In this case, the poll has a credibility interval of plus or minus the following percentage points



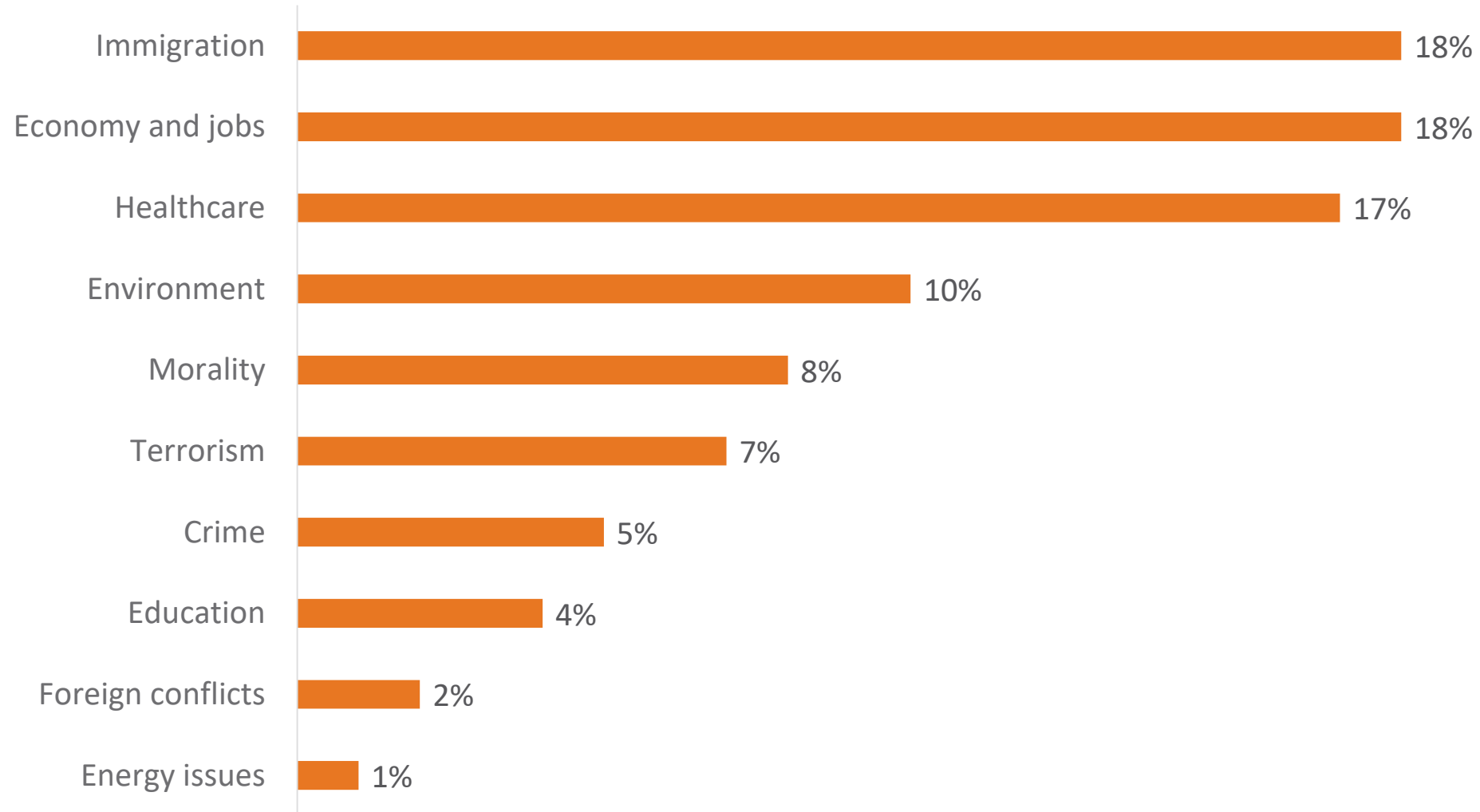

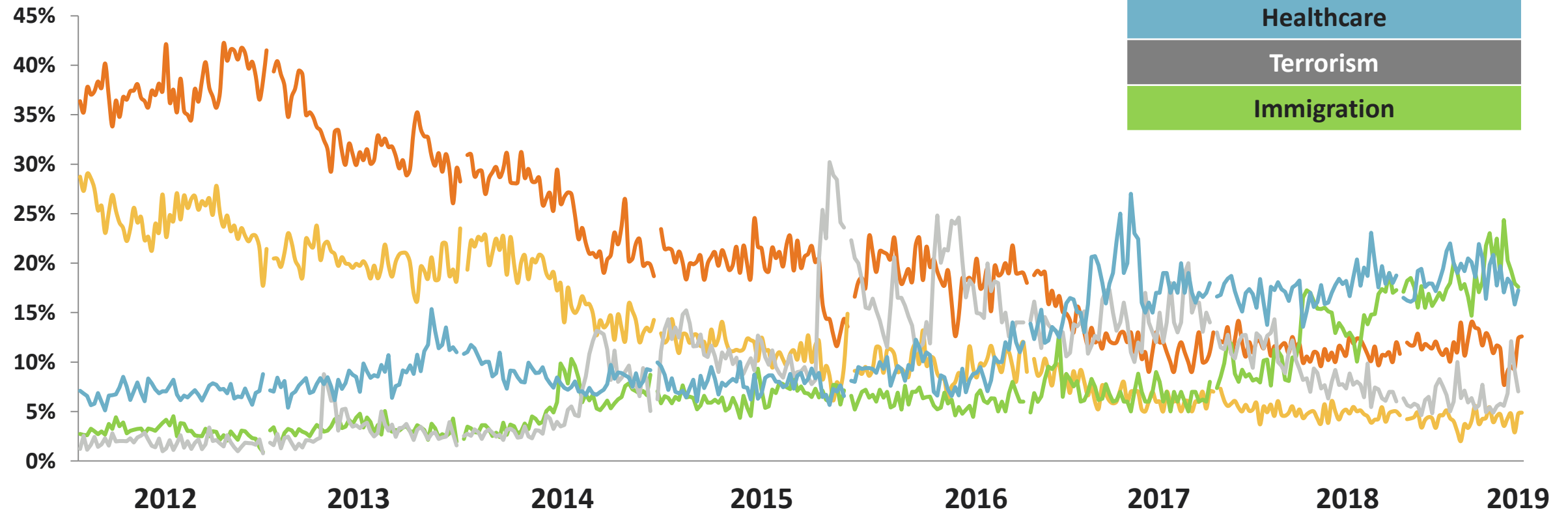

