

# **HEALTHCARE IS THE TOP ISSUE OF NATIONAL CONCERN**



**Canadian adults** identify **health care** as the **TOP ISSUE** of public concern, followed by employment and jobs.

Health care has been the top area of concern for Canadians since the 1990s.

# MOST EXPECT TO USE THE SYSTEM MORE THAN EVER, BUT WORRY THEY'LL FALL THROUGH THE CRACKS

**82%** of Canadian adults expect to access the health care system more than ever in the next five to 10 years. *Yet...* **70%** worry they may fall through the cracks

#### **HEALTH CARE IS SEEN AS AN INDISPENSABLE SERVICE**

Canadians expect <u>more</u> from the health care system than they do from... Other public sector services (84%) ... or... Private sector services (79%)

#### EFFICIENT SPENDING AND BETTER CARE GO HAND IN HAND

**89**% say more efficient spending by the health care system would lead to better care. **52**% say they don't care how the money is spent as long as the quality of care is high

# ALTHOUGH MOST SAY THE SYSTEM IS AMONG THE BEST IN THE WORLD, MANY SEE IT FALLING BEHIND

**75**% think the health care system is among the best in the developed world... *However...* **64**% worry it is falling behind... and...

40% know people who have sought for care outside their province

# Who's Responsible For Improving The System?

Governments haven't "solved" the health care problem.

The public mood is a combination of fatigue and frustration.

The challenge for health care leaders is how to turn public attitudes away from fatigue and frustration towards accountability and change.

- Canadians expect health care professionals, particularly doctors (70%), nurses (66%) and health researchers (62%) to play a greater role in improving the health care system
- Nearly three in five (58%) say the people who run Canada's hospitals and health institutions should also play a greater role
- Fewer think policy makers (39%), politicians (37%) or business people (29%) should play a greater role in improving the system









### **Public Concern At A Glance**

% WORRIED they will fall through the


CANADA AVERAGE: 70% cracks in the health care system.

## **What Are Canadians Worried About?**

IF 70% ARE WORRIED ABOUT FALLING THROUGH THE CRACKS. WHERE ARE THE FAULT LINES?

- 91% want more done to improve the quality and accessibility of mental health care
- 90% want more done to identify and provide for frail seniors
- 90% want more done on palliative care
- 77% prioritize investments in ageing hospitals over roads and bridges
- 66% are worried about the risk of infection in hospitals
