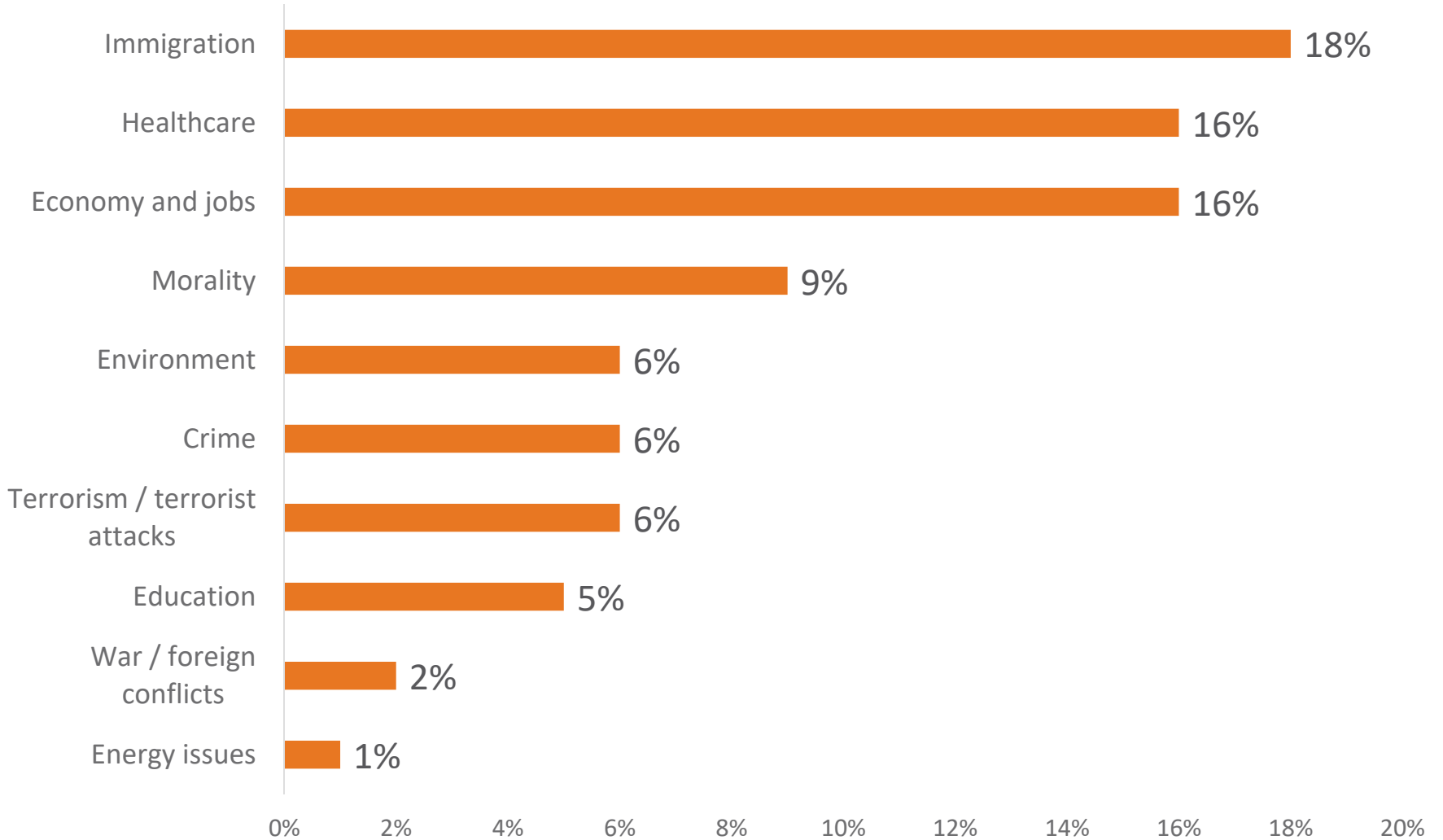

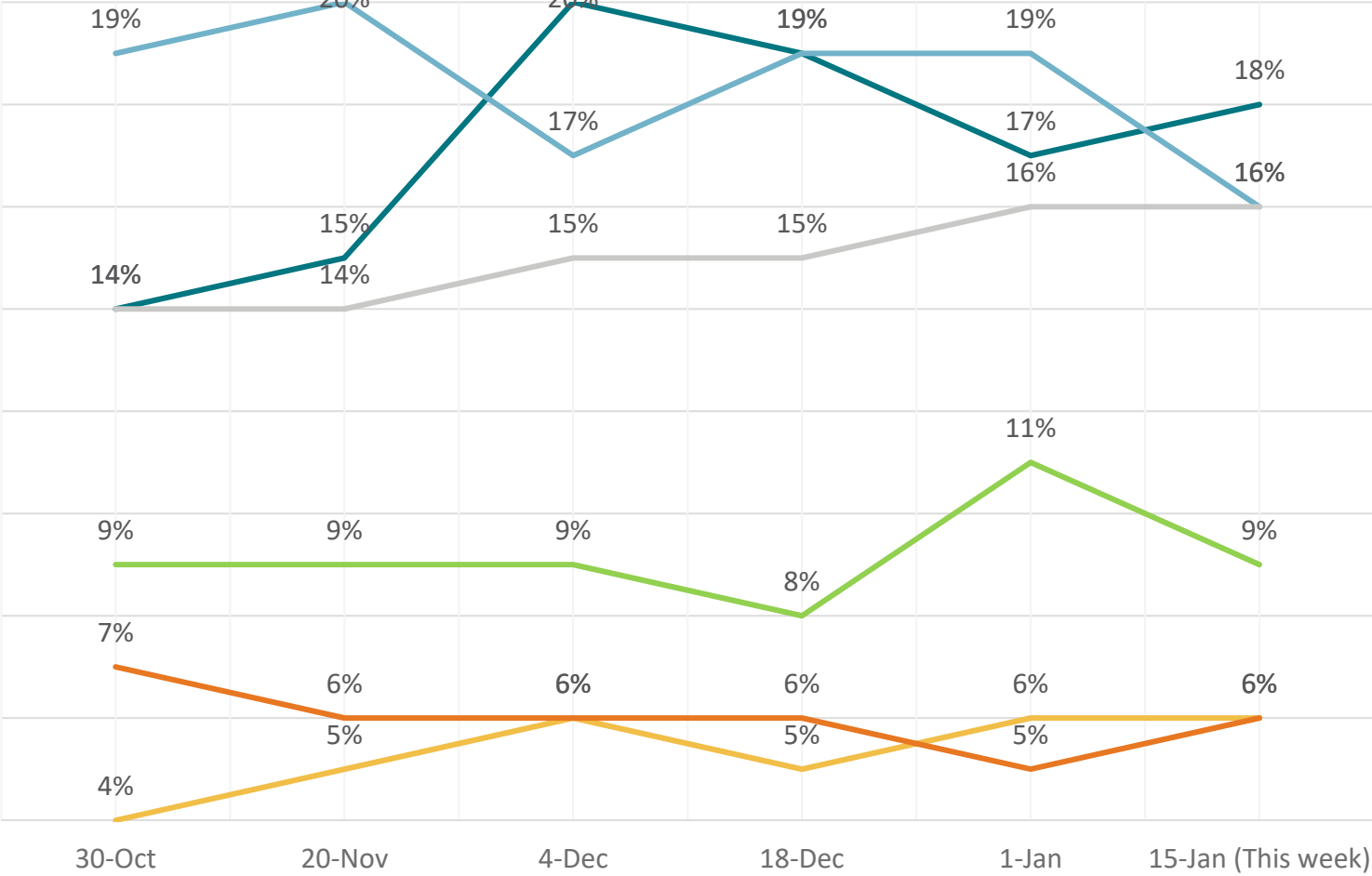
Main Problems

Trends in Top 6 Problems