Most Important Problem Facing America

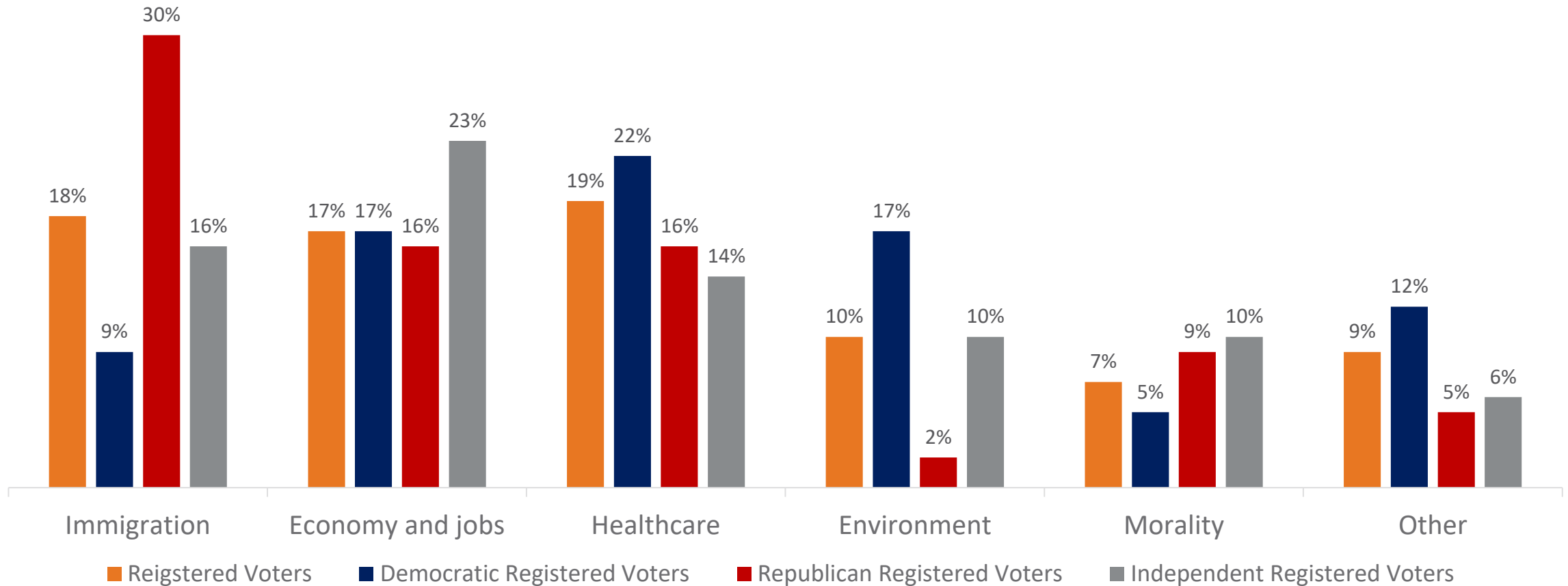
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the U.S. today?

