


In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?





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Most Important Problem Facing America






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Parties are split on their top issues

In your opinion, what is the most important problem facing the US today?






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
Donald Trump's Weekly Approval



Which of the following comes closest to your opinion?




President Trump should be impeached

How serious of a problem is it that President Trump encouraged the Ukrainian president to investigate Joe Biden and his son, Hunter?




IMPEACHMENT IN A GLOBAL CONTEXT

Impeachment Data Set

- Democratic countries with presidential systems where the chief executive was removed or an attempt was made to remove them through a legal or constitutional process as opposed to extra institutional means, like a coup.
- Additional variables such as an incumbent's approval rating, economic growth, party control of the legislative body in charge of deciding impeachment, and what happened in the following election.
