

For many years, Newfoundland and Labrador has been classified as a 'have not' province, meaning it receives equalization payments from the federal government. Earlier this year, Newfoundland and Labrador negotiated a deal with the federal government that allows them to keep all their equalization payments at current levels, even though the province is now receiving more revenues from offshore oil and gas royalties. Newfoundland's premier says the deal will allow his province to build a long-term stable economy. Do you support or oppose allowing Newfoundland and Labrador to maintain its current equalization payments despite rising oil and gas revenues?
