In this case, the poll has a credibility interval of plus or minus the following percentage points



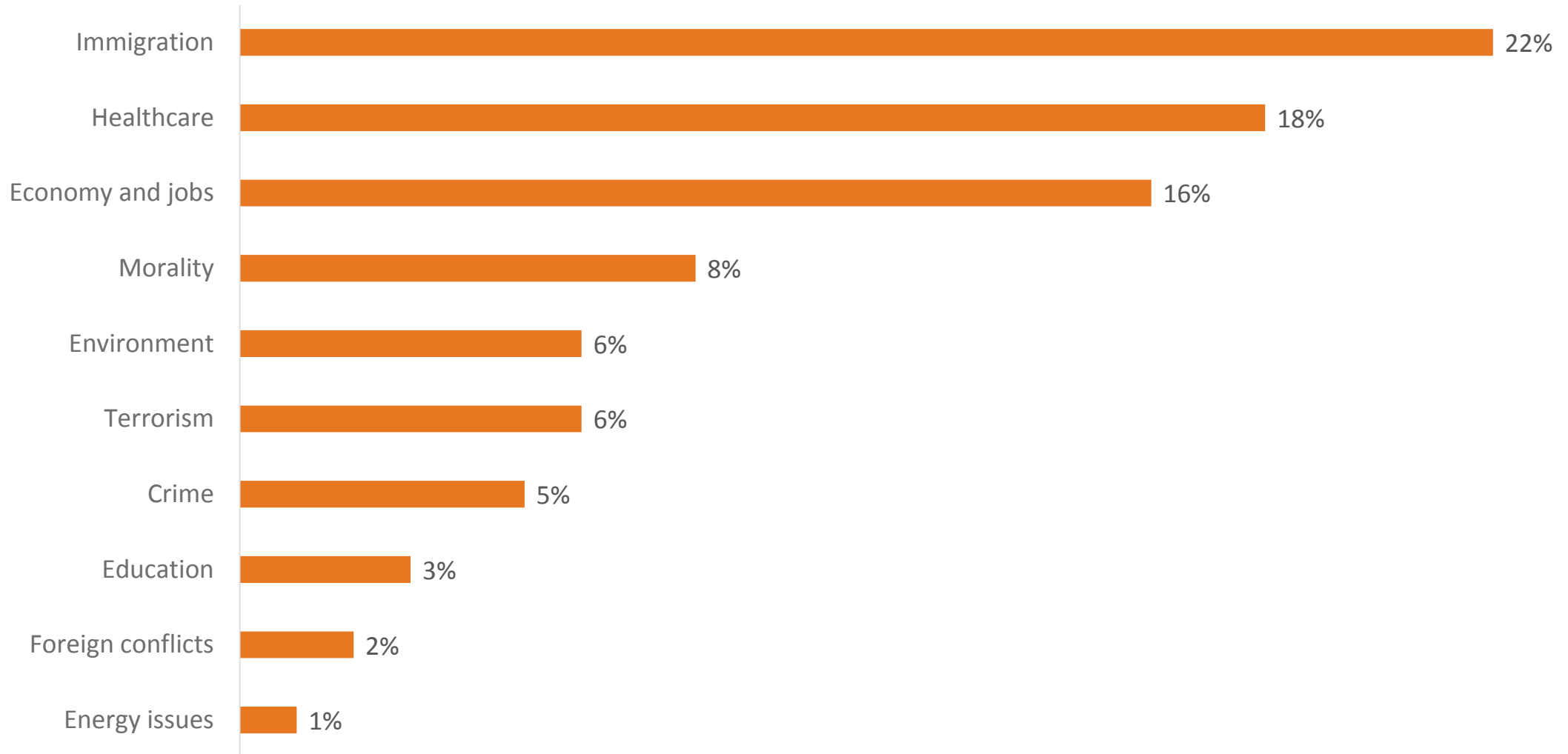

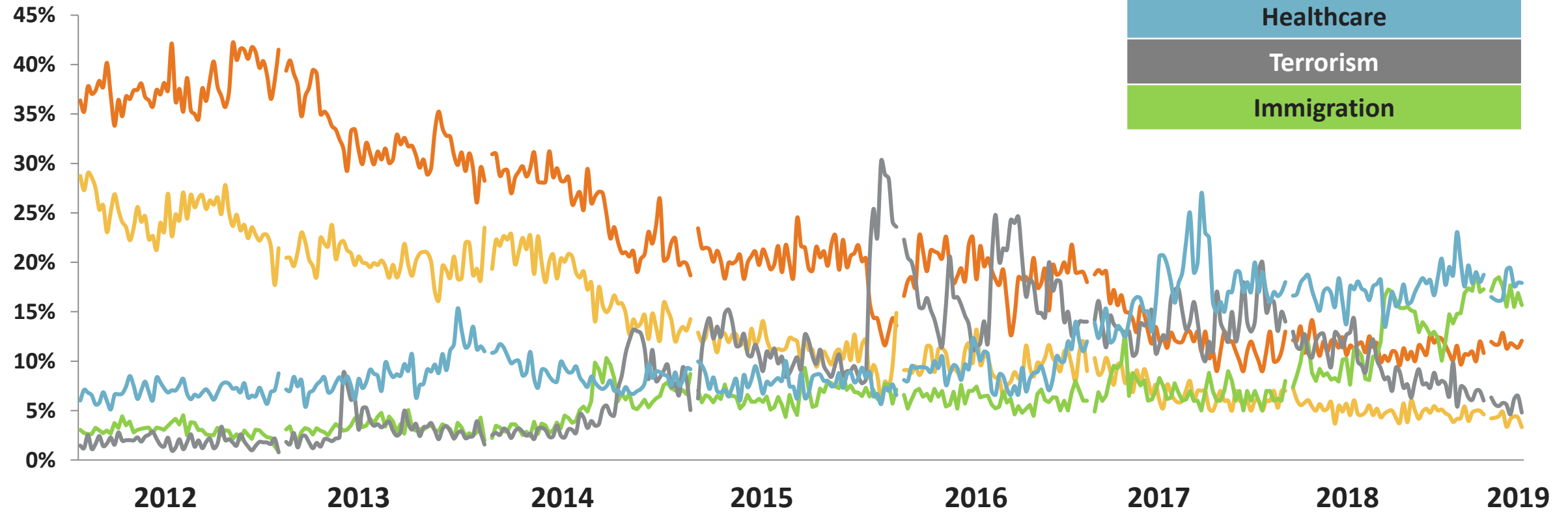
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?

