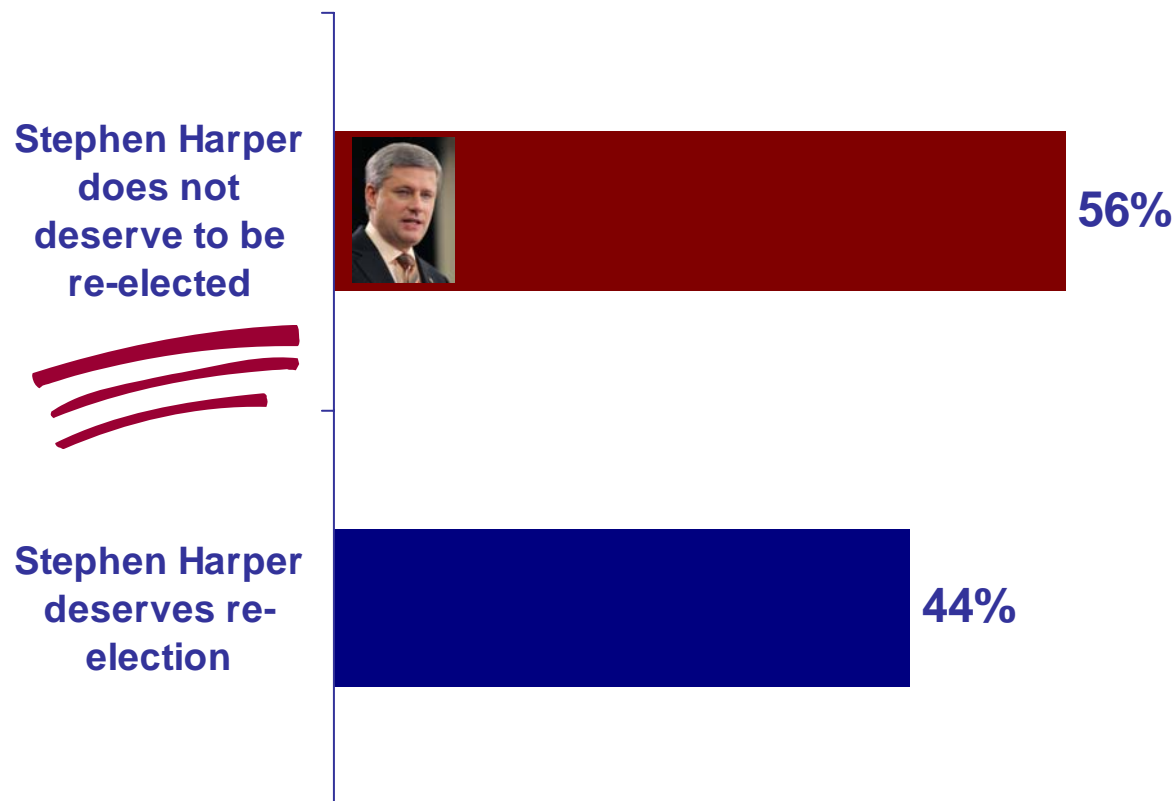

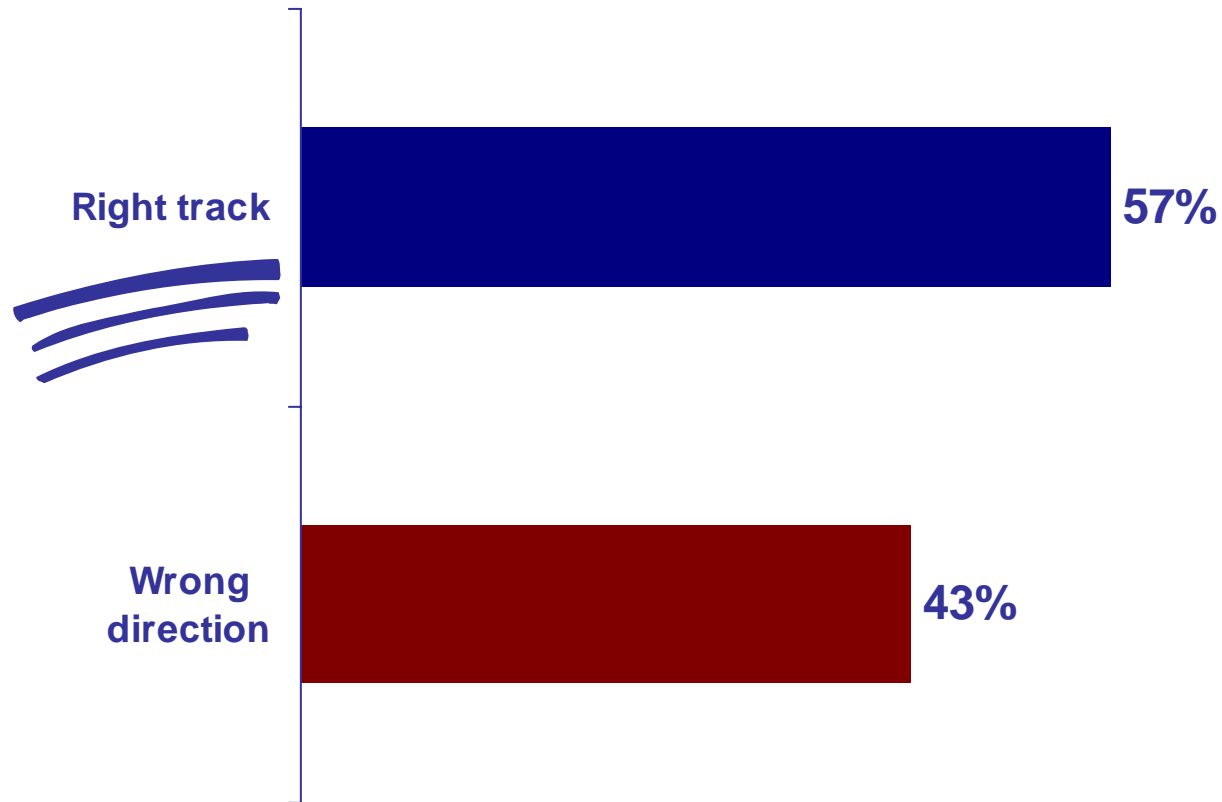
Which Of These Statements Is Closest To Your Point Of View?

