

Ipsos-Reid/CTV Internet Polling Results

Methodology

These are the findings of an Ipsos-Reid/CTV poll conducted on November 9th, 2000 using Ipsos-Reid's Internet panel. A total of 558 Canadian Internet users were surveyed, yielding results which are accurate to within + 4.2% (19 times out of 20) of what the results would be if the entire Canadian Internet population been surveyed. The data were statistically weighted to ensure that the sample's age, sex and regional composition reflect that of the actual Canadian Internet population. Members of Ipsos-Reid's Internet panel were randomly selected and sent an email directing them to Ipsos-Reid's survey site where they completed the survey online.