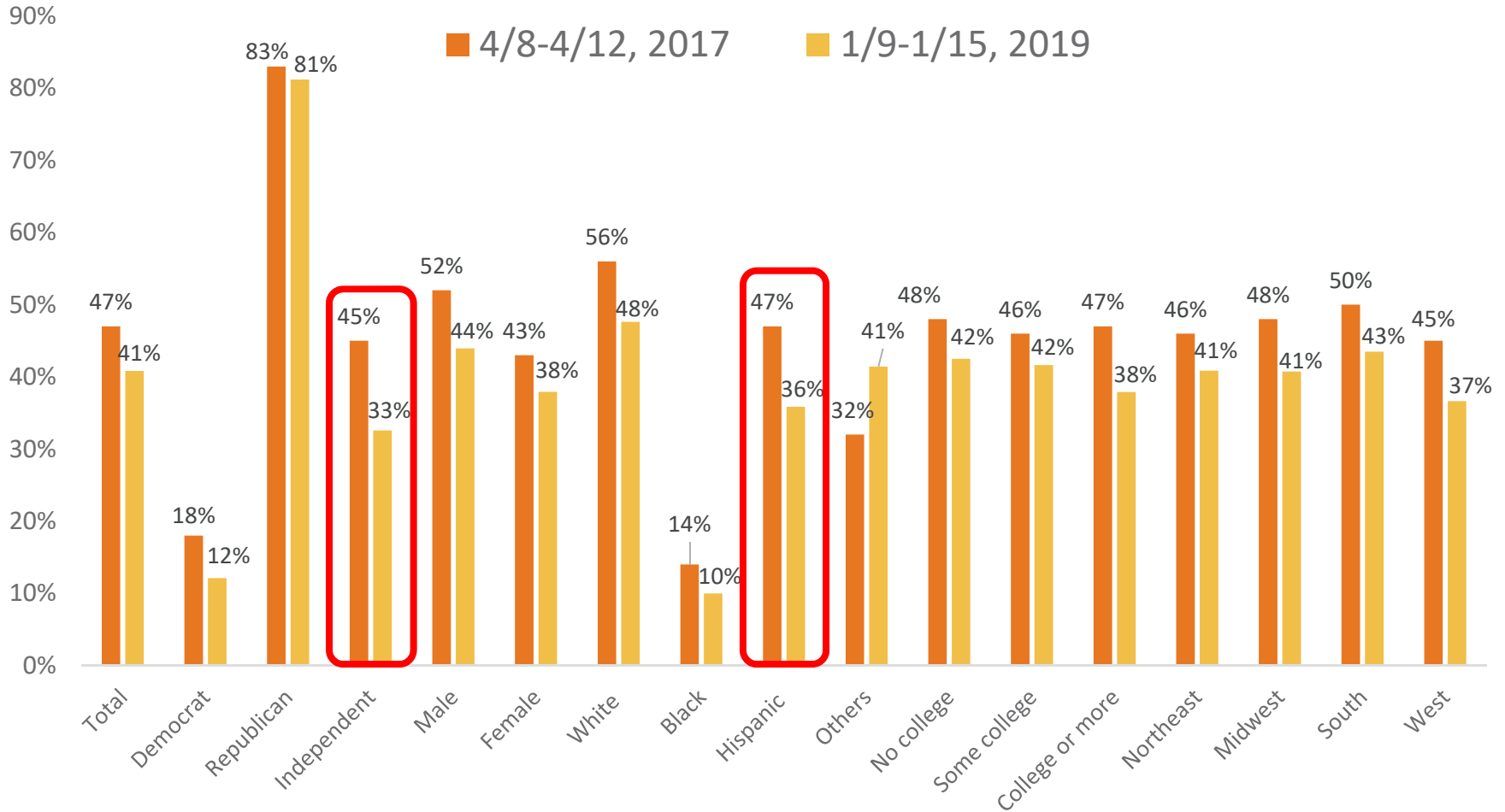

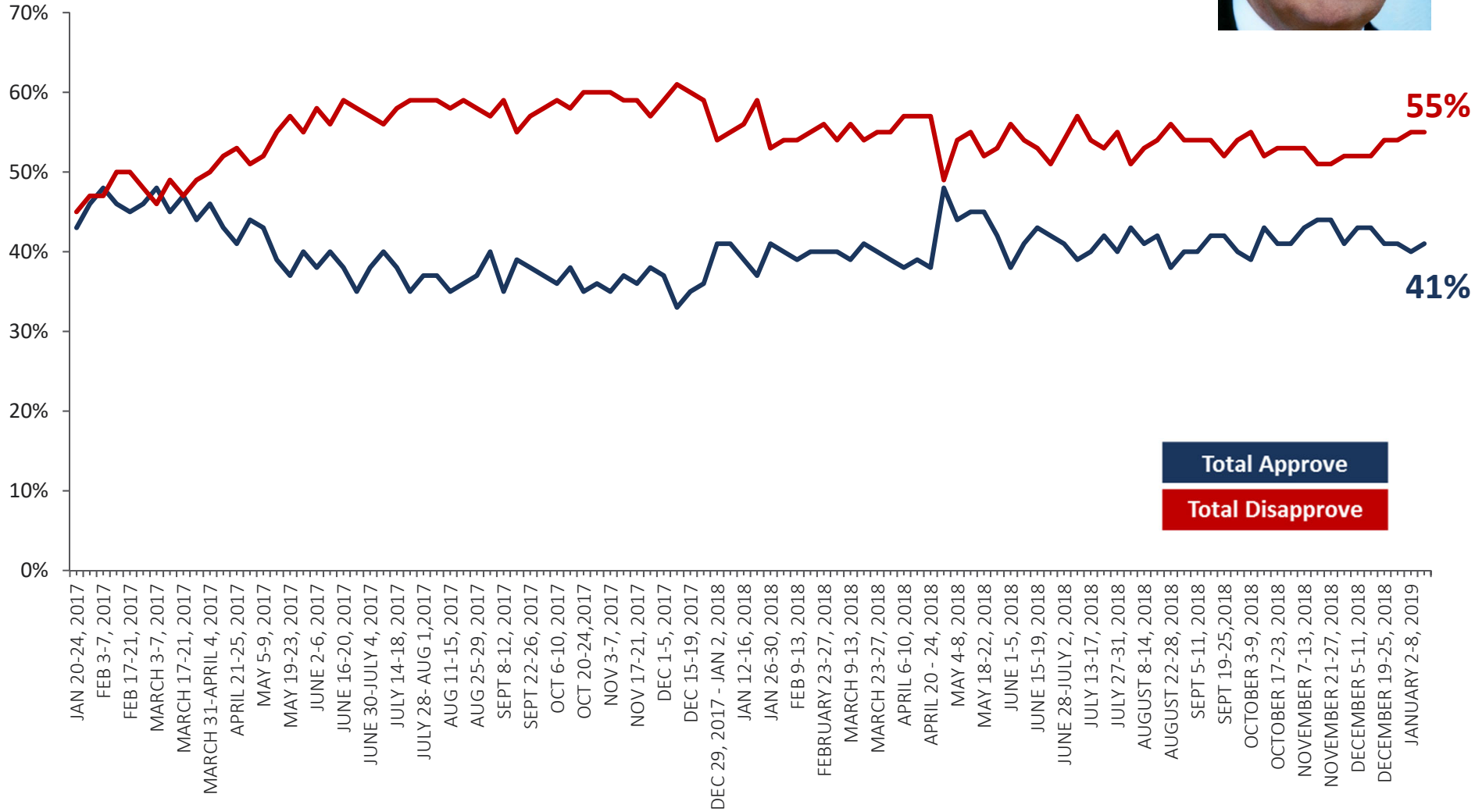

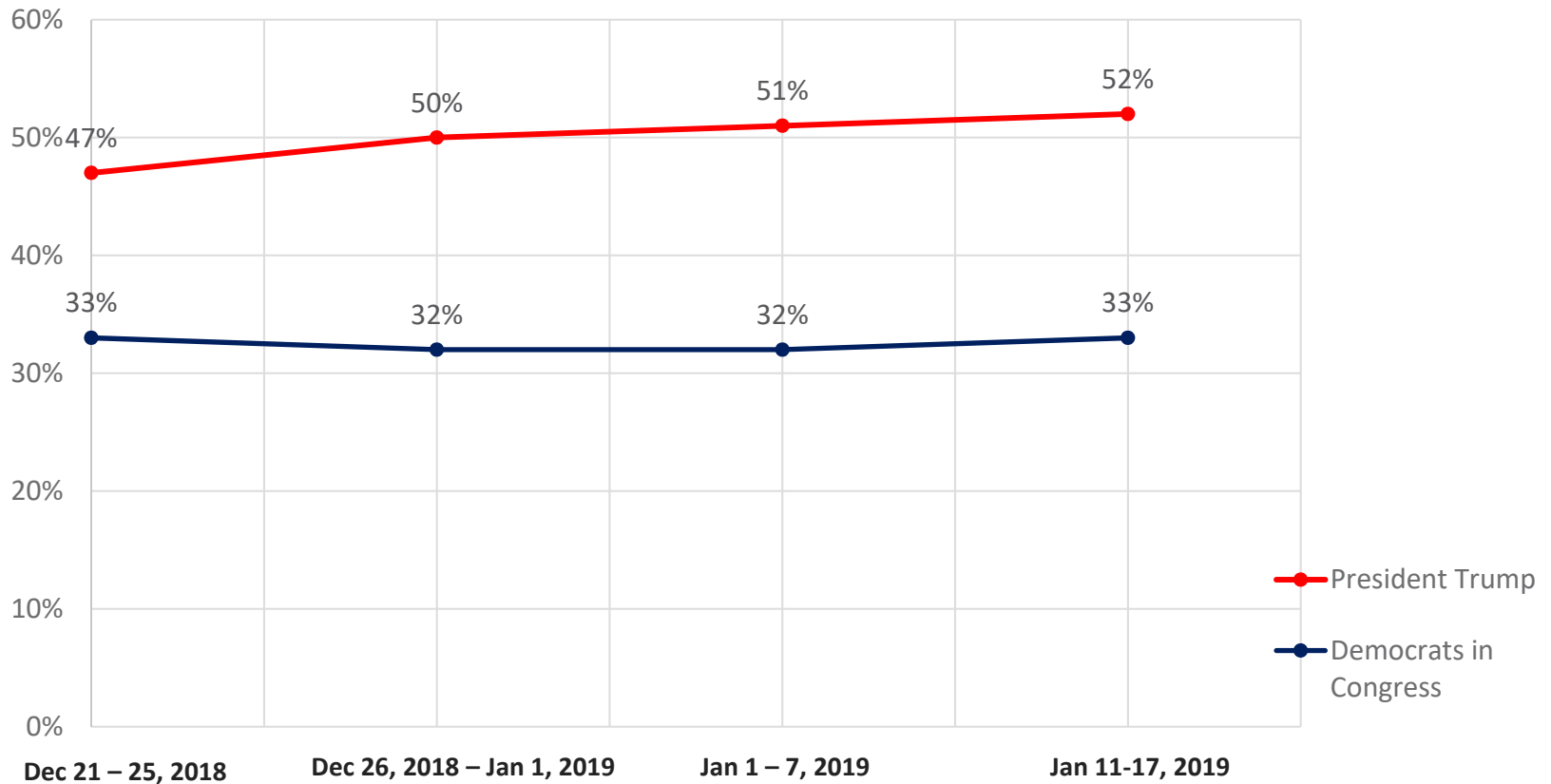

