As you may know, at the request of the Senate of Canada, the external auditing firm Deloitte has audited a number of Senators expense reports, and has said there are problems with some claims relating to housing allowances and travel expenses. In one case, Senator Mike Duffy repaid \$90,000 in expenses by way of a monetary gift he received from the now former Chief of Staff to the Prime Minister, Nigel Wright. Questions surrounding the appropriateness of the monetary gift have resulted in Senator Duffy resigning from the Conservative caucus and now sitting as an independent Senator and Nigel Wright having resigned as Chief of Staff to the Prime Minister.
