Methodology...

- Online interviews were conducted among a randomly selected, nationally representative sample of 2367 Canadian homeowners...
- All interviews were conducted in English and French...
- Interviewing took place from August 17th-21st 2006...
- Data was weighted by region, age & sex according to Census data...



Sample Stratification and Margin of Error...

- ■The margin of error for the full sample is ±2.0 percentage points, 19 times out of 20.
- ■The margin of error for subsets of the total sample are detailed in the table below.

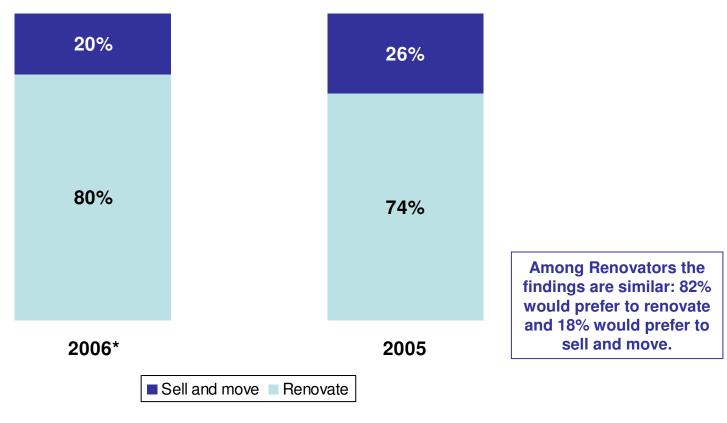

Among All Homeowners, Most (80%--up six points from 2005) Would Prefer To Renovate Their Current Home Than To Sell And Move...So...