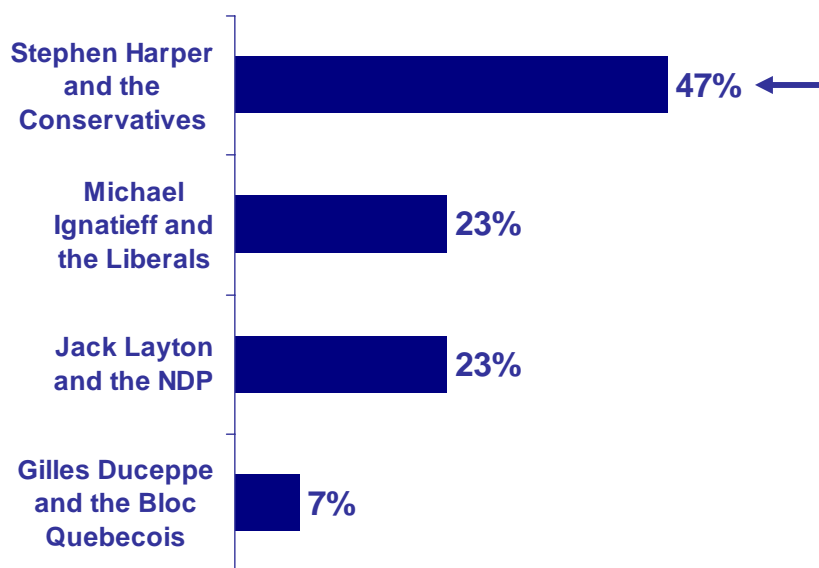
Overall, Would You Say That Canada Is Moving In The Right Track These Days, Or Headed In The Wrong Direction?



