




Methodology

- These are some of the findings of an Ipsos Reid poll conducted for CTV News and CP24 on June 3rd, 2014 from immediately before and after the Televised Leaders debate.
- The pre-debate survey was conducted among 2,068 Ontarian adults; the post-debate survey was conducted among 1,765 Ontarian adults. Respondents were selected via the Ipsos I-Say Online Panel, Ipsos Reid's national online panel. The sample was drawn from a pre-recruited panel of 4,152 voters said they would vote on Election Day and watch the debate.
- Weighting was then employed to balance demographics to ensure that the sample's composition reflects that of the adult population according to Census data and to provide results intended to approximate the sample universe.
- The precision of Ipsos online surveys are measured using a Bayesian Credibility Interval. For the pre-debate poll, the results are accurate to within +/- 2.5 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. For the post-debate poll, the results are accurate to within +/- 2.7 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what the results would have been had the entire population of adults in Ontario who watched the debate an intend to vote on election day been polled. All sample surveys and polls may be subject to other sources of error, including, but not limited to coverage error, and measurement error.

POST: Who, in your view, won this debate?



PRE: Which party leader do you think offers the best ideas and policies?


POST: Who do you think offered the best ideas and policies in the debate?



PRE2/POST2. Which party leader do you think offers the Best Ideas and Policies? Base: All Respondents: Pre n= 2,068 Post n=1,765




PRE: Which party leader do you think sounds and acts most like a Premier? POST: Who do you think sounded and acted most like a Premier?




most visually attractive?

Time for change vs. Deserves re-election?






What is the most important issue for you in this election, the one that you most want the political leaders and candidates to be talking about?














[POST] Did you change your mind about who to vote for on June 12th because of tonight's debate?


[POST] Which of these party leaders, if any, do you think had a knock-out punch in the debate, that is an argument or point that was the defining moment of the debate?