Most Important Problem Facing America

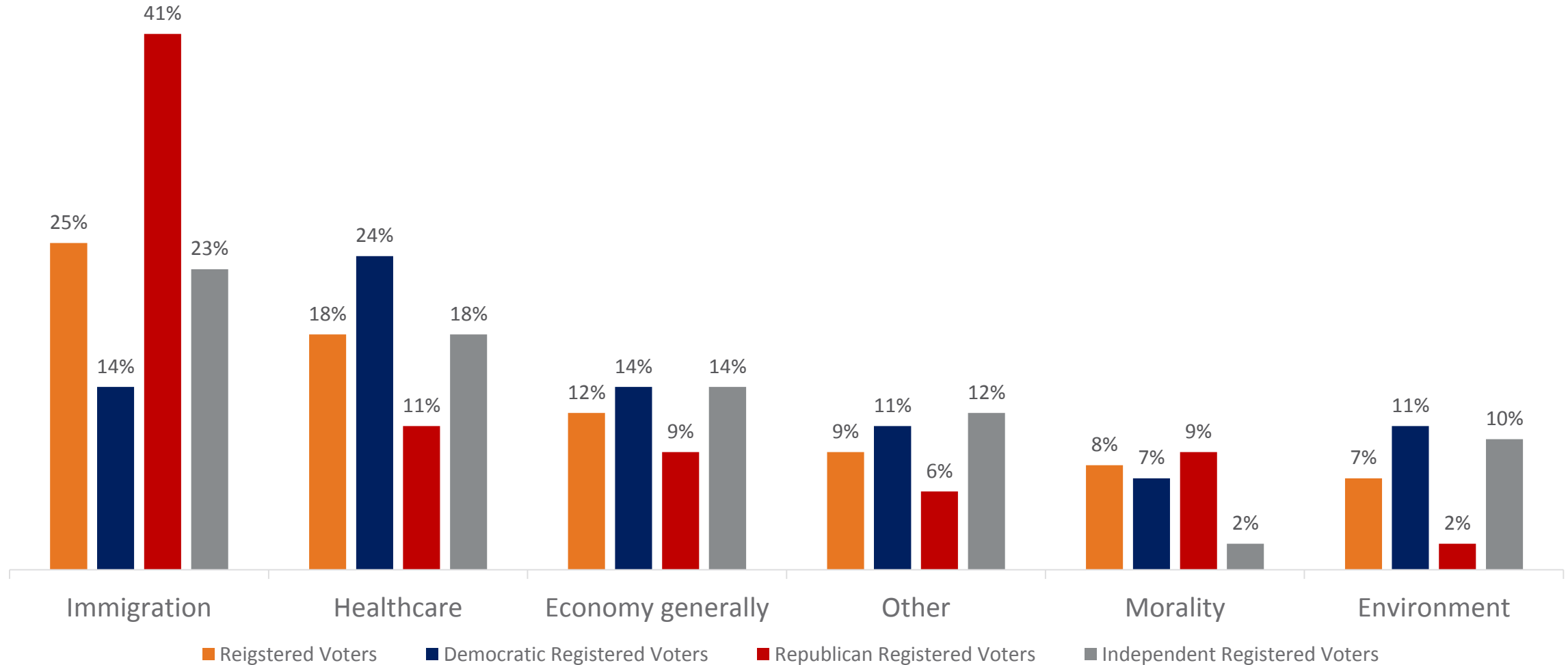
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?

In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?