Parties are split on their top issues

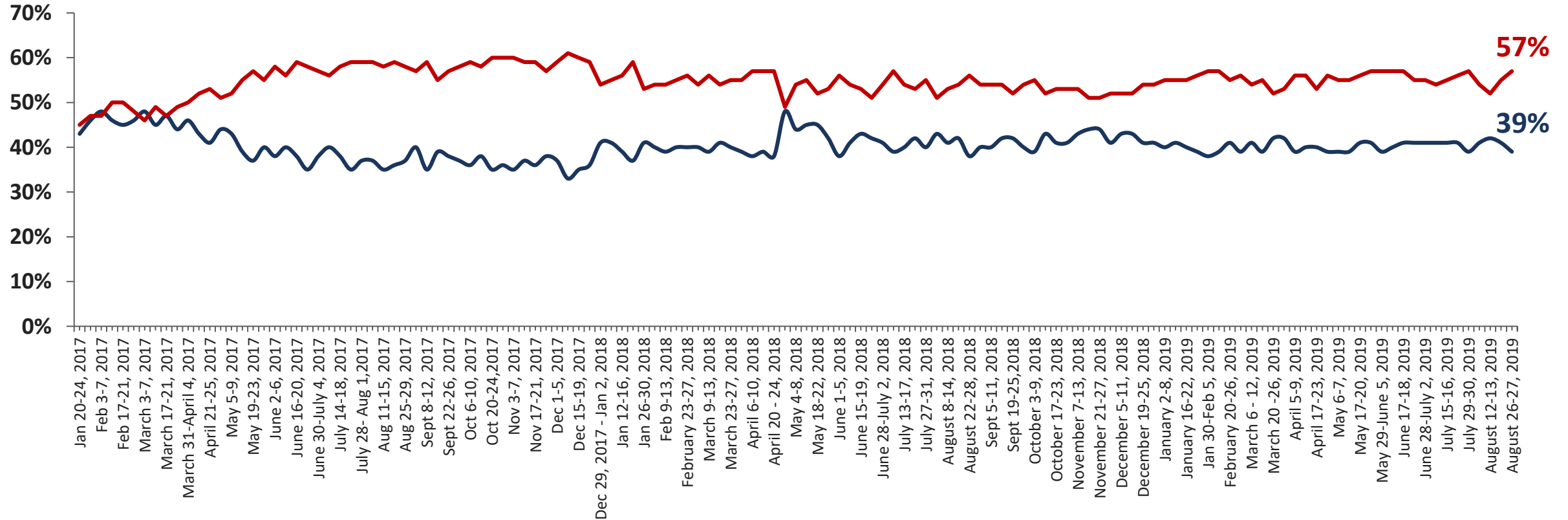
In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?