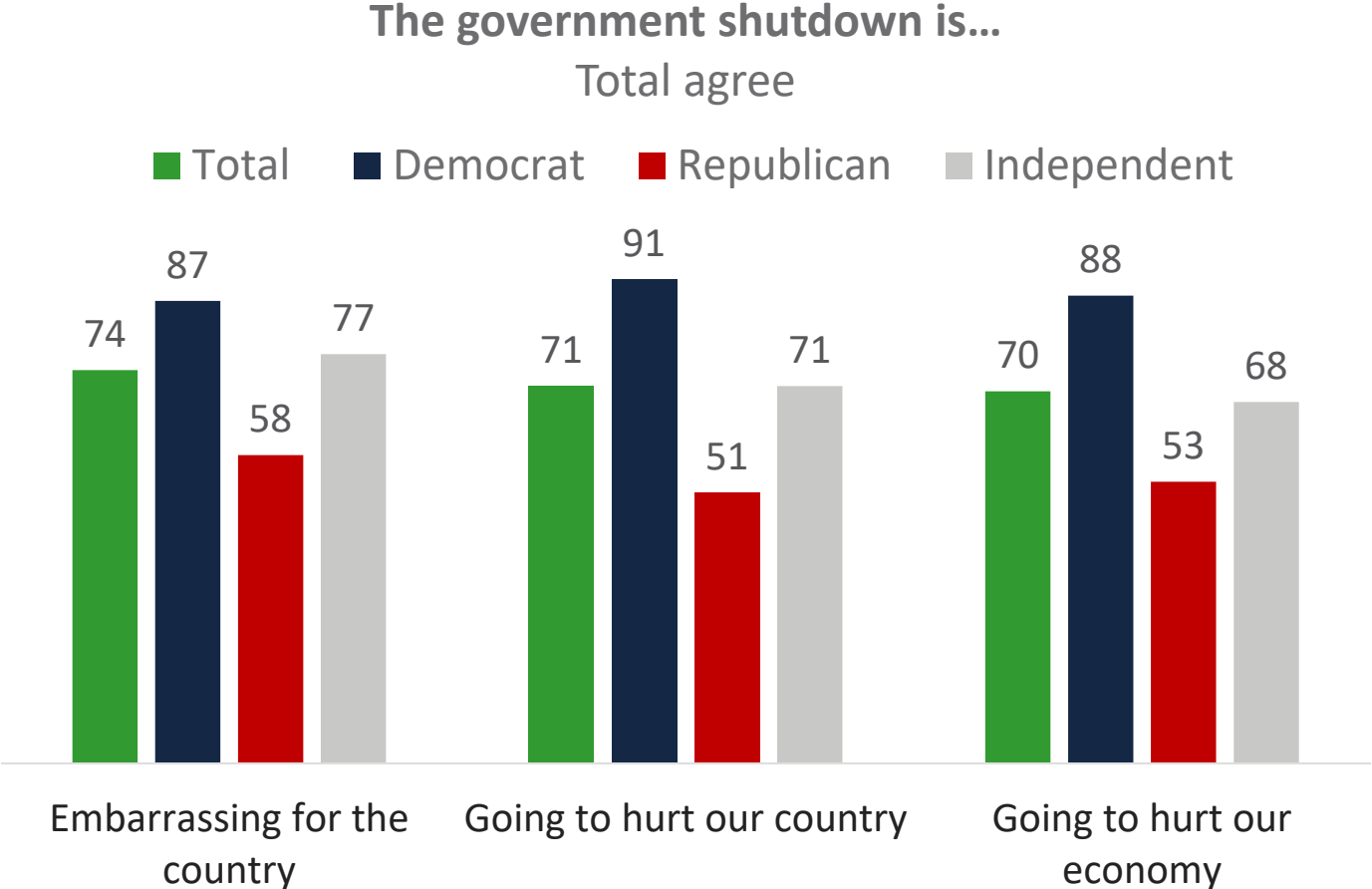

Blame for President Trump continues to rise in early survey returns

