

## GREEN SHIFT PLAN

1. As you may know, Liberal Party Leader Stephan Dion has recently announced his "Green Shift" plan. Now, as part of the plan, Mr. Dion is proposing to tax certain carbon producing activities, which is hoped will change various consumer habits that will help improve the environment. Mr. Dion has indicated that the tax would not be applied to gas for automobiles. The policy will produce an increase in revenue for the government but he proposes that this money will be returned to Canadians through other tax breaks or incentives to offset the tax measures. In effect, the policy is termed a 'green shift' that penalizes those who don't switch to less or non-carbon use activities and rewards those who do make the switch. Upon hearing this, do you support or oppose this approach by Mr. Dion?