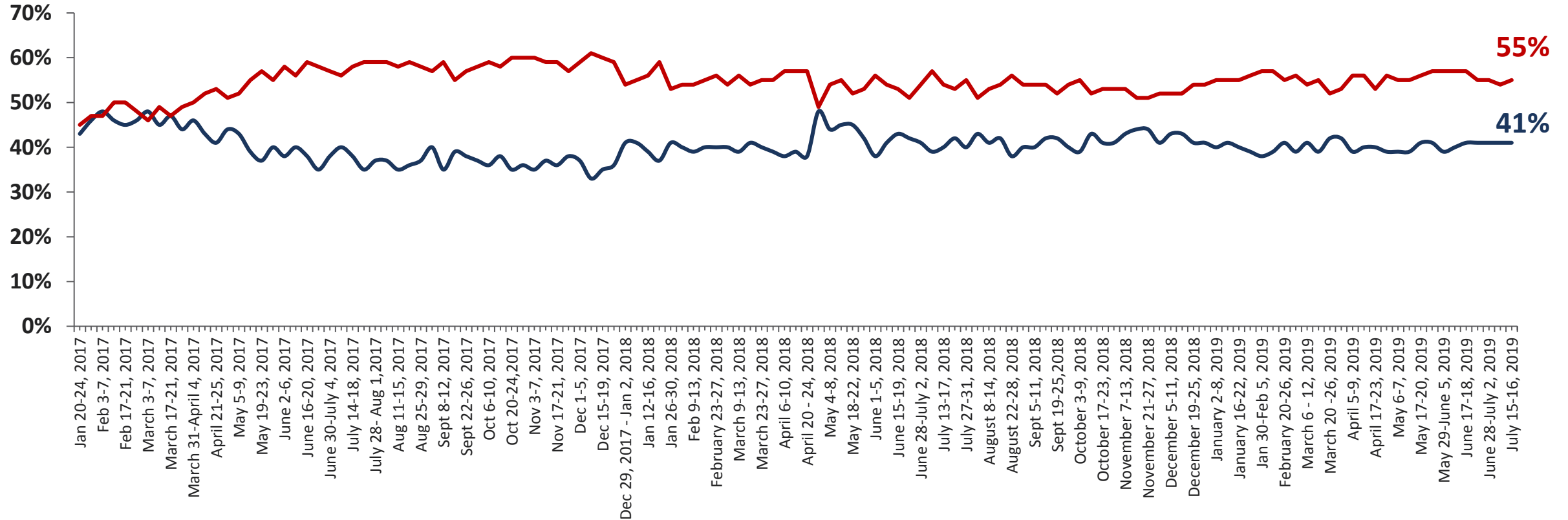

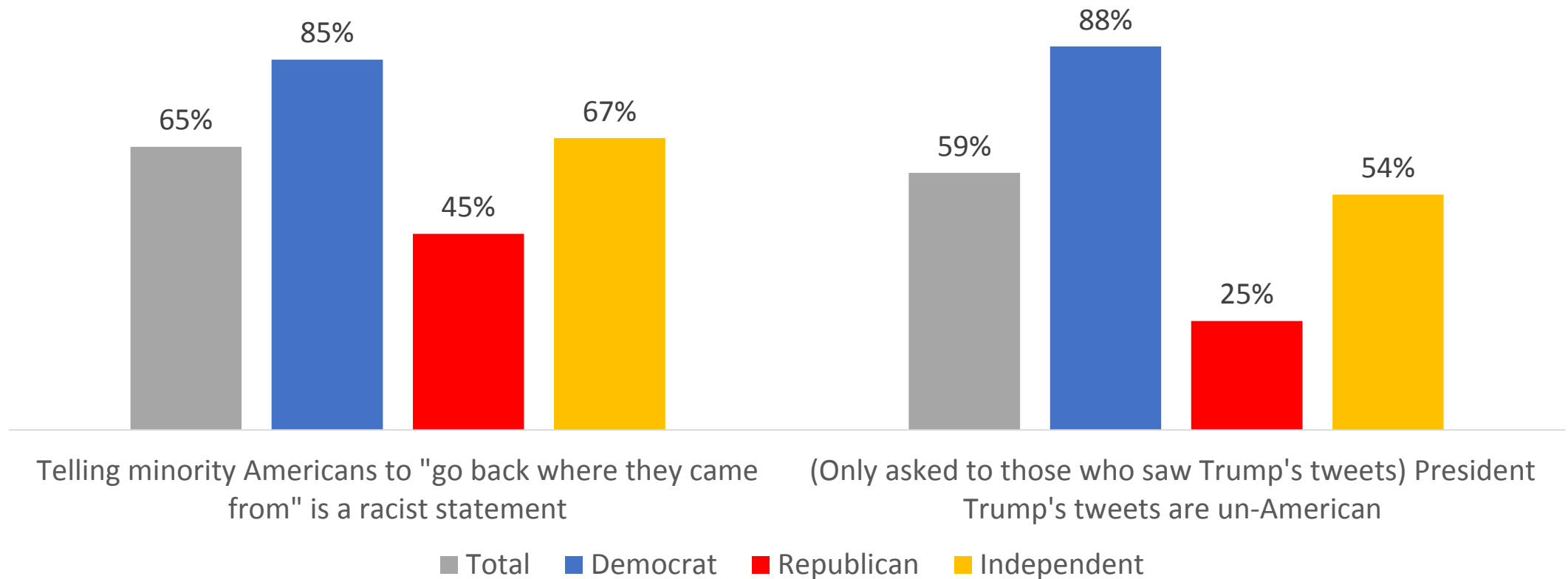