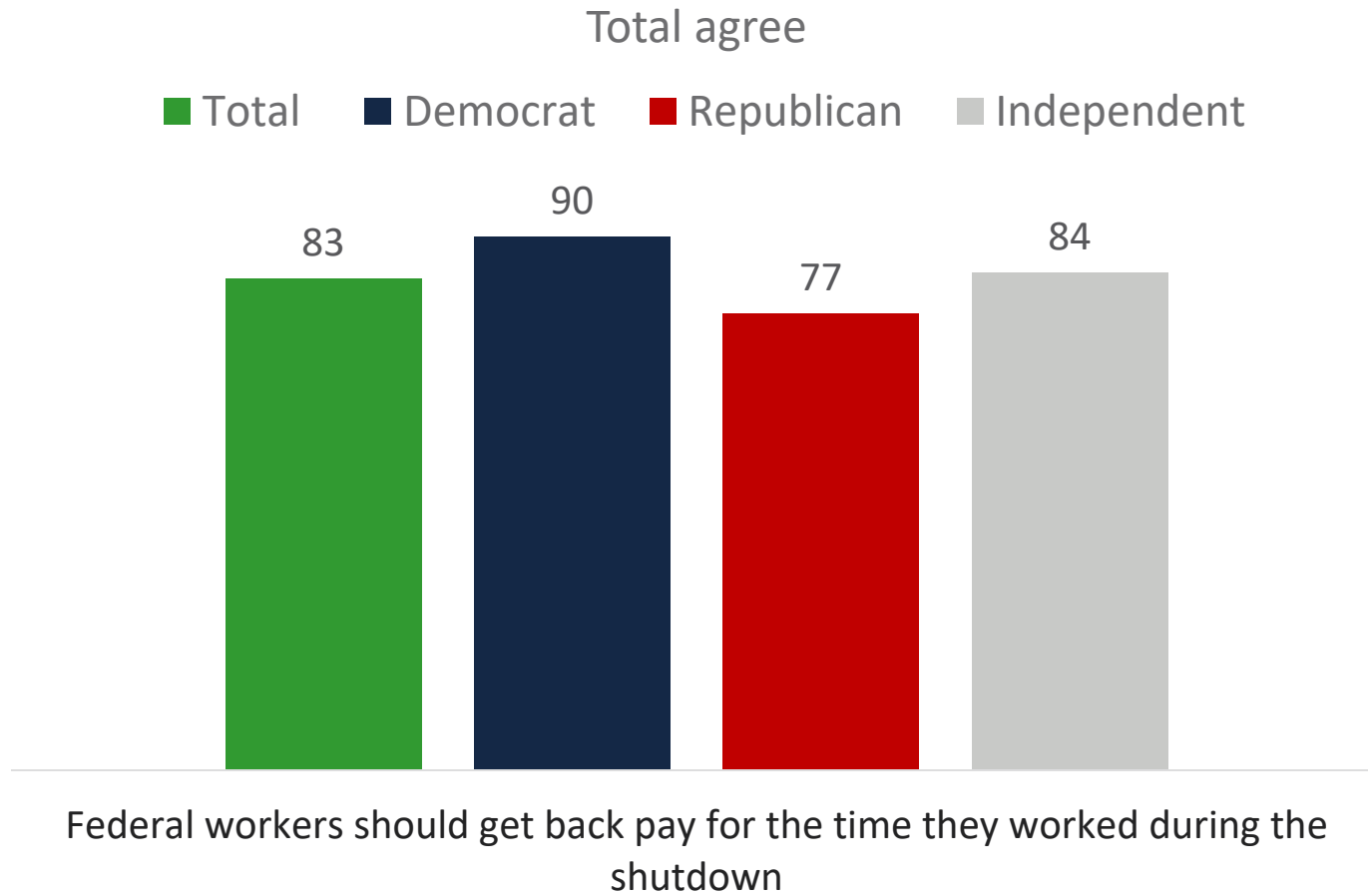
Who would you say most deserves blame for a deal not being reached, causing the federal government to shut down? (All Americans)

... and the vast majority support back pay for federal workers.