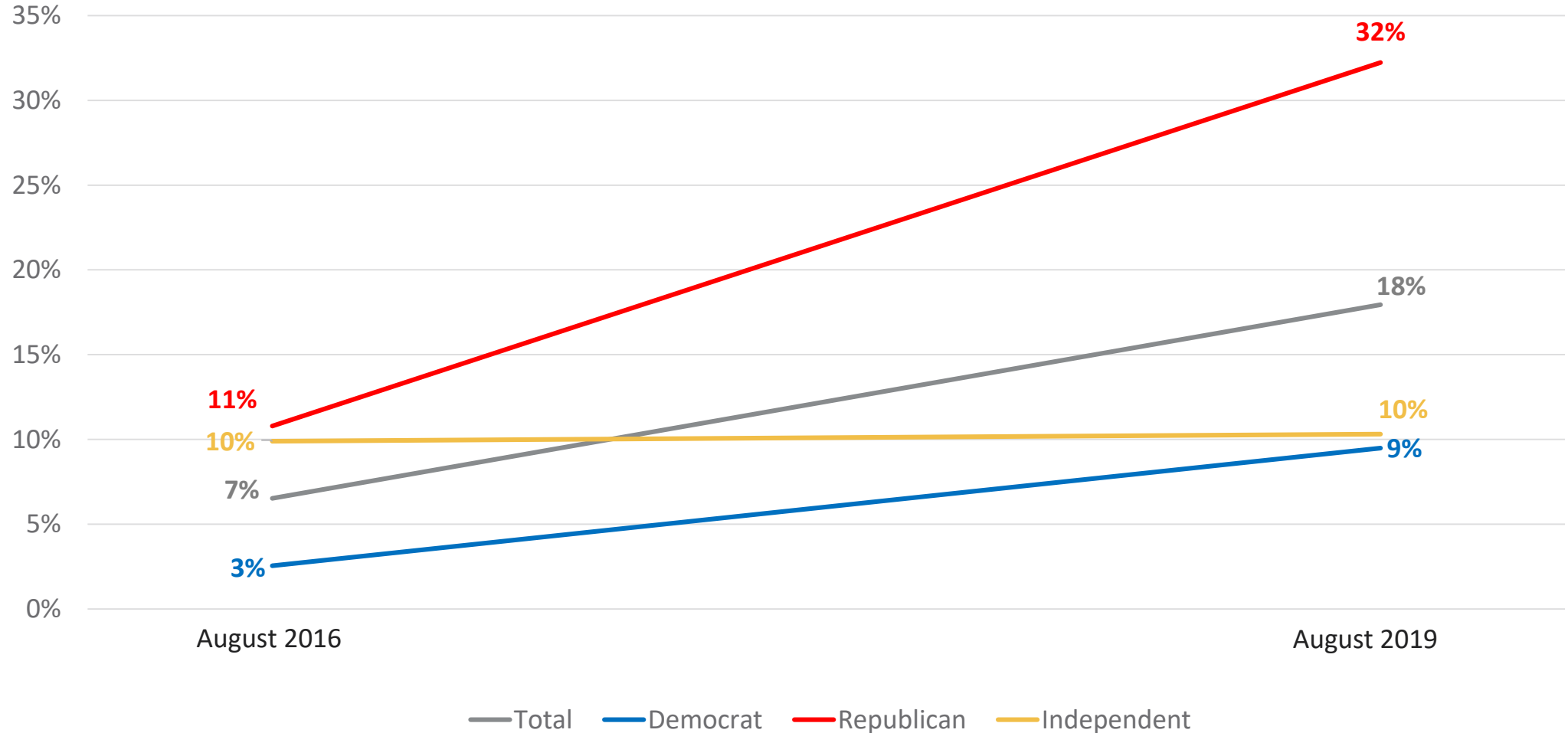

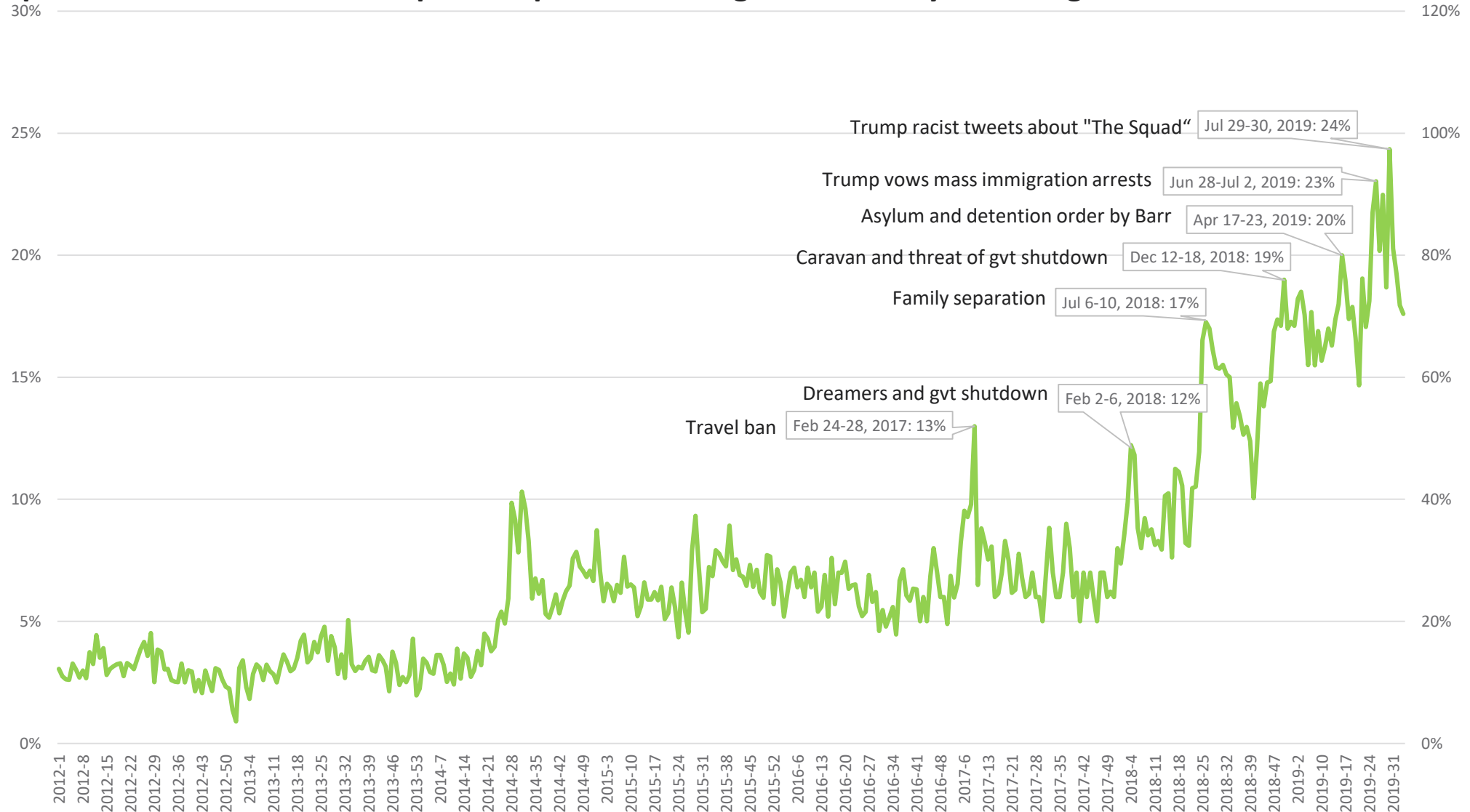
Most Important Problem Facing America – Trend

