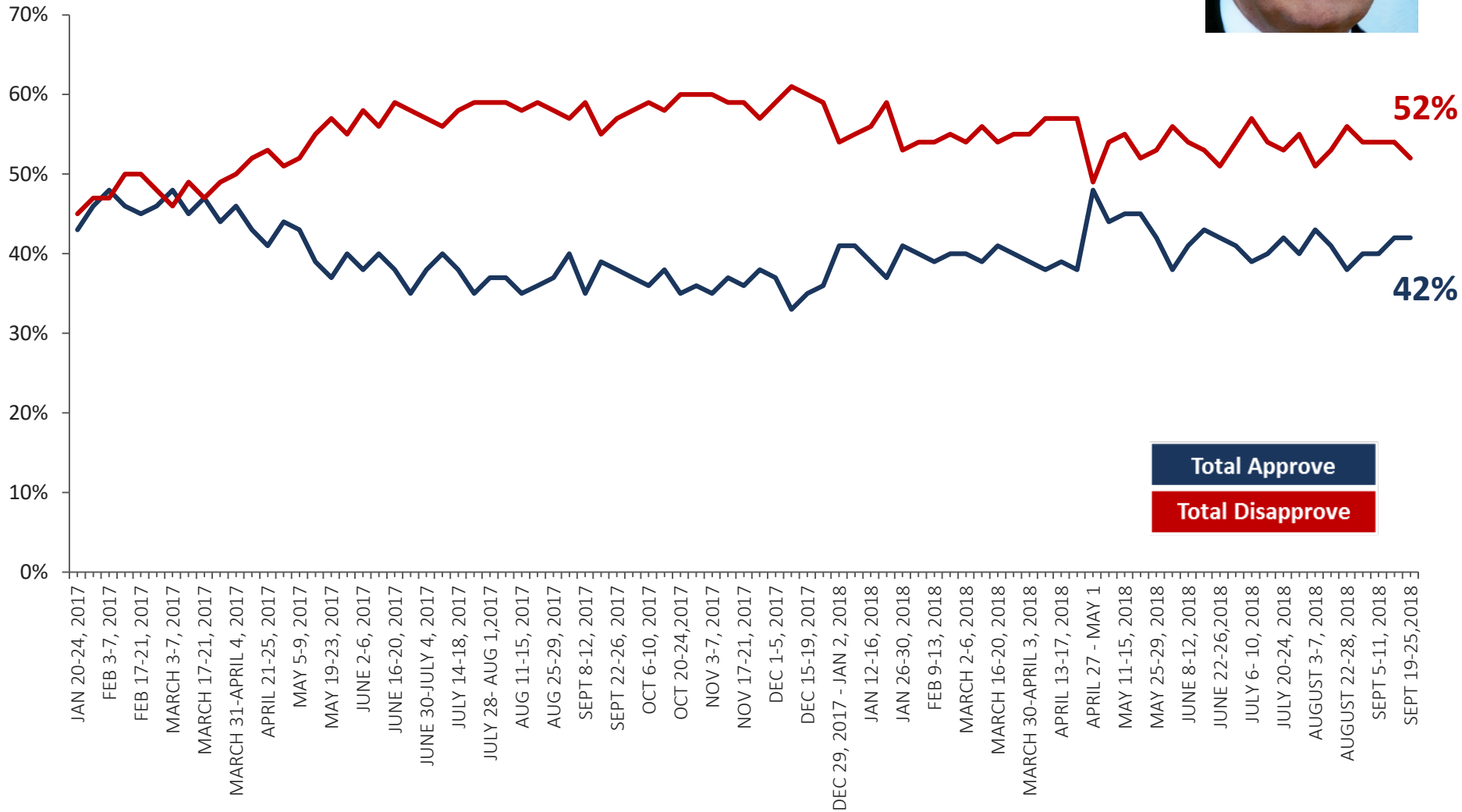

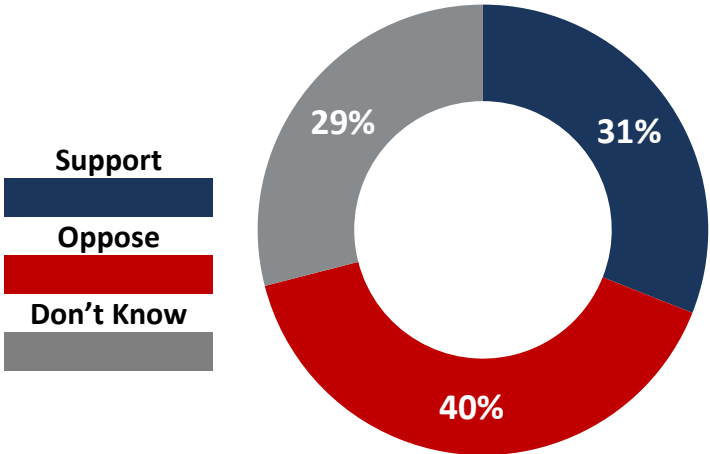

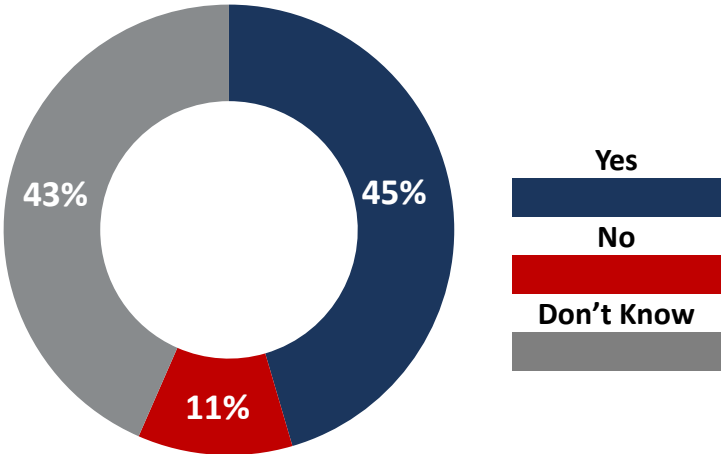
# Only a third of Americans support Kavanaugh

Support for Kavanaugh:

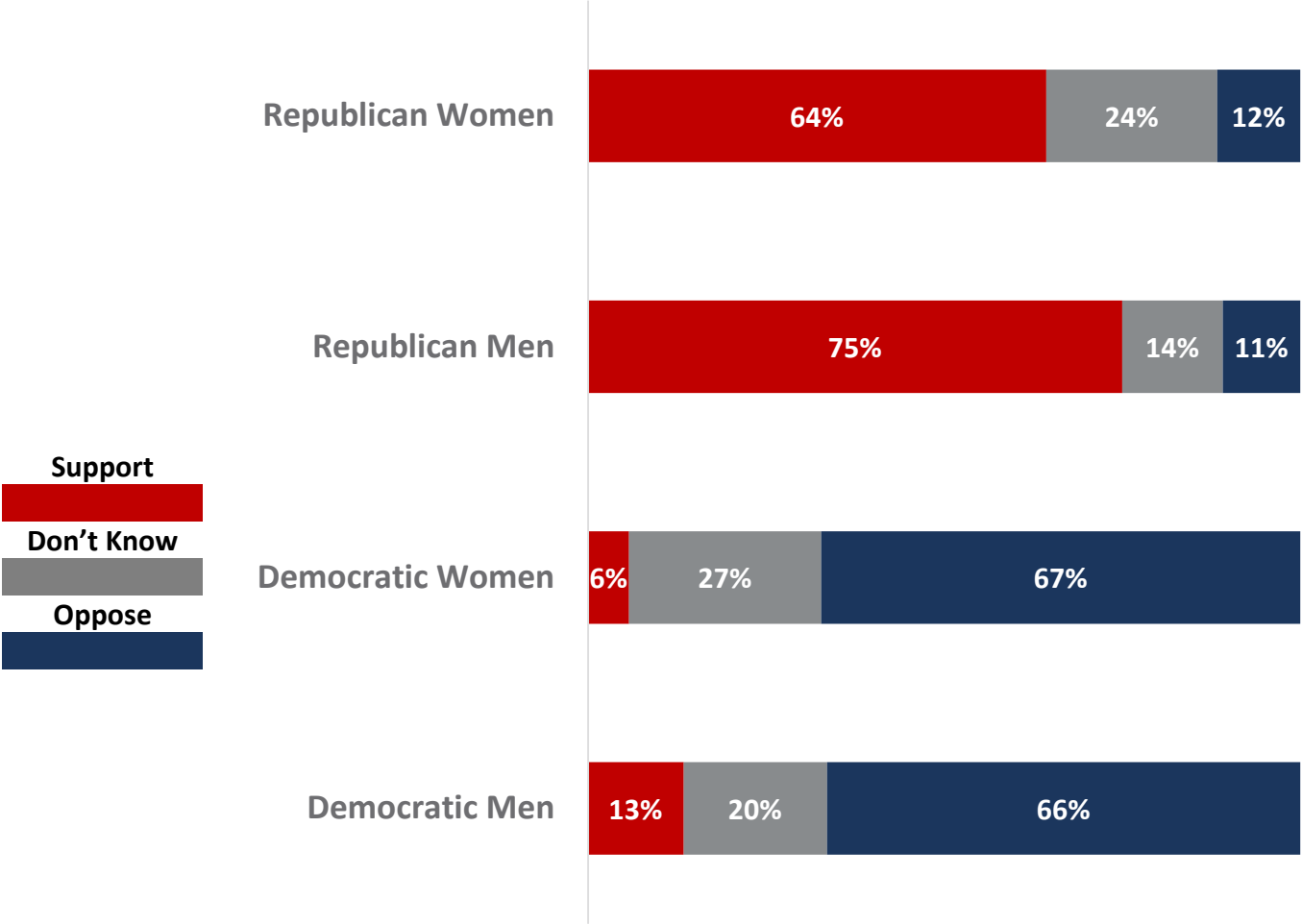


Belief Kavanaugh will be confirmed:



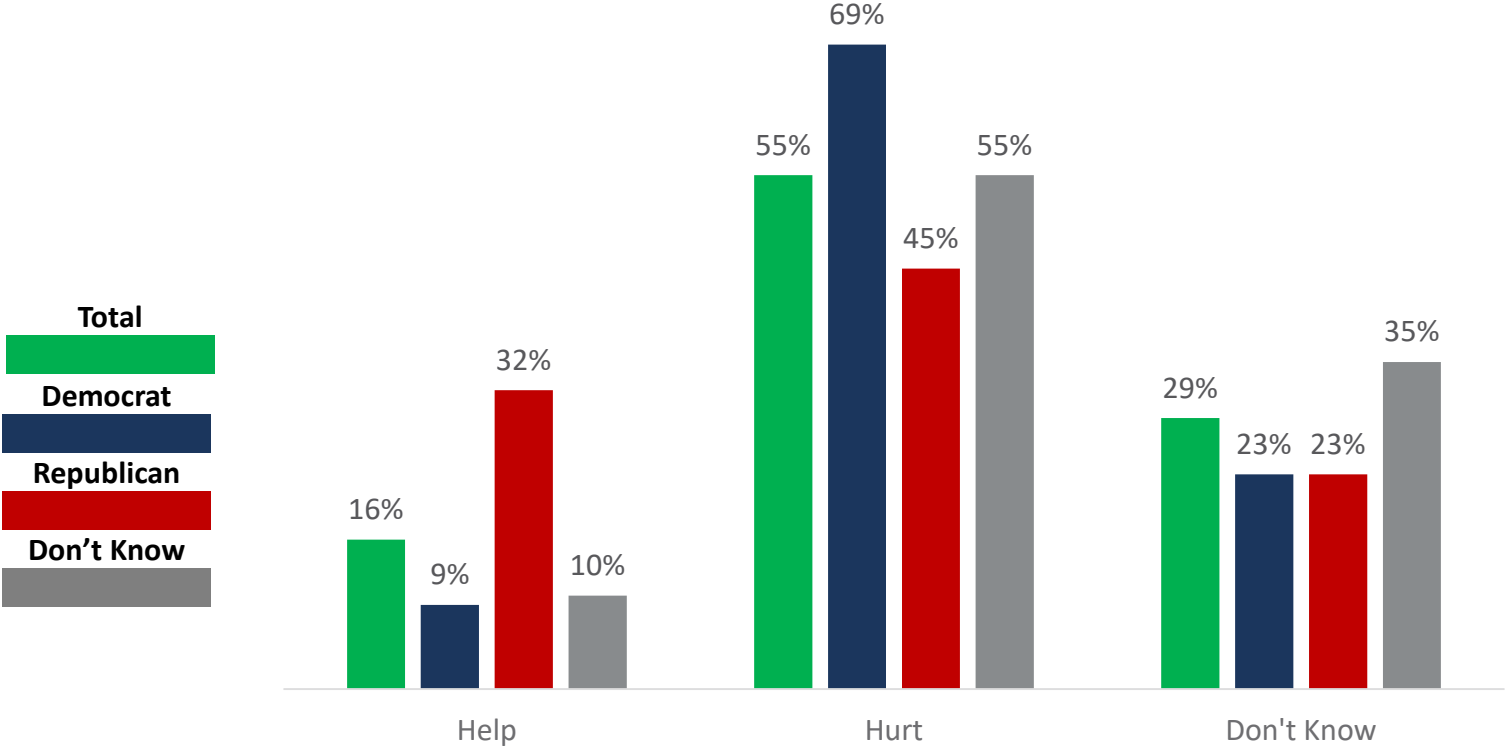
Do you support or oppose Brett Kavanaugh's confirmation as the next Supreme Court justice?