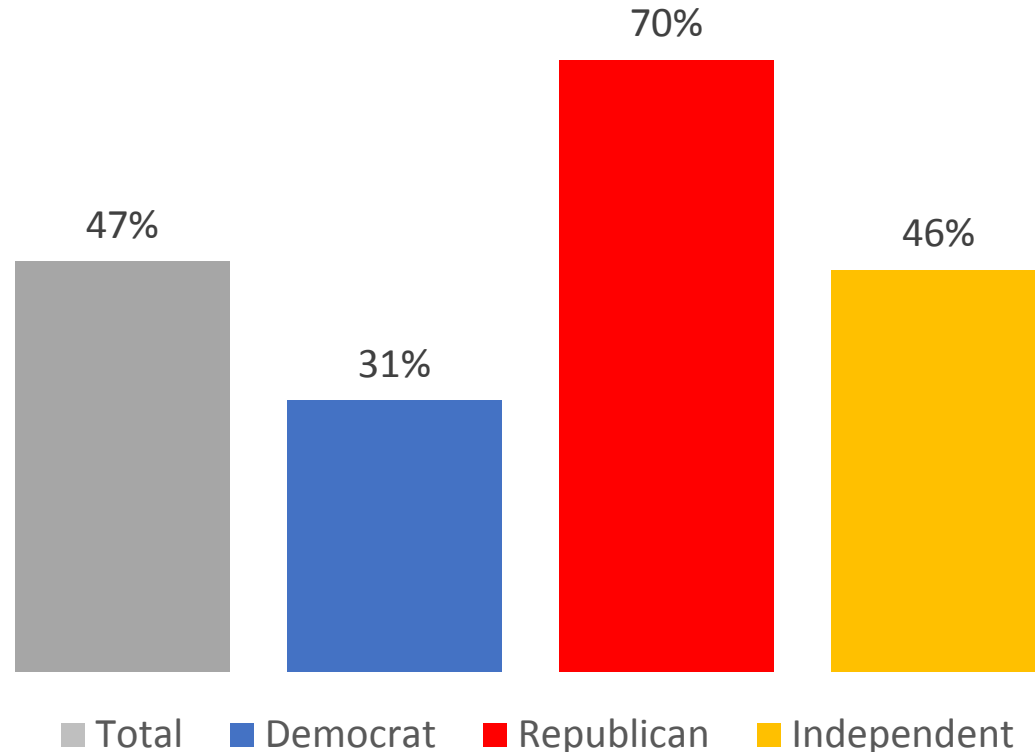

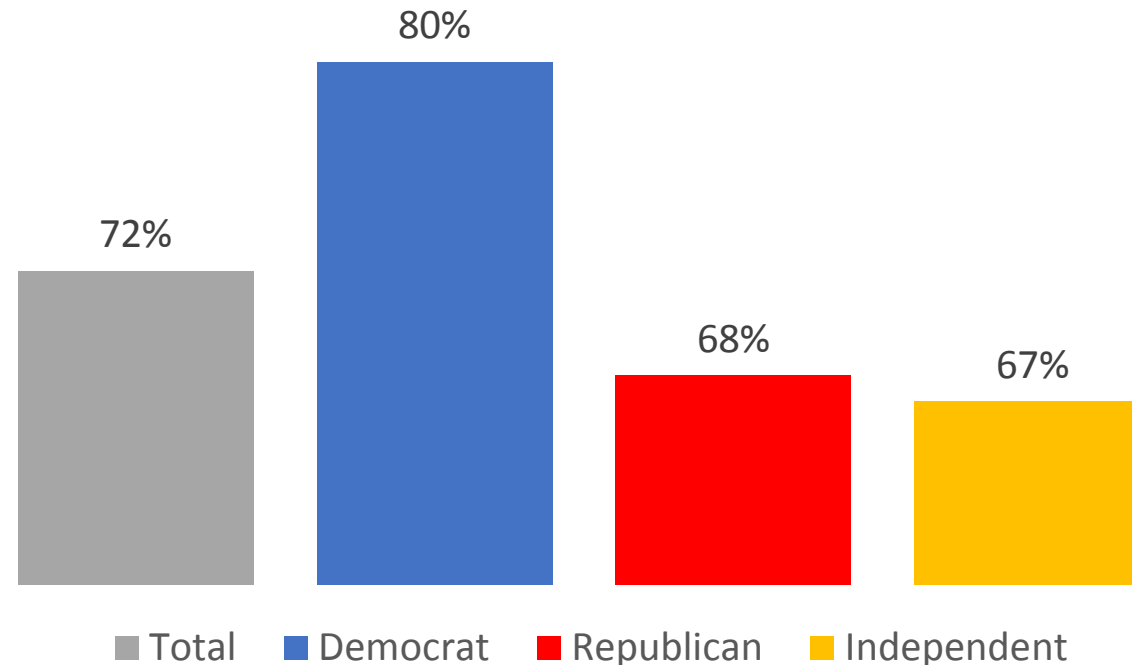


Regardless, Americans believe it is patriotic to point out where American falls short and try to do better.