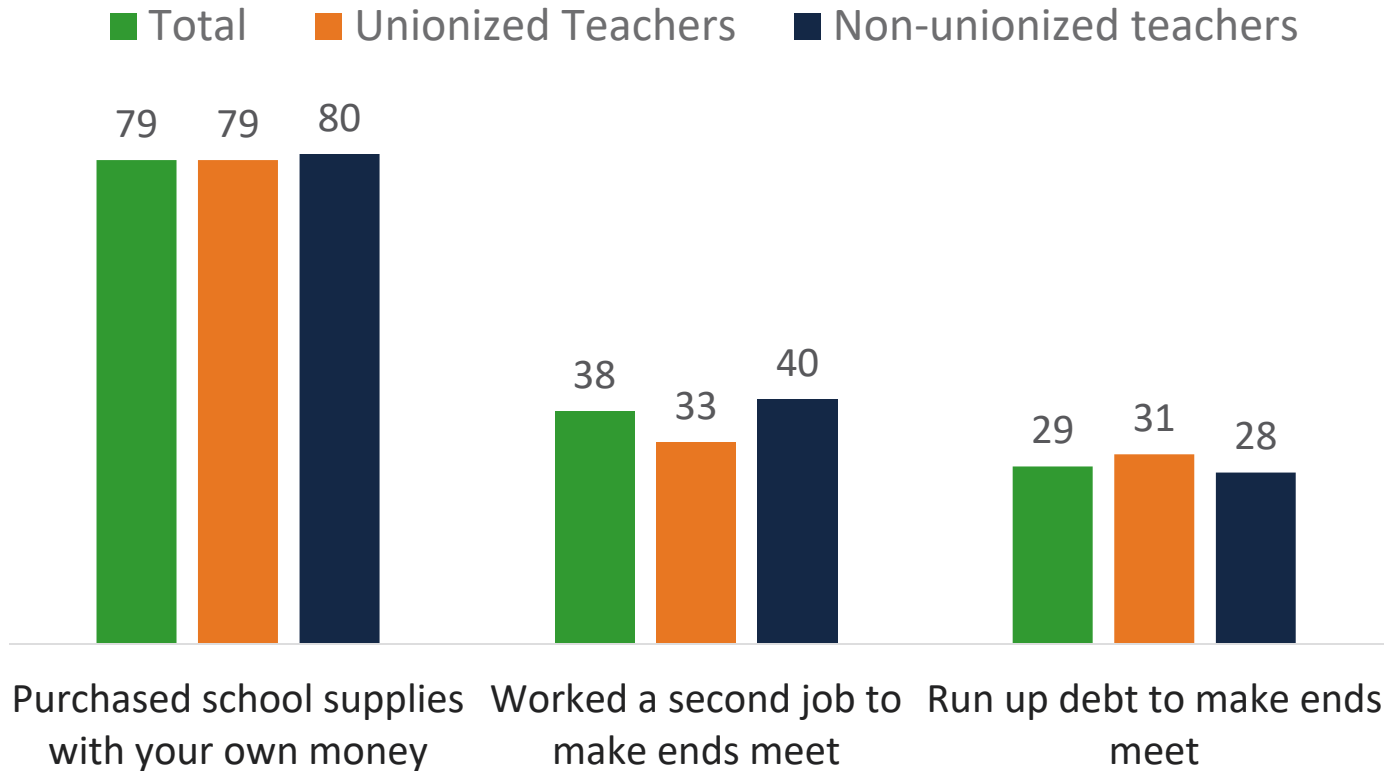

2019 TEACHER STRIKES

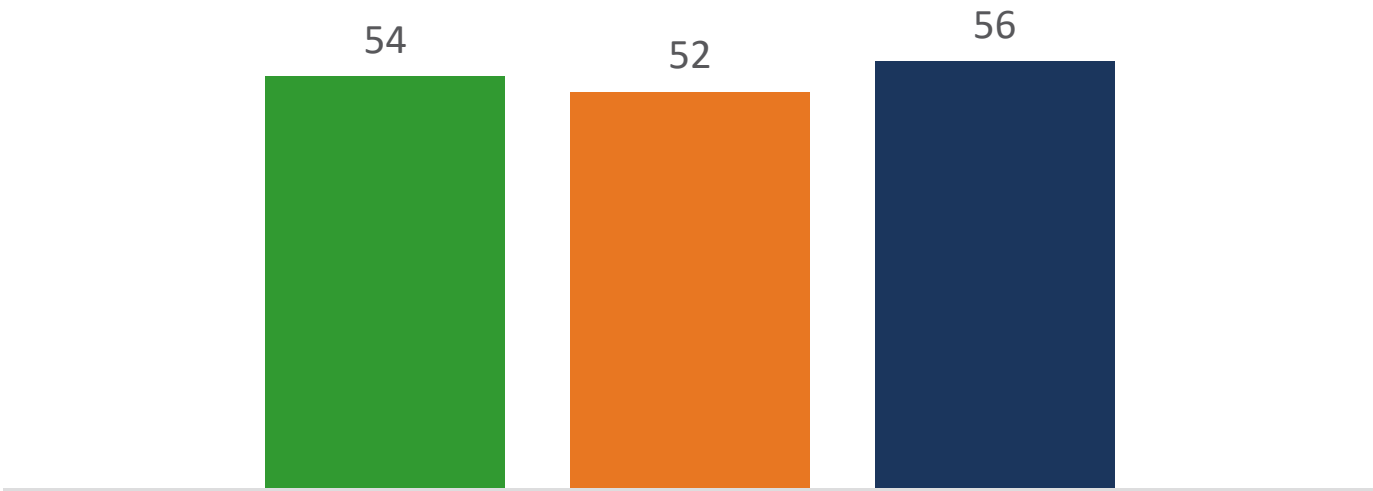
Vast majority of school teachers feel that they don't receive enough resources and many struggle to make ends meet...

