Research Methodology


- Angus Reid Group has recently completed a survey called The Affluent Canadian Report. A total of 2,414 respondents qualified for and completed the survey. In order to qualify for the study, respondents had to have financial assets and/or incomes which placed them in approximately the top 20% of Canadian households.
- Of this total sample, 250 reported that their household has at least \$1 million in financial assets, defined as the value of the household's investments/savings and excluding other assets such as a principal residence, other homes, businesses and the household possessions.
- This report excerpts findings about these 250 respondents, who represent approximatley the top 2% of Canadian households by wealth. Please note that due to the sampling methodlogy, the very top strata of millionaires are not included in this survey.
- The margin of error is ± 6.2 percentage points.






Education



Note: education of the respondent to survey




Occupation



Note: occupation of the respondent to survey




Business Ownership



Rated 5,6, or 7 on a 7-point scale for agreement





Leisure Activities




