

In September 2004 the provincial and territorial premiers and the Prime Minister committed to a 10-year plan to strengthen health care. A key component of this plan was to establish benchmarks for medically acceptable wait times for treatments for cancer and heart ailments, diagnostic imaging, joint replacements, and sight restoration by December 31, 2005. These benchmarks will be used to measure changes in health services over time and to ensure that wait times in these five areas are reduced to acceptable levels by 2007.