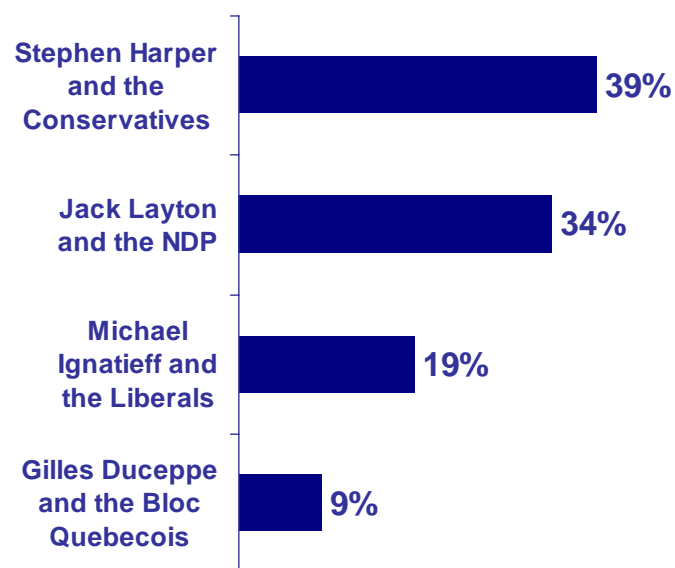

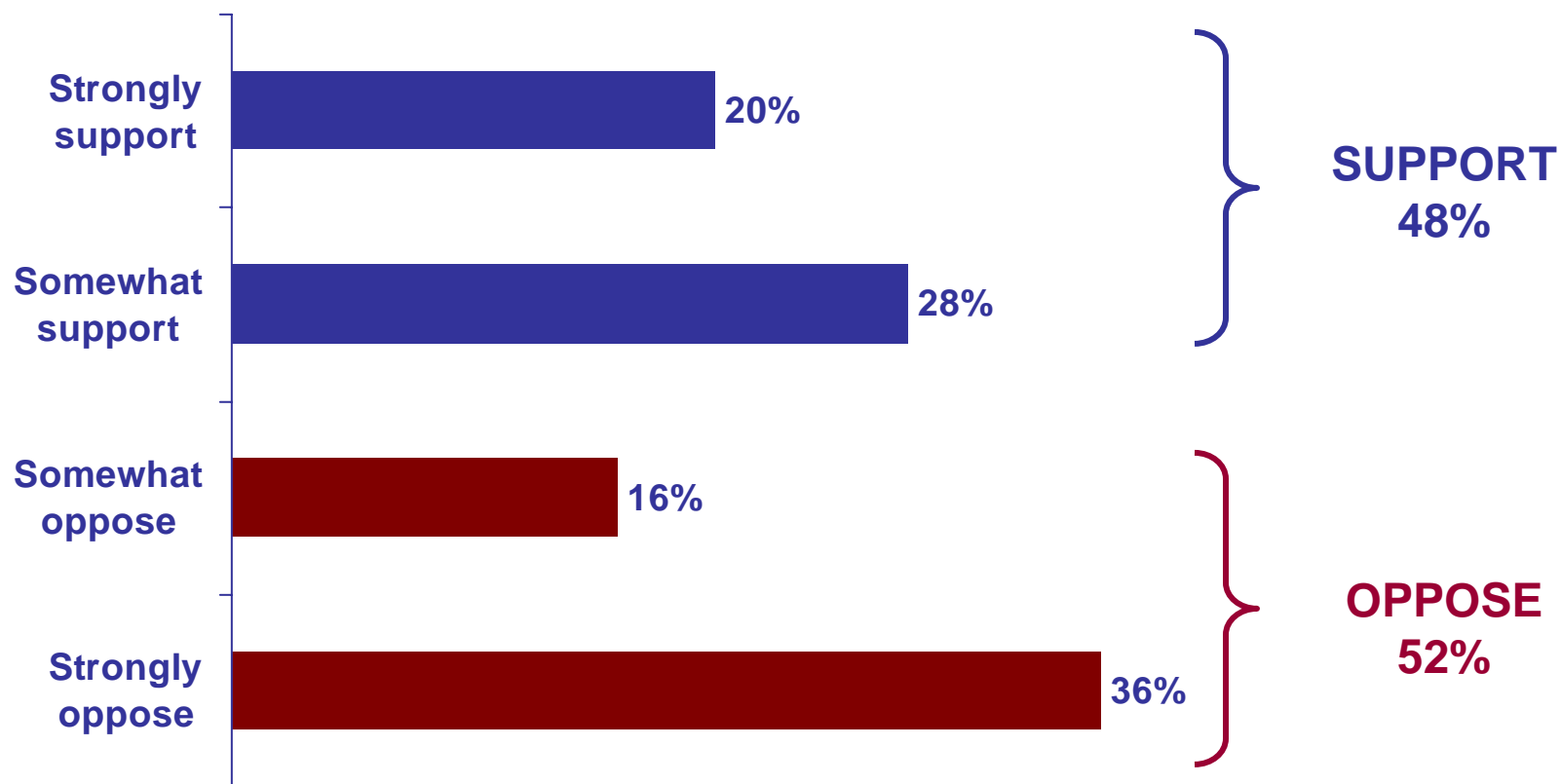