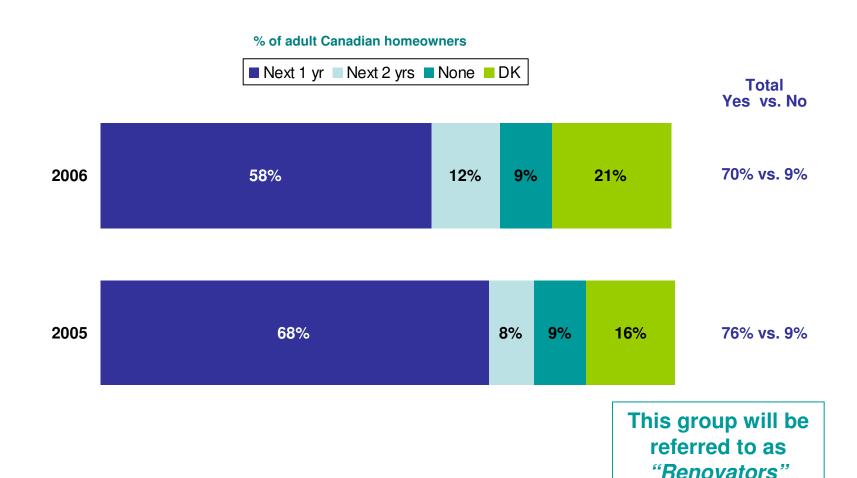

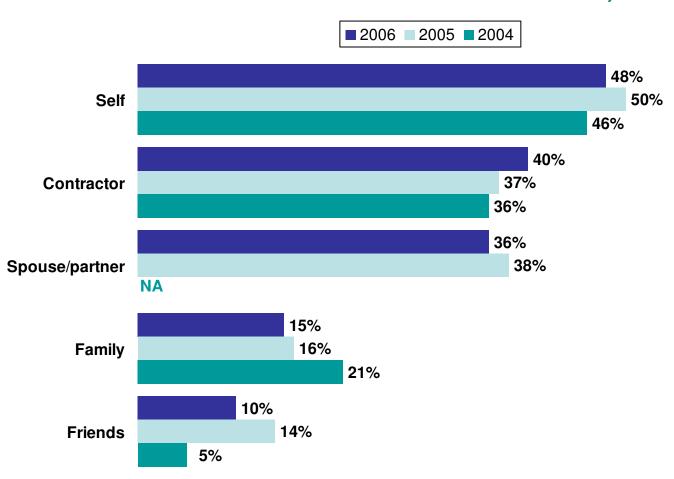

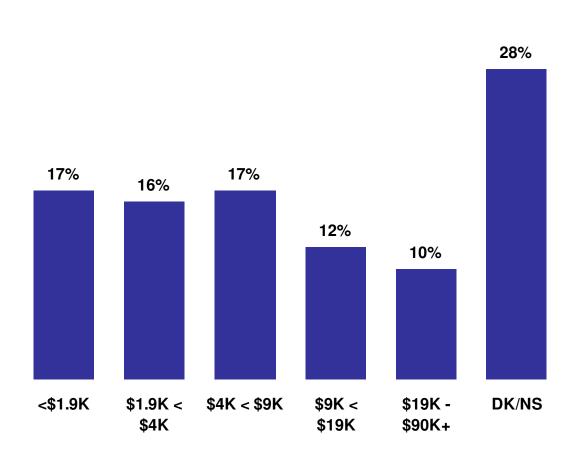


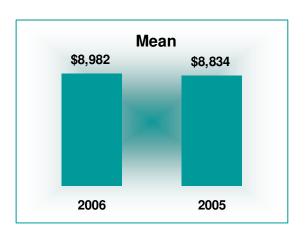
Half Of Renovators (48%) Plan To Do Renovations Themselves...But Slightly More (+4) Using Contractors Than Two Years Ago...





How Much Do Renovators Think They'll Spend? A Mean Average Of \$8,982...\$148 More Than Last Year...

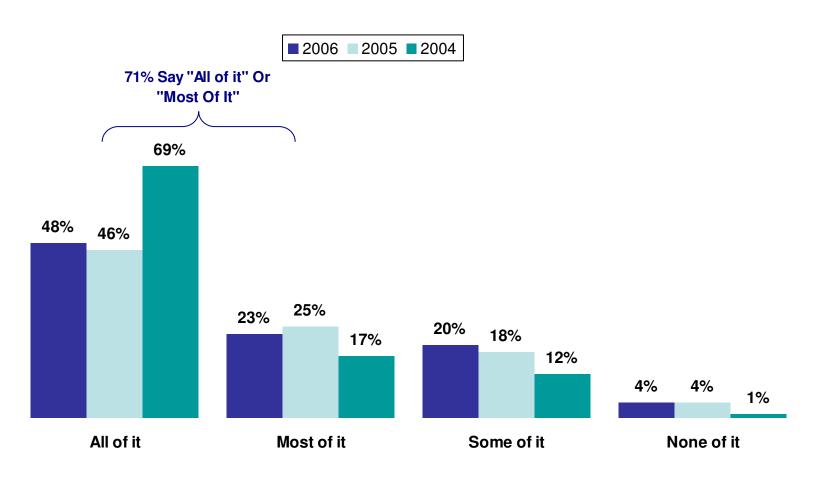








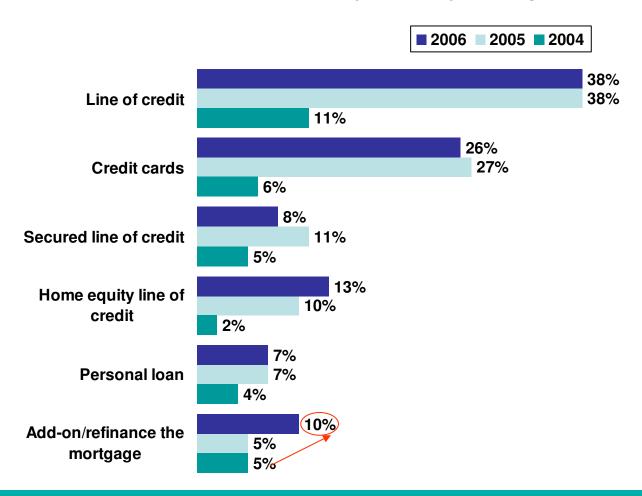

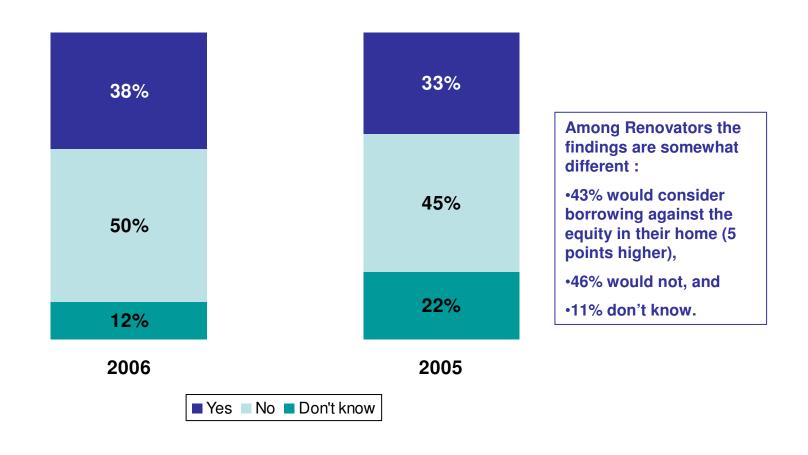
% of adult Canadian homeowners who intend to renovate in the next 2 years and don't plan to use only cash/savings





Among All Homeowners, 38% Might Borrow Against Their Home Equity To Finance Renovation, Up 5 Points Over 2005...