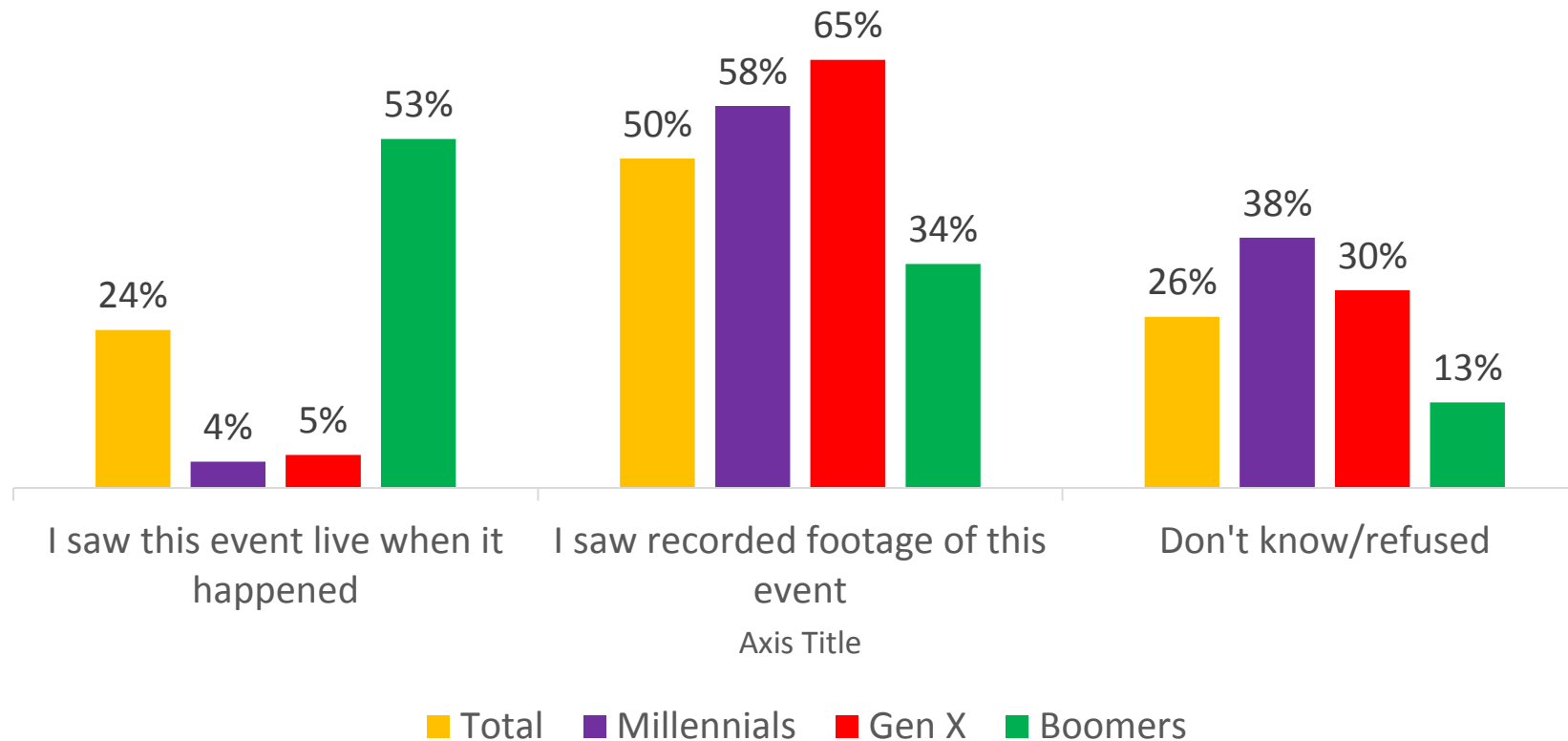

The Apollo 11 Moon Landing is a shared experience for Americans across all age groups...

