Pulse of Canada: Week 3, March 20th-26th

Toronto, ON - Ipsos Reid, on behalf of CanWest News Service and Global News, has undertaken a new national survey titled the "Pulse of Canada". The survey, conducted among a massive national sample of 8,431 Canadians, measured the vital signs of Canada's communities from sea to sea. Specifically, the survey asked respondents to offer their thoughts on the good and the bad when it comes to their communities, their lifestyle, their values, and their thoughts about the future.

Laid out below, are the topics surveyed for week three of this four week series.

These are the findings of an Ipsos Reid poll conducted for CanWest News Service/ Global News fielded from February 24th to March 3rd. For the survey, a representative sample over 8431 Canadians were interviewed via an on-line survey vehicle. The sample used in this study has been weighted according to 2001 Census data to accurately reflect the general population.. With a sample of this size, the aggregate results are considered accurate to within ±1.1 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what they would have been had the entire population of Canada been polled. The margin of error within each region surveyed is shown in the table below.