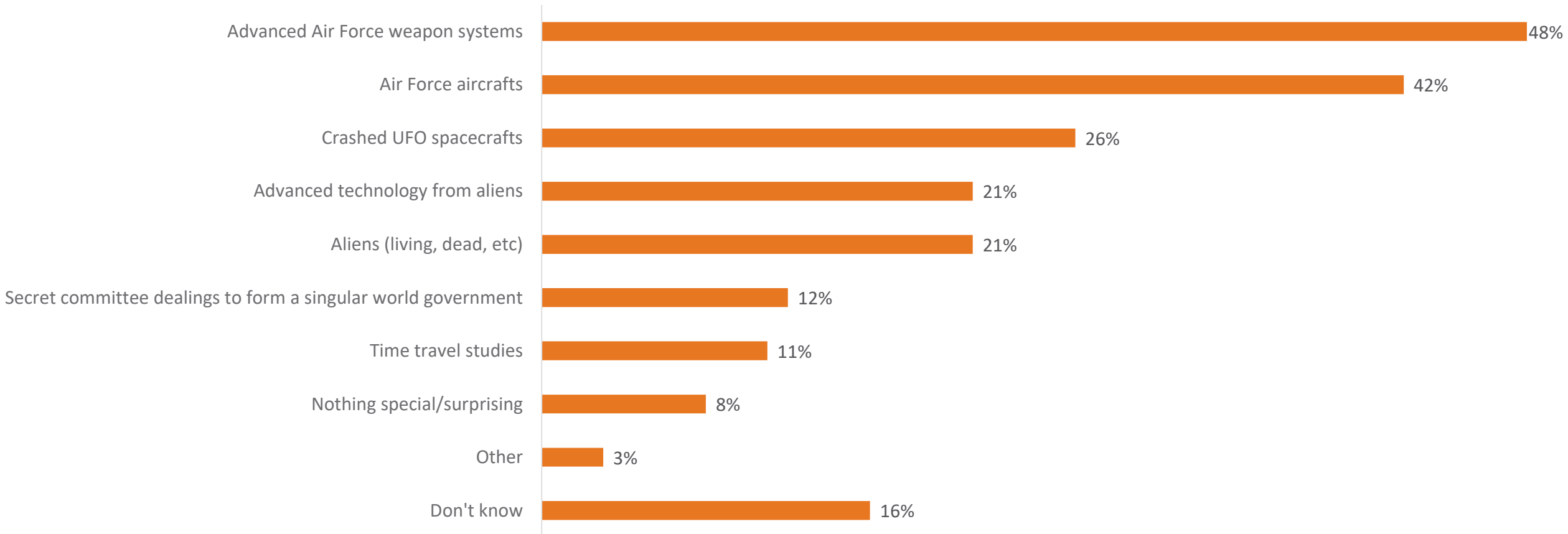

In your opinion, what is held at Area 51?