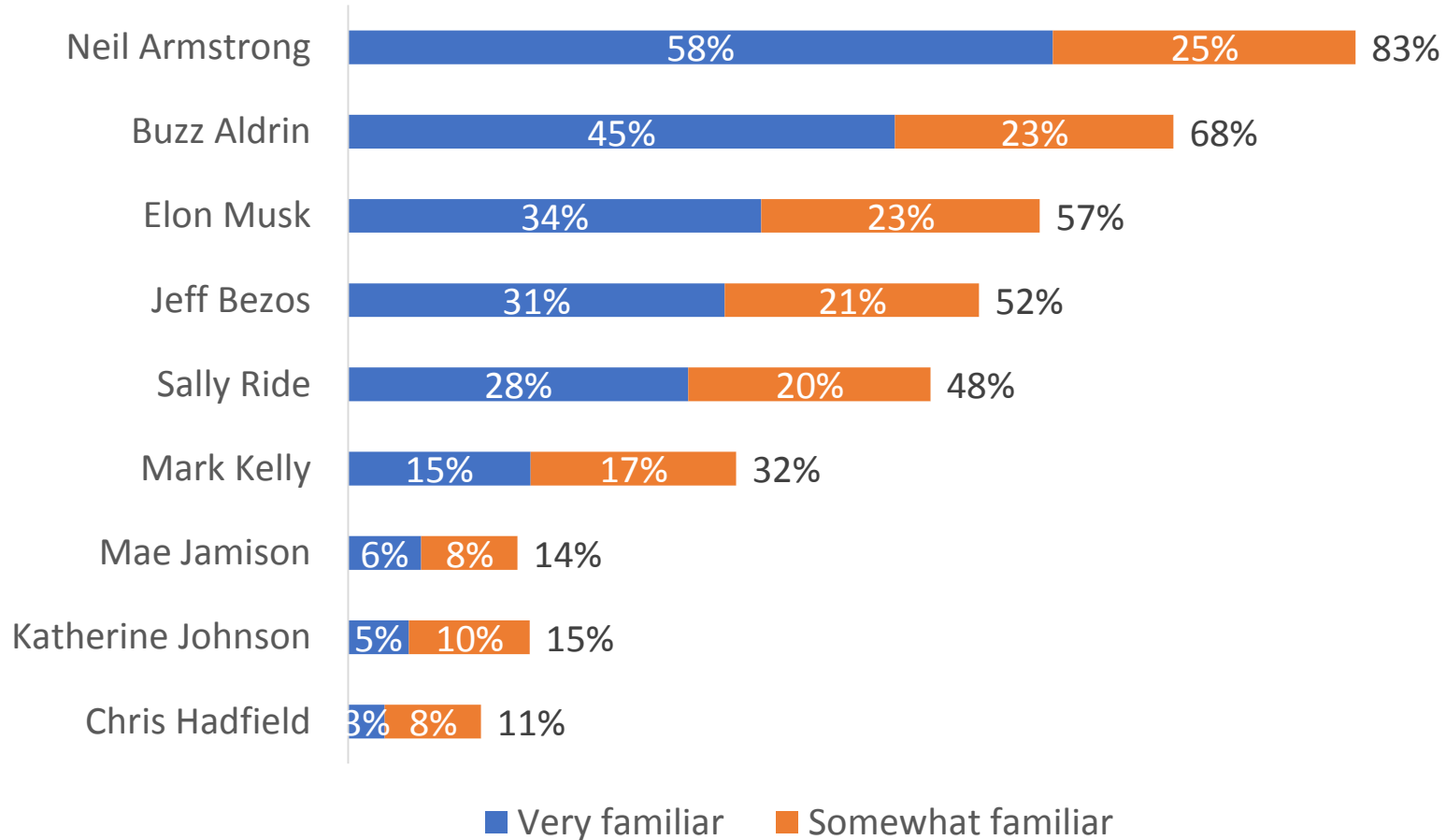
Have you ever watched footage of the following space exploration milestones?