In the last year, have you done any of the following:



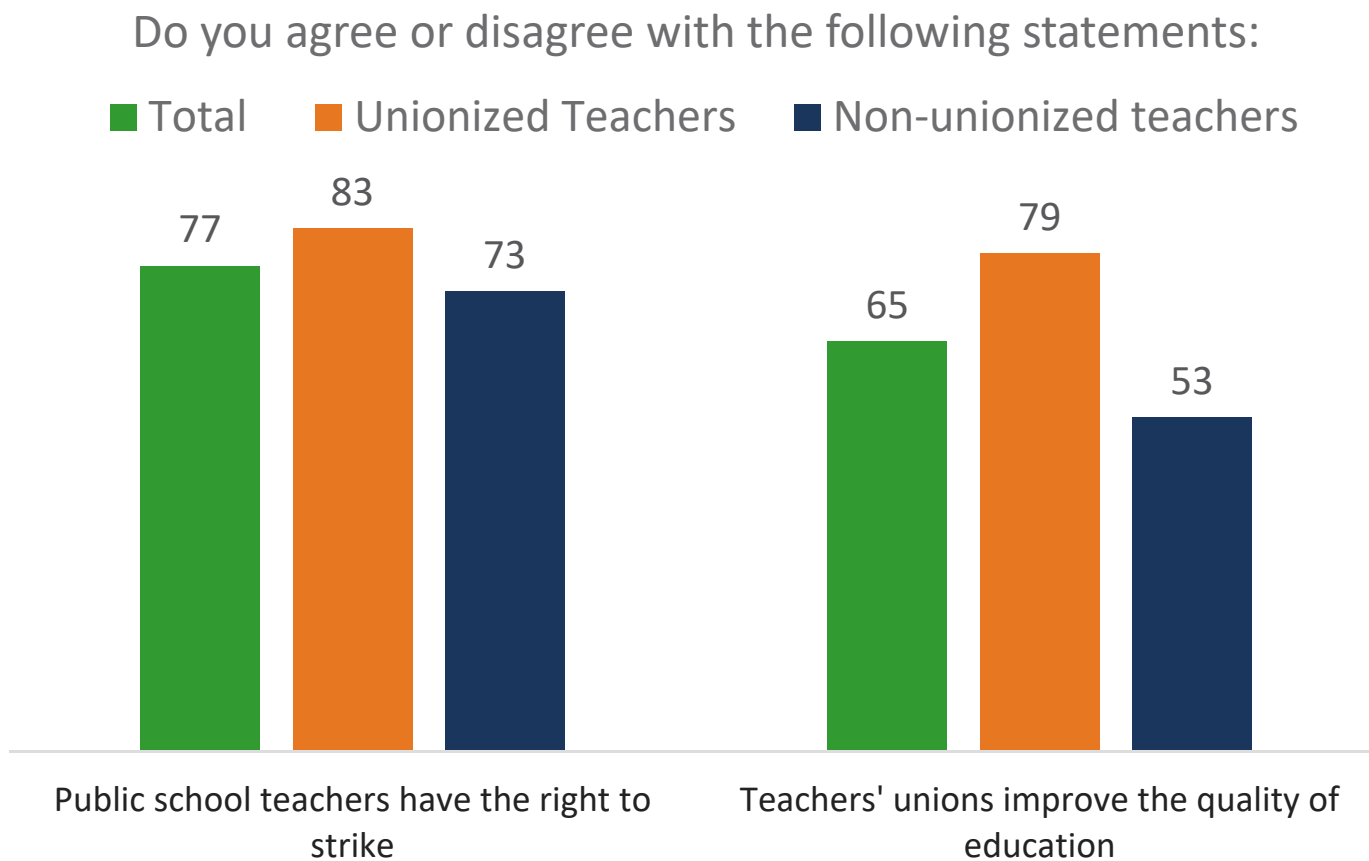
... And more than half have thought about leaving their job.