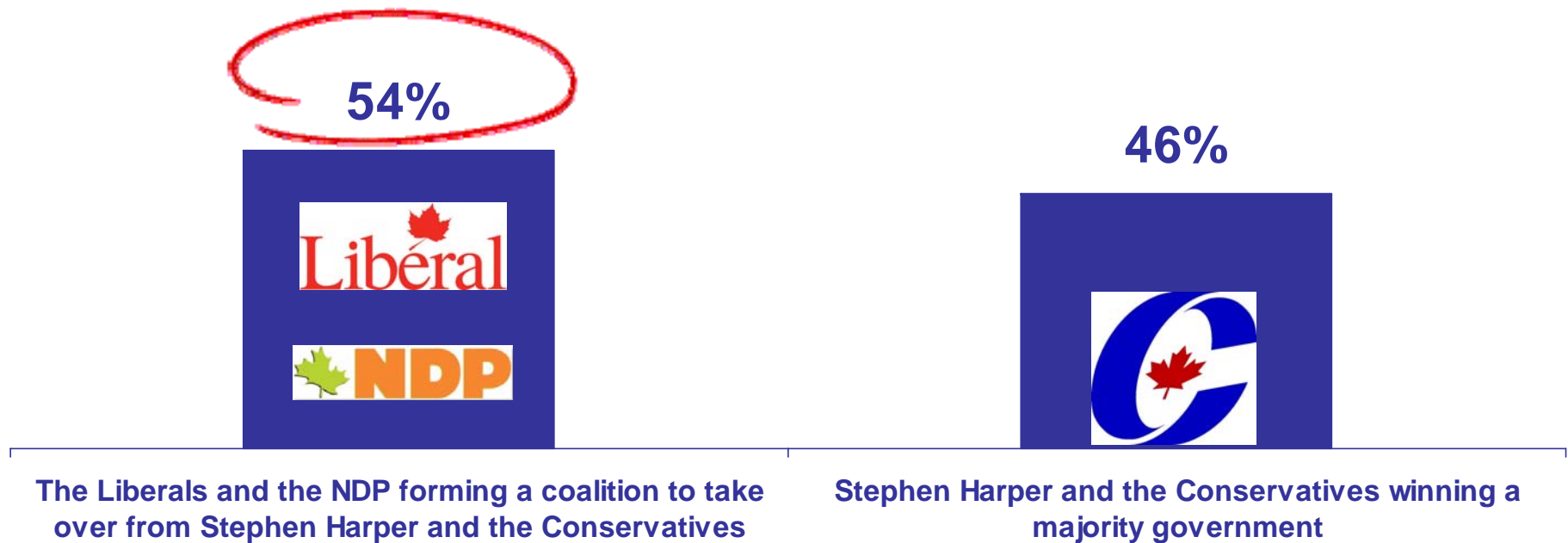

Suppose The Coalition Only Involves Only The Liberal Party And The NDP Getting