
METHODOLOGY

- These are the findings of an Ipsos poll conducted on behalf of Global News.
- For the survey, a sample of 2,002 Canadians from the Ipsos I-Say panel was interviewed from December 16 to 18, 2015.
- Quotas and weighting were employed to ensure that the sample's composition reflects the overall population according to census information.
- The precision of online polls is measured using a credibility interval. In this case, the results are accurate to within +/- 2.5 percentage points, 19 times out of 20, of what the results would have been had all Canadians been polled.



TOP CANADIAN NEWS STORY

The top Canadian news story is the election/change of government. Two other popular news stories are the Syrian refugees and the economy.

TOP CANADIAN NEWS STORY BY REGION

Residents of BC are more likely to have chosen the election/change in government as the top Canadian news story, while those from Alberta are more likely to have chosen the economy. Residents in Quebec and the Atlantic are slightly more likely to think the Syrian refugee crisis was the top story.