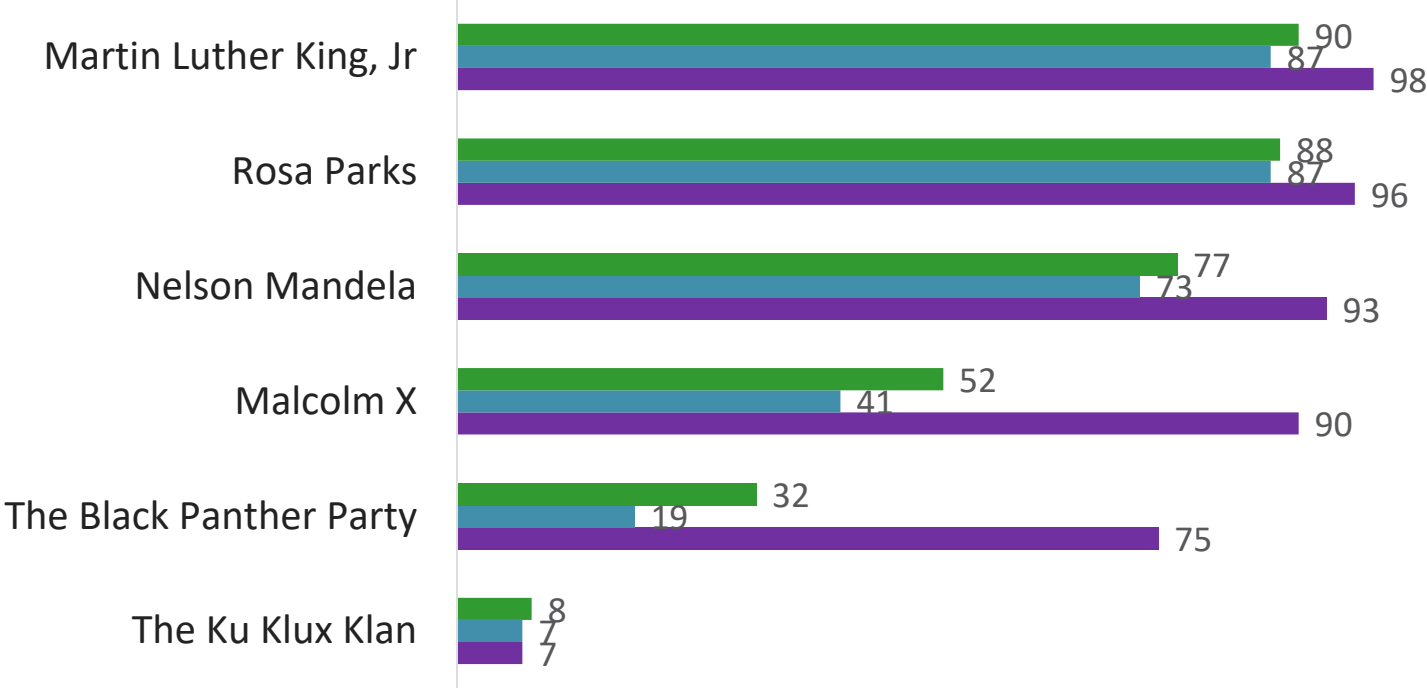
REMEMBERING HISTORY ON MLK DAY

■ Total ■ White ■ Black

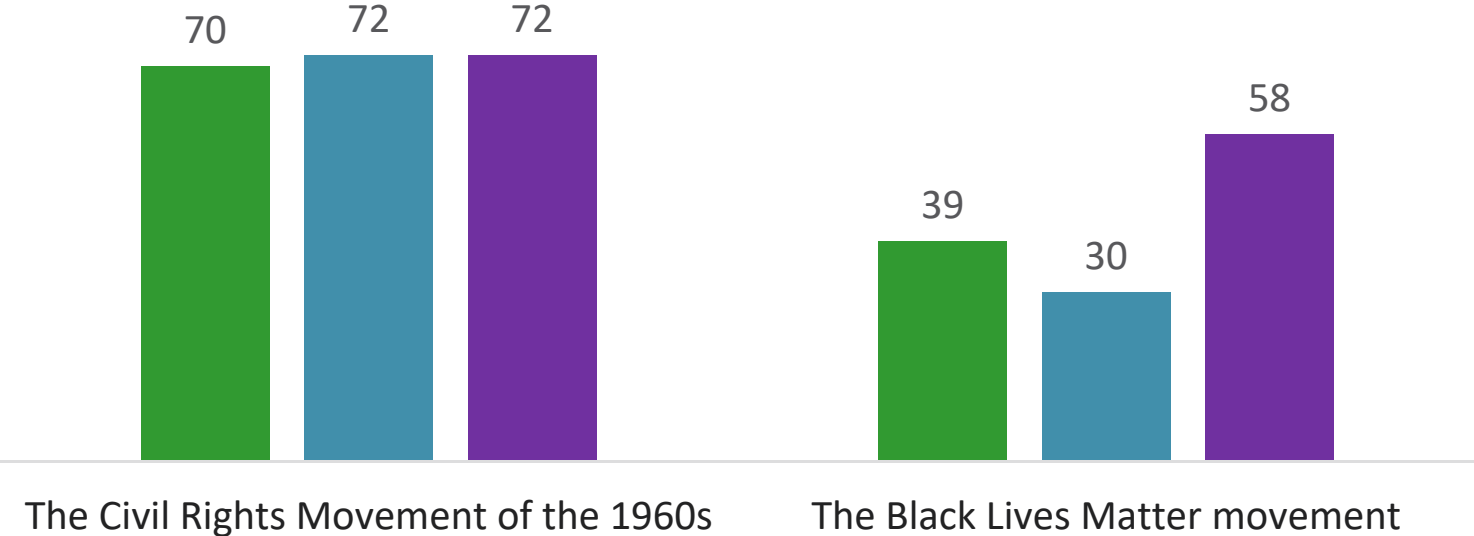


Compared to the Civil Rights Movement led by Dr. King, sentiments about today's Black Lives Matter movement are much more polarizing.