... and Neil Armstrong and Buzz Aldrin are the most recognized space exploration pioneers.

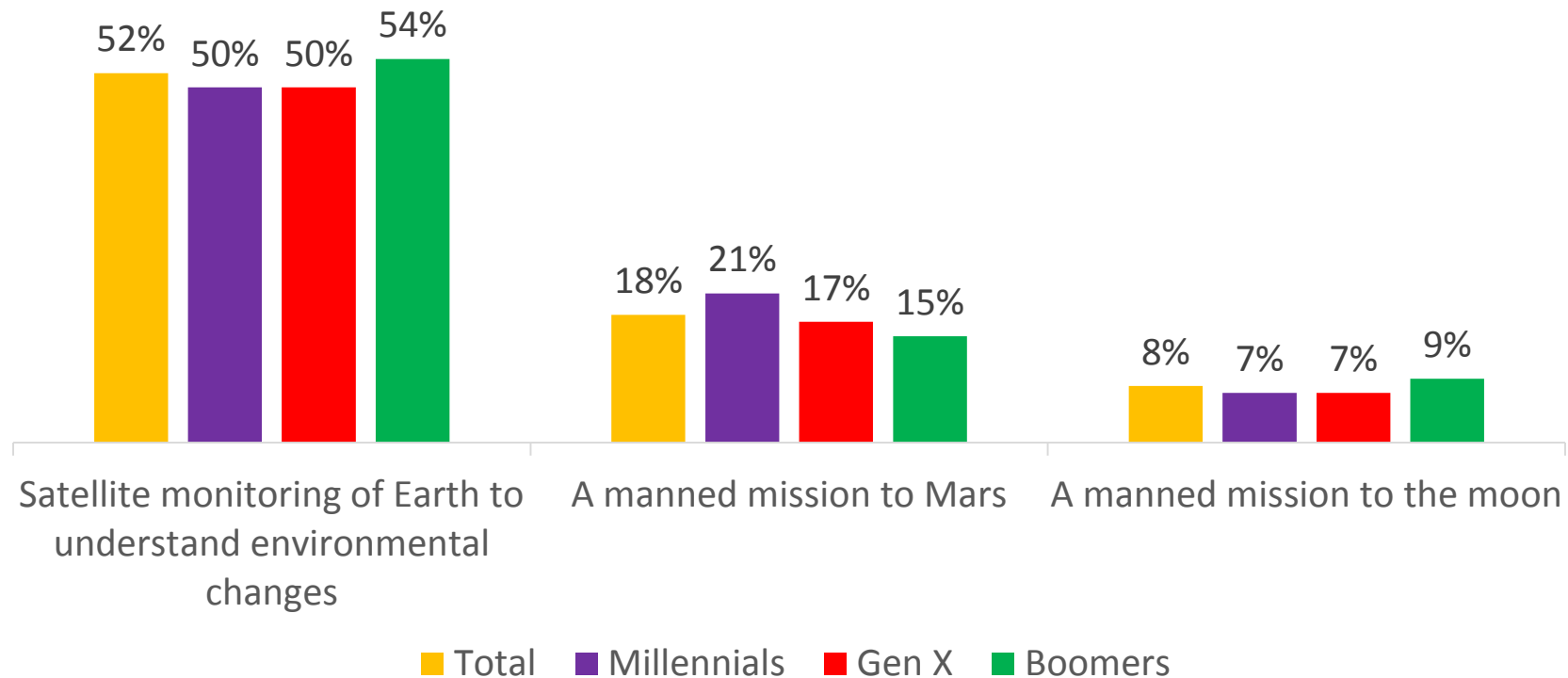
How familiar are you, if at all, with the following individuals?