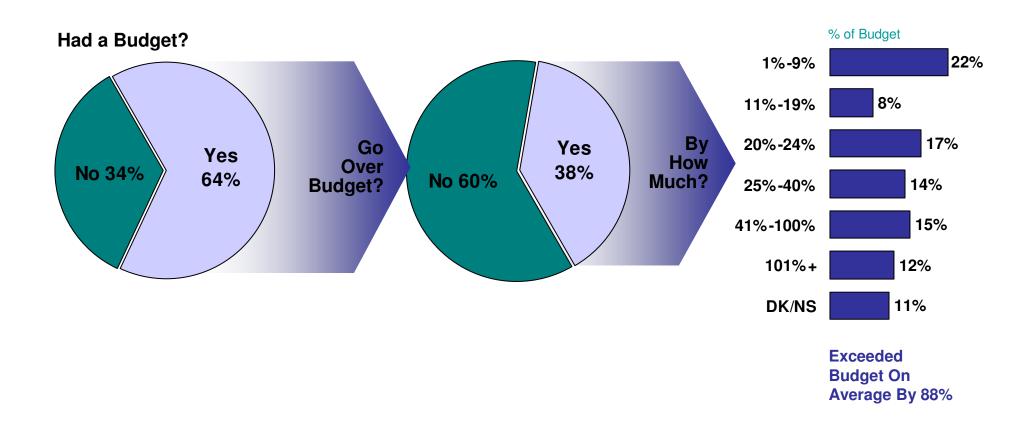

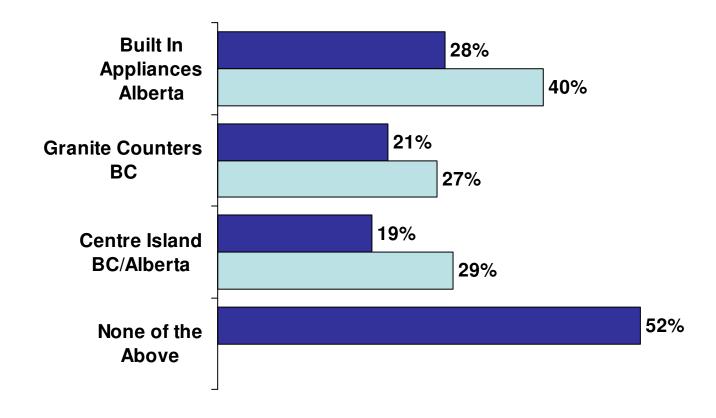

Among Those Planning Kitchen Renos, Who Are Planning Most Are In The West...

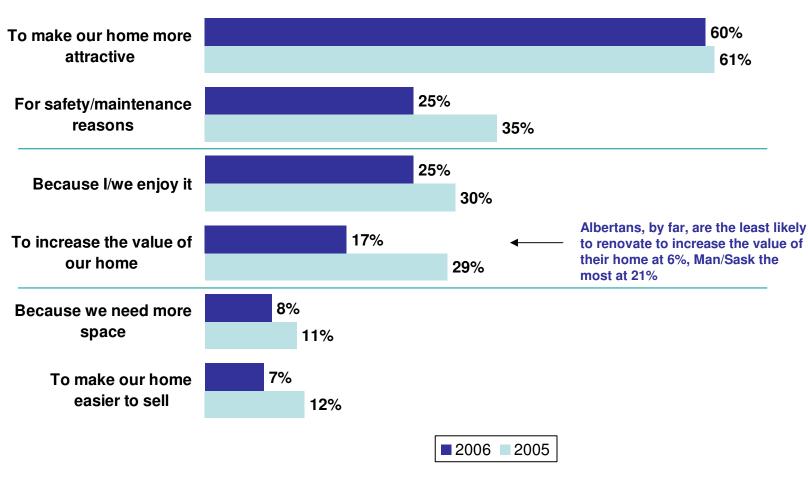