Together. Which Of These Two Options Would You Prefer To See:

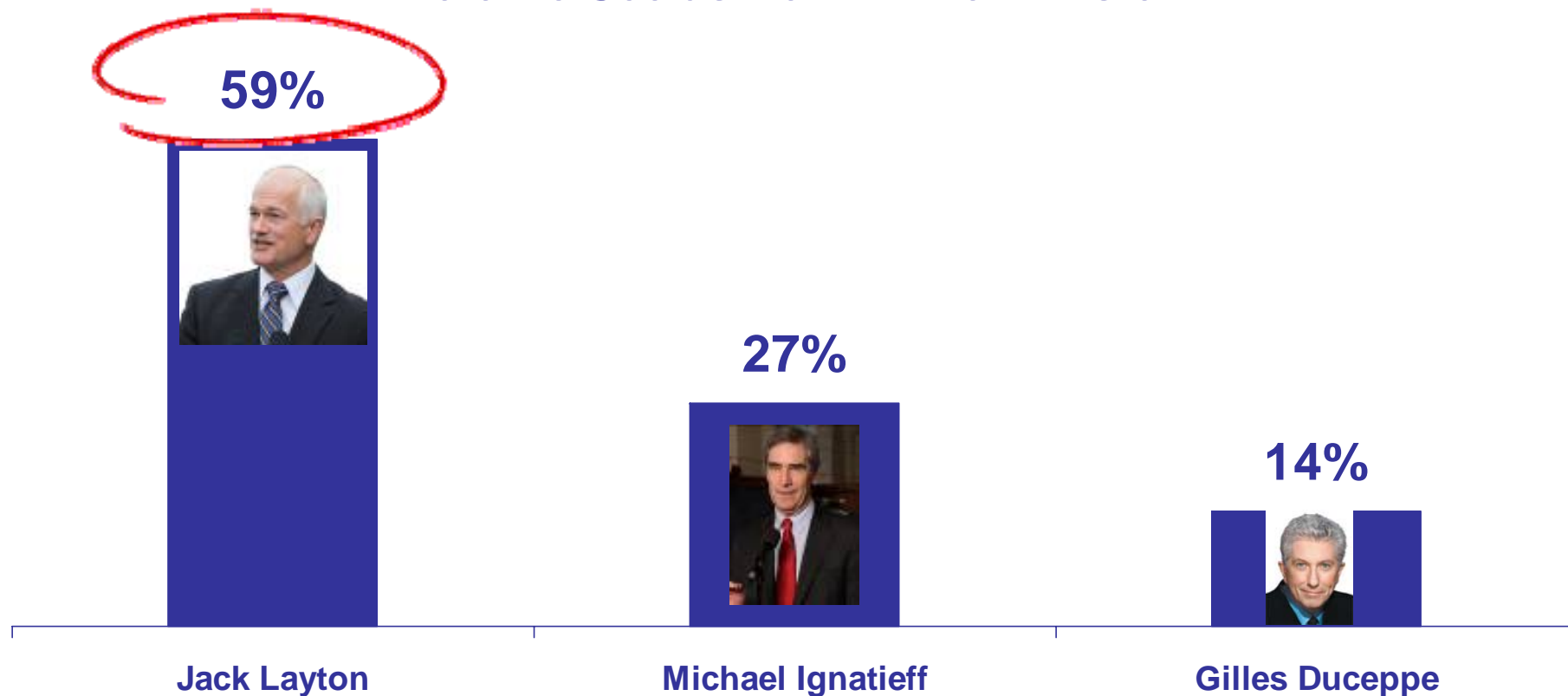
