After all recycling is completed, Ontario currently produces about 9.4 Million Tonnes of garbage per year, and it is disposed of in a number of ways. Toronto and a number of other cities and towns in Ontario, including Sudbury and Belleville, currently pay private landfill disposal companies in the State of Michigan to accept and dispose of their garbage. By the end of this year, about 3 Million Tonnes – or about a third – of Ontario's garbage will be sent to Michigan. About one-third – or 1 Million Tonnes – of this garbage comes from Toronto, but most of it – or about two-thirds – comes from communities throughout the remainder of the province. Ontario transports the garbage to Michigan by truck – that's about 330 trucks per day, 6 days of the week. Have you seen, read or heard anything about this before today?