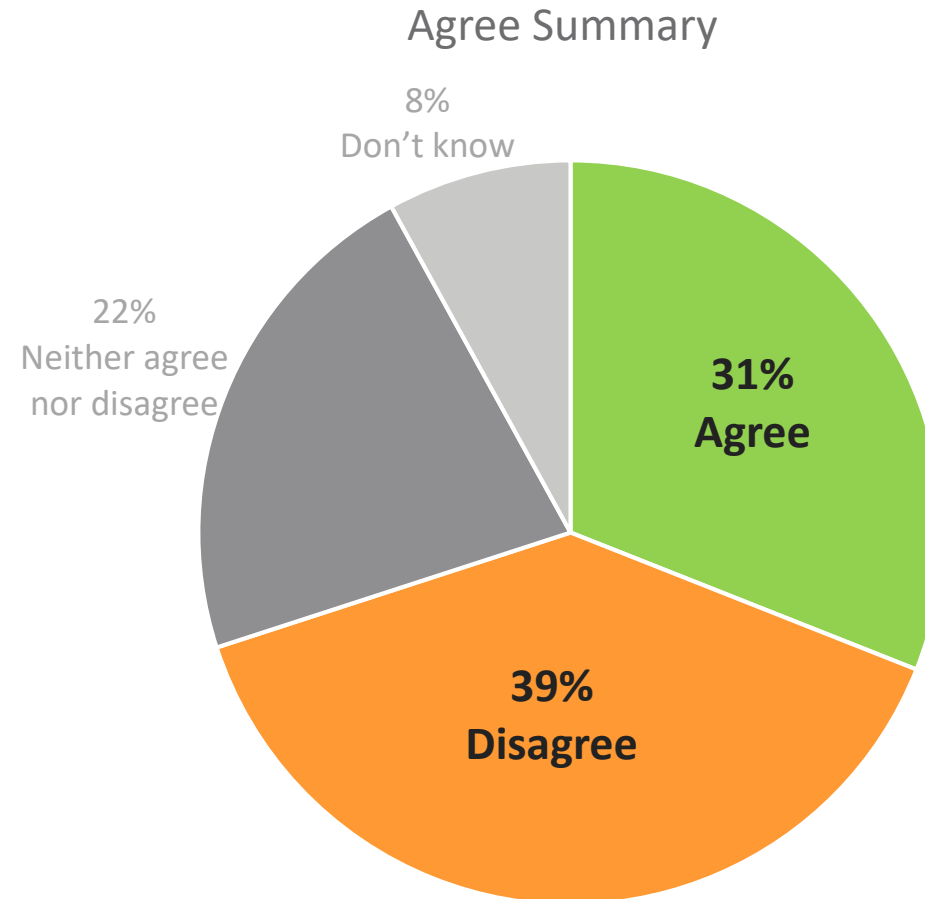

Please indicate how much you agree or disagree with the following statements:

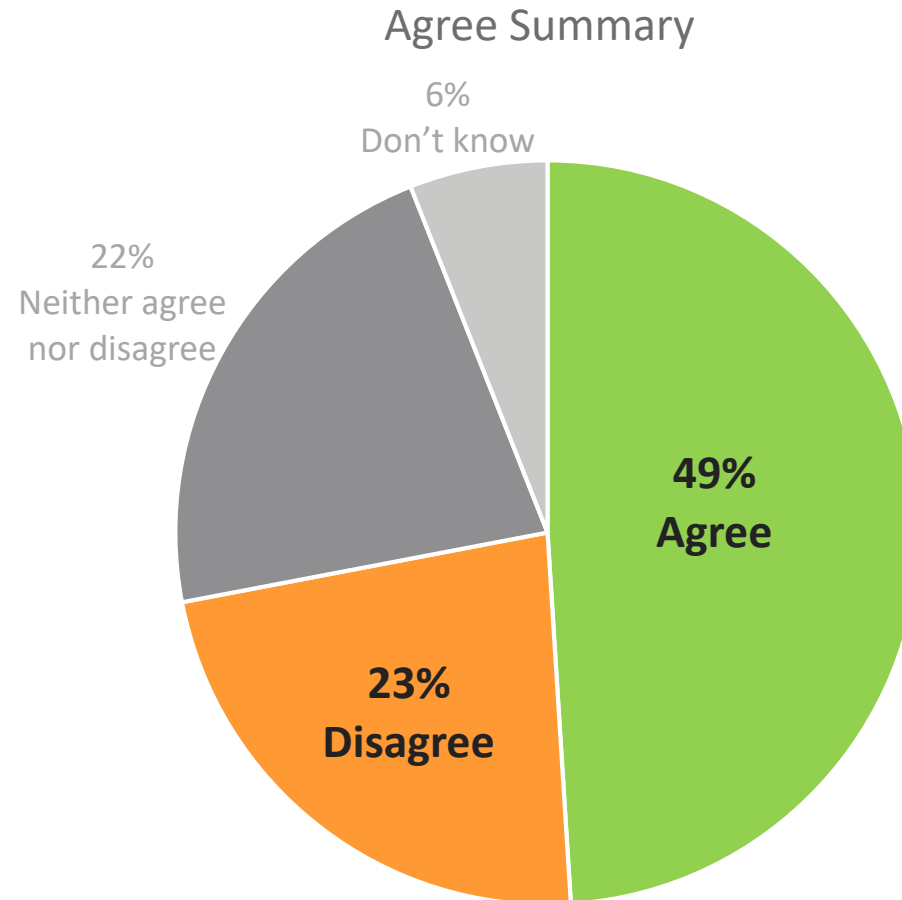
Area 51 is just a regular Air Force base.
