Best Campaign So Far

1. Who do you think has had the best start to the campaign so far?

36% Adrian Dix and the NDP
25% Christy Clark and the BC Liberals
5% John Cummins and the BC Conservatives
3% Jane Sterk and the Green Party
31% Don't know

Notes: Excluding the 'don't knows', the results are NDP 52%, BC Libs 36%, BC Cons 8% and Greens 4%.

Most Important Election Source of Information

2. Which of the following is your most important source of information about the BC election?

42% Television 20% Newspapers 12% Radio 12% Online news sites 5% Online blogs, forums, etc 2% Social media (e.g. Facebook or Twitter) 1% Campaign advertising/materials 1% Other 5% Don't know

Notes: The total of the three online sources is 19%. Among the 18-34 year old segment, this rises to 34%, which puts online sources slightly ahead of television (30% among 18-34 years).

Methodology

These are the findings of an Ipsos Reid poll of 450 adult British Columbians conducted online using Ipsos Reid's national online household panel between April 18 and 19, 2013. A survey with an unweighted probability sample of this size and a 100% response rate would have an estimated margin of error of $\pm 4.6\%$, 19 times out of 20. These data were statistically weighted to ensure the sample's regional and age/sex composition reflects that of the actual BC population according to 2011 Census data.
